

ROUTINE FOR HANDLING PERSONAL DATA

By giving us the information about you and your guests to this event, you agree to the GDPR policy of Experience Scania.

Experience Scania collect relevant personal data for our assignments in order to plan and execute the event. All data collected will be handled in accordance to the applicable data protection regulations. The data might be transferred to third party (external suppliers), such as for example hotels or other partners providing services during the event.

The data we collect could for example be name, title, phone number, e-mail, any allergies or food requirements etc. Each event coordinator is responsible to secure third-party personal data handling when giving the data externally.

The personal data that we gather will be saved for 5 years. We do this in order to be able to re-use for recurrent events/exhibitions, for invoicing and for any audits. After 5 years we depersonalize the data.

BU/MARKET RESPONSIBILITY

Scania CV AB is data controller for the central processing of personal data to facilitate participation in a certain event. It is very important that you as BU/Market is aware of the fact that you become a data controller when you receive data from us and that you then must ensure compliance with local data protection regulations.

If you, as BU/Market, gives us data in form of a name list for example (for an event) we will handle the information as mentioned above. If we hand over personal data from the event it is important that you are aware of your local processing and your local data protection regulations and handles the data in accordance with applicable laws.

According to the new law, all participants need to be informed how their personal data is processed. If event system AxacoAir aren't used for the individual registrations and instead is registered through you (via AxacoAir, Excel or other) following will apply:

- It is the responsibility of each business unit to inform their participants on how we process their personal data during this event
- If a business unit conducts local processing of this data the business unit remains data controller for the local processing and must ensure compliance with local data protection regulations

Scania demands that you process personal data in accordance with applicable laws, in particular the Swedish Personal Data Act (2018:18) and the EU General Data Protection Regulation (EU) 2016/679 ("GDPR").
