- 1 C — The story states Mara is **sixteen**.
2 B — RiverLight is a **waterfront festival** with music, fireworks, and lasers.
3 C — Elias is **Mara’s uncle** and a **sound engineer**.
4 B — He clips a **contact microphone** to the cable.
5 C — The resonant band appears near **47 Hz**.
6 C — The analyser shows **frequency peaks** (“small teeth”).
7 B — **Ms Harrow** is the **council coordinator** in high-vis.
8 C — The **band changes the bass pattern** away from 47 Hz.
9 B — “Patient stars” suggests a **calm, ceremonial** mood.
10 B — She **balances instrument data with bodily awareness**.
11 A — **Sustained** resonance can **amplify**; brief contact is usually fine.
12 B — The ticking signals **resonance building** with each beat.
13 C — She recognises **spectacle and**

- subtle structure-borne sound** coexisting.
14 C — Elias frames their part as **collaborative humility** (“we nudged”).
15 C — The band proves **responsive** to safety advice.
16 A — The echo as a “softer twin” **mirrors her path** toward acoustics.
17 B — **Resonant = echoing or amplifying** sound.
18 B — **Braided = interwoven**.
19 B — **Floated** is a **verb** (action).
20 B — **Slid** is a **verb**.
21 E — No misspelling among A–D: “structurally” is correct.
22 E — **No error**: all words are spelled correctly.
23 B — **seperate** → **separate** (only B is wrong).
24 B — **indispensible** → **indispensable** (B is wrong).
25 A — **supercede** → **supersede** (A is wrong).
26 A — Needs a comma after the introductory clause: “**After the monitors spiked, ...**”.
27 B — Missing comma after the reporting clause: “Elias said, ‘**then widen...**’”.

- 28 C — A comma is needed to separate the reporting tag from the quote: “...radioed the stage, ‘**shift the bass now,**’ ...”.
29 A — Non-restrictive clause needs a comma after “bridge”: “**The bridge, which had stood...**”.
30 E — **No error**: commas correctly separate coordinated clauses.
31 A — The bridge feels **poised**, not strained.
32 A — The barge moves **upriver**.
33 C — Let the evidence **settle**.
34 B — A sound recommendation can **stand**.
35 A — Confidence should **coast** (steady, controlled), not careen.
