



School visits to Our Lady's Home of Compassion Ideas for Secondary School Students:

Activities

- Heritage Centre Activity Booklet

(Learn about the history of the Sisters of Compassion and their continuation today through student led investigation.)
- Nature walk at Manawa Karioi Reserve to Historic Reservoir

(Go on a nature walk through Te Manawa Karioi Reserve to learn about the history of the land, the leadership of key people, and see the Historic Reservoir. The walk is between 30-45mins and requires good walking shoes and a decent level of fitness.)
- Host your own Liturgy in The Chapel of Our Lady of Compassion

(The experience of creating a liturgy and being a part of it is important for student engagement and spiritual benefit. Designed to be organised in advance, you can use our PowerPoint template to build your own liturgy. Students are encouraged to read scripture, poetry and prayers of intercession. Please ask for the template when you book)
- Visit The Chapel of Our Lady of Compassion and the Resting Place of Meri Hōhepa Suzanne Aubert.

(Spend time in meaningful reflection and take the opportunity to pay your respects to Venerable Meri Hōhepa Suzanne Aubert. This is a good time to reflect on your visit and the themes you have explored as a group).
- Explore Catholic Social Teaching

(Learn about Catholic Social Teaching Principles and their relevance today through drama, discussion, and/or group projects.)
- Overnight Retreat

(Stay overnight in our accommodation rooms. This allows evening access to the Chapel and grounds to enjoy further reflection and community prayer).
