Across the UK, people are now coming together to ensure these risks are properly understood, openly discussed and responded to with the seriousness they require.

A growing national effort

The National Emergency Briefing is building support for a government-backed televised emergency briefing to the nation on the climate and nature crisis.

The initiative began at Westminster Central Hall, where more than 1,200 MPs, peers and leaders from across UK society heard directly from senior experts about the scale of the risks facing the UK and the response now required.

This film extends that work into workplaces, organisations and communities across the country, helping create the shared understanding needed for an effective national response. Increasingly, businesses, institutions and professional networks are engaging with the film as part of a wider conversation about organisational resilience, leadership, public understanding and long-term societal preparedness.
