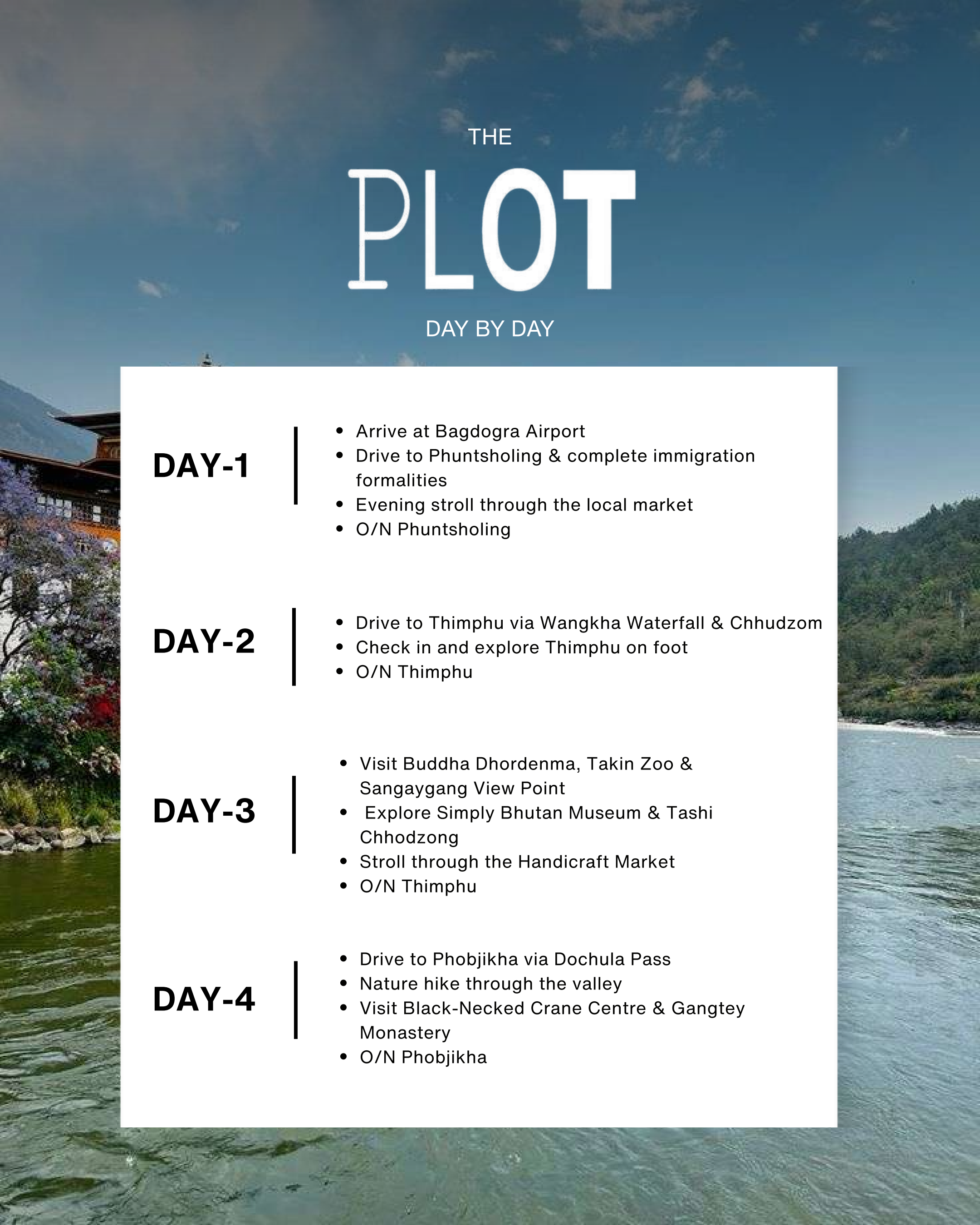
BHUTAN FOR US

DAY-2

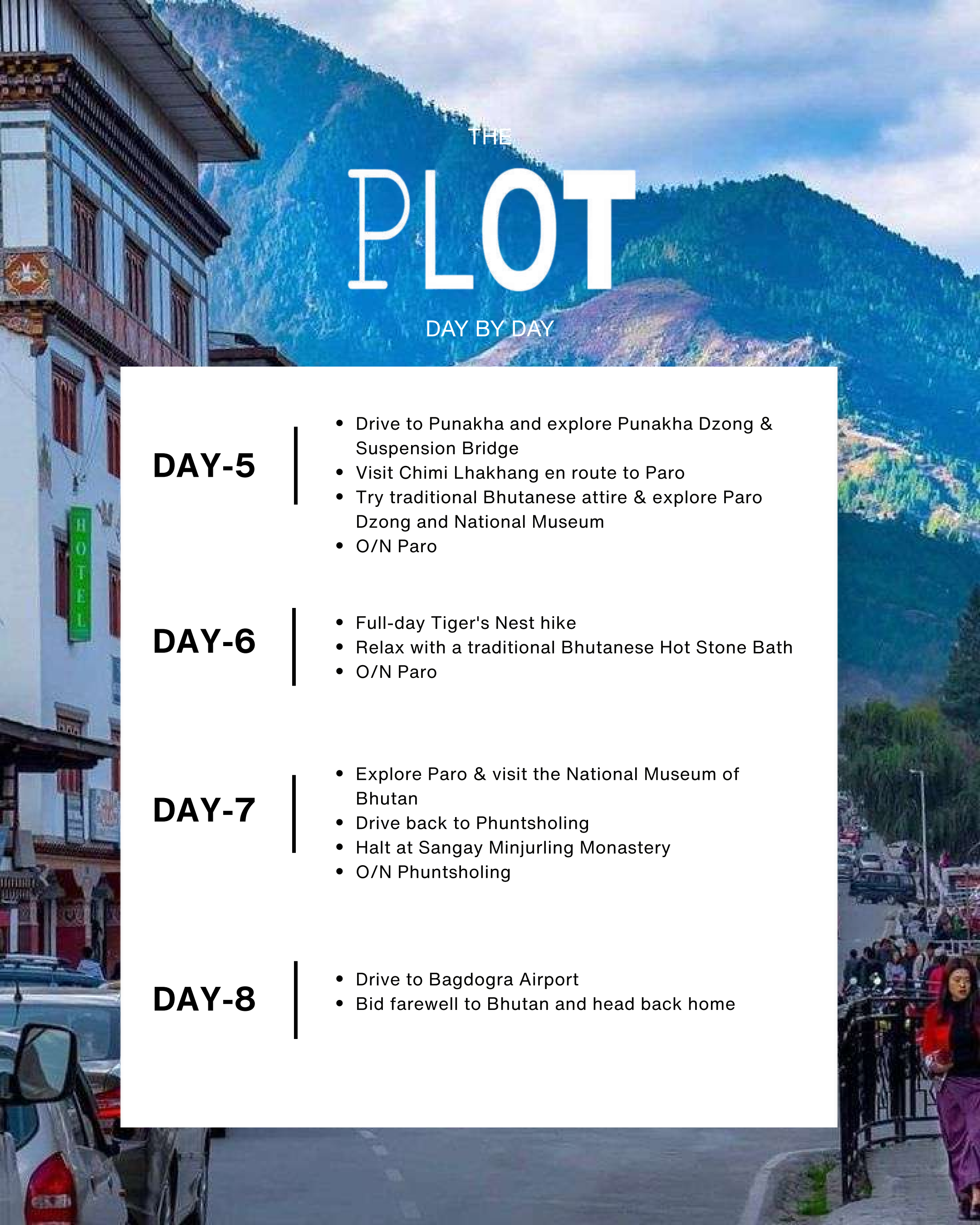
- Drive to Thimphu via Wangkha Waterfall & Chhudzom

- Drive to Bagdogra Airport
- Bid farewell to Bhutan and head back home

DAY 1

26th December

Welcome to Bhutan

The adventure begins at Bagdogra Airport, where we'll meet our representative and start the scenic drive towards Phuntsholing, the gateway to Bhutan.

On arrival, we'll complete the immigration and permit formalities before checking into our hotel.



As evening sets in, step out for a relaxed stroll through the local market and get your first taste of Bhutanese life.

DAY 2

27th December

Into The Mountains

After breakfast, we leave Phuntsholing behind and make our way towards Thimphu, Bhutan's charming capital.

The journey takes us through beautiful mountain landscapes, with stops at Wangkha Waterfall and Chhudzom, the confluence of the Pachhu and Wangchu rivers.



After checking in, spend the evening exploring Thimphu on foot, discovering its streets, cafés, and local charm at your own pace.

Overnight Stay: Thimphu

DAY 3

28th December

Monasteries, Mountains & Bhutanese Culture

Today we dive deeper into Bhutan's culture and unique way of life.

Start with the magnificent Buddha Dhordenma, followed by a visit to the Takin Zoo and Sangaygang View Point for panoramic views over Thimphu.



After lunch, explore the Simply Bhutan Museum and the impressive Tashi Chhodzong.

As evening arrives, stroll through the Handicraft Market, browsing traditional Bhutanese crafts and local creations.

DAY 4

29th December

Into The Valley

Today we head towards the peaceful Phobjikha Valley, with the journey itself being part of the experience.

Our first major stop is Dochula Pass, home to 108 memorial chortens surrounded by spectacular Himalayan scenery.



Continue towards Phobjikha and stretch your legs with a one-hour nature hike through the beautiful valley.

We'll also visit the Black-Necked Crane Centre and the serene Gangtey Monastery before settling into the quiet rhythm of valley life.

Overnight Stay: Phobjikha

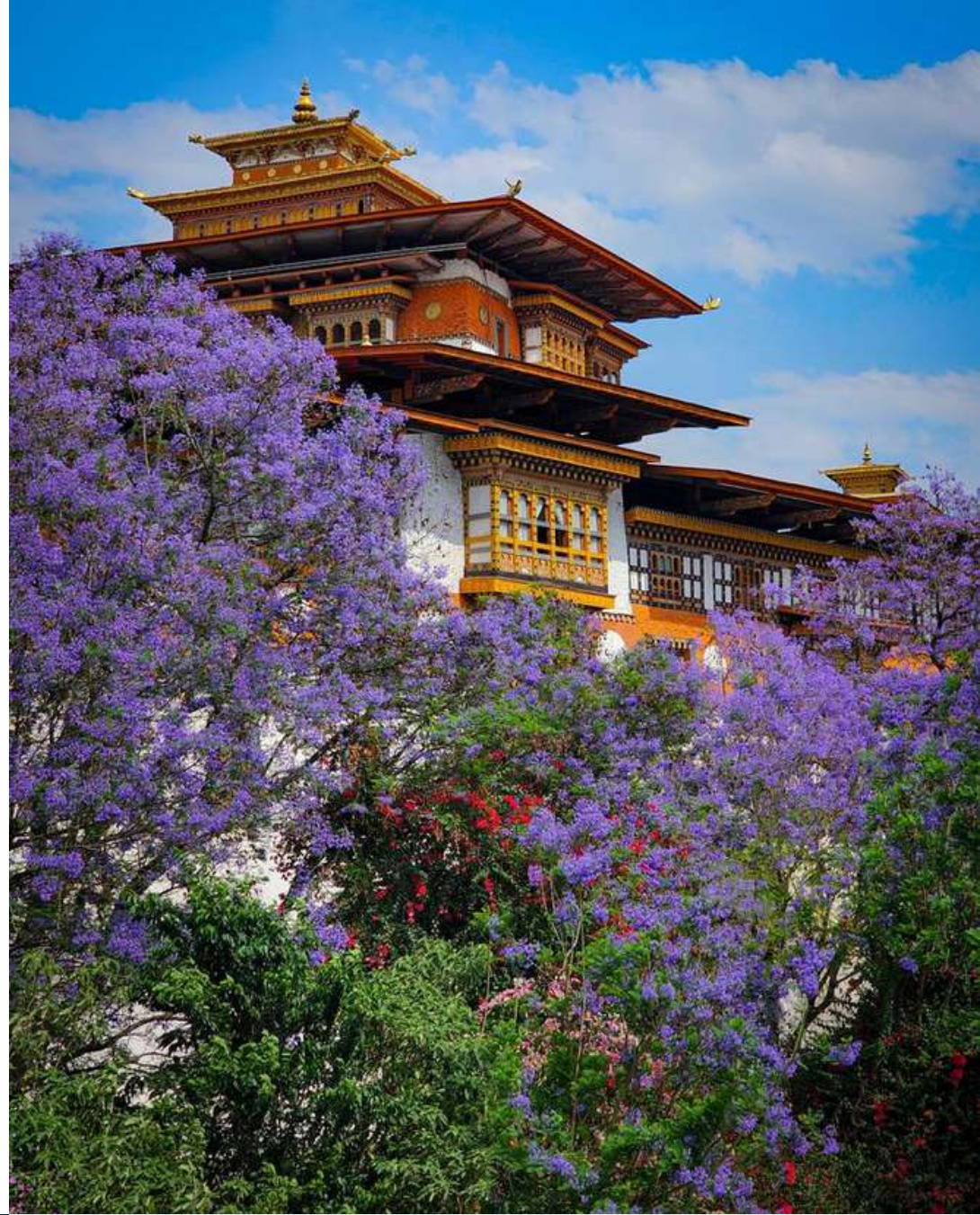
DAY 5

30th December

Dzongs, Rivers & The Road To Paro

After breakfast, we make our way towards Punakha, stopping to explore the magnificent Punakha Dzong and its iconic suspension bridge.

We then continue towards Paro, stopping at Chimi Lhakhang, popularly known as the Fertility Temple.



Once in Paro, experience a little Bhutanese dressing-up moment by trying traditional attire and capturing photographs against the majestic Paro Dzong and the National Museum of Bhutan.

Overnight Stay: Paro

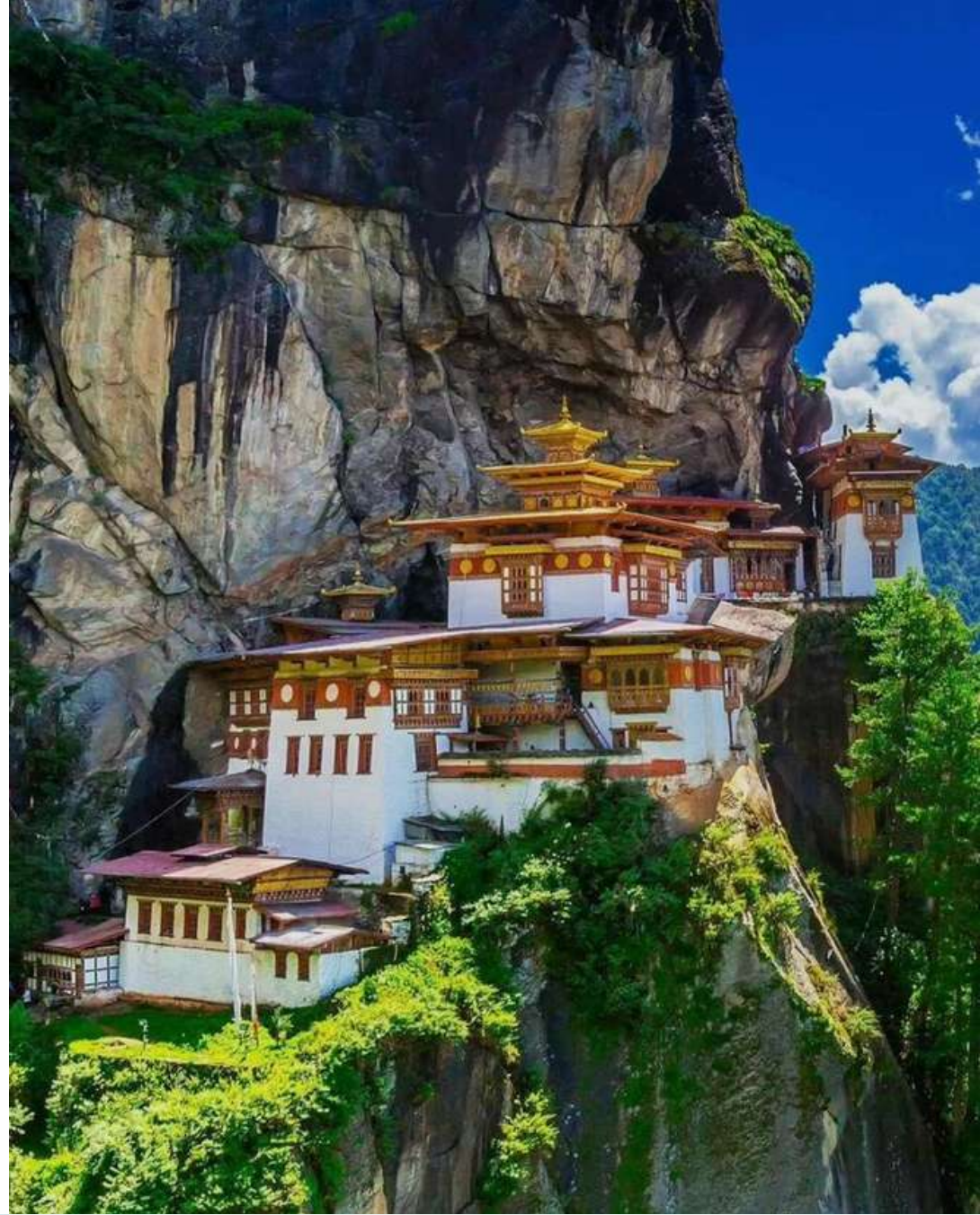
DAY 6 31st December

The Tiger's Nest

Today is the big one.

We'll take on the iconic hike to Tiger's Nest Temple, one of Bhutan's most remarkable heritage sites, dramatically perched on a sheer cliff above the Paro Valley.

The hike takes around three hours for an average hiker, passing through beautiful, shady pine forests. Depending on your pace, the experience can take most of the day.



After making your way back, it's time to slow down and recover.

End the day with a traditional Bhutanese Hot Stone Bath, especially rewarding after conquering the Tiger's Nest trail.

1st January

One Last Taste Of Bhutan

After breakfast, we'll spend the first half of the day exploring more of Paro, including the National Museum of Bhutan. Later, begin our drive back towards Phuntsholing, taking in the changing landscapes one last time.



Before reaching Phuntsholing, we'll make a halt at Sangay Minjurling Monastery, adding one final cultural experience to the journey.

After breakfast, we begin our drive towards Bagdogra Airport, bringing our Bhutan adventure to an end.

THINGS TO CARRY

- Id proof: Carry an original photo id (passport) when you come for the trip. Two copies of your passport and Travel Insurance. This is Mandatory.
- Warm clothes: Carry all warm layers (Sweaters & Jackets)
- Woollen socks, mufflers, and gloves: It is a must as it gets very cold in Bhutan
- Carry 2-3 layers of fleece/inner warmers
- Get caps, hats, and sunglasses
- Get trekking shoes and also flip-flops
- Sun lotion: You don't want your skin to burn so kindly carry a sun lotion (SPF 50+ is advisable).
- Water bottle: We are against buying plastic bottles so kindly carry your own refillable water bottle
- Sanitisers and face masks: We urge everyone to carry masks and sanitisers for everyone's health benefit
- Sim Cards: Get international roaming activated or buy a local sim
- Power Bank
- Chocolates and light snacks: Chocolates help a lot during transfers so don't forget to carry a few. Carry other healthy snacks as well
- Personal Medications if any
