

# Cookie Policy

## 1. Introduction

- 1.1. Our Website ([www.saibongroup.com](http://www.saibongroup.com)) uses cookies and similar technologies. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our Website and also allows us to improve our Website.
- 1.2. Cookies are small text files that are downloaded to your device (e.g., your computer or smartphone). Cookies contain uniquely generated references which are used to distinguish you from other users. They allow information gathered on one webpage to be stored until it is needed for use on another, allowing our Website to provide you with a personalized experience (like remembering your favorites) and provide us with statistics about how you interact with our (and sometimes third party) Website.
- 1.3. Cookies are not harmful to your devices (like a virus or malicious code), but some individuals prefer not to share their information, for example, to avoid targeted advertising.
- 1.4. You can read more about cookies and how they are regulated on The Swedish Post and Telecom Authority's website.

## 2. Different types of cookies

- 2.1. **Session vs. persistent cookies**  
Cookies have a limited lifespan. Cookies which only last a short time or end when you close your browser are called session cookies. Cookies which remain on your device for longer are called persistent cookies (these are the type of cookies that allow websites to remember your details when you log back onto them).
- 2.2. **First party vs. third party cookies**  
Cookies placed on your device by the website owner are called first party cookies. When the website owner uses other businesses'

technology to help them manage and monitor their website, the cookies added by the other business are called third party cookies.

### 2.3. **Categories of cookies**

Cookies can be grouped by what they help the website, or website owner do:

**Necessary cookies** are cookies that make the website useful and help it run properly (when they are strictly necessary cookies, it means their only function is to help the website work). Without necessary cookies, the website cannot function optimally,

**Performance cookies** help a website owner understand and analyze how a user uses a website in order to personalize content and remember user preferences (such as language preference),

**Analytical cookies** are used to understand how visitors interact with the website. These cookies help provide information on metrics the number of visitors, bounce rate, etc.,

**Marketing cookies** tailor online adverts. Marketing cookies are used to track how users move between different websites. Marketing Cookies aim to offer you relevant advertisements and recommendations based on the content you have previously browsed and your previous interest.

## 3. **Purpose of cookies**

### 3.1. **We use cookies:**

- 3.1.1. to track how visitors use our Website,
- 3.1.2. to record whether you have seen specific messages we display on our Website,
- 3.1.3. to keep you signed into our Website,
- 3.1.4. where we post content and links to content, we use cookies to capture and analyze information such as the number of views and shares.

## 4. What cookies do we use?

4.1. The cookies we use on our Website are:

<b>Cookie</b>	<b>Purpose</b>	<b>What it does</b>	<b>How long it lasts</b>
Access_token	Authorization	Make sure users is logged in	5 minutes
Refresh_token	Authorization	Is exchanged for a new access_token	1 day
Code_verifier	Authorization	Is used to make sure authorization flow is followed correctly	Session based
i18next (server)	Localization	Saves the language code of the browser to use for localization of content	1 year
i18next (client)	localization	Saves the language code of the browser to use for localization of content	Session based

4.2. We can only use cookies with your permission. When you visit our Website for the first time, you will be prompted by a message, also known as a cookie banner, where you can choose to accept or decline our cookies.

4.3. You can update your cookies settings and permissions on our Website by [www.saibongroup.com](http://www.saibongroup.com).

4.4. You can always choose to decline the use of cookies. However, if you turn off necessary cookies, some pages and functions on our Website may not work correctly. You can also manage cookies through your browser settings or device settings.
