

By encouraging students to voice their opinions in a group setting, GDs create a supportive environment that validates individual contributions. This process plays a vital role in addressing imposter syndrome—a common experience among students who question their abilities despite their achievements. Through GDs, they learn to trust their knowledge and express it confidently, a skill that extends beyond placements into other aspects of life.

GDs teach students how to respect differing viewpoints and build on others' ideas, fostering a sense of collaboration. The ability to summarize discussions and propose solutions helps students stand out. These experiences prepare them for future professional scenarios, where teamwork and communication would play vital roles.

Beyond placements, the skills gained through GDs equip them for lifelong personal and professional growth. For the students, each GD is more than a challenge—it is an opportunity to learn, grow, and shine.

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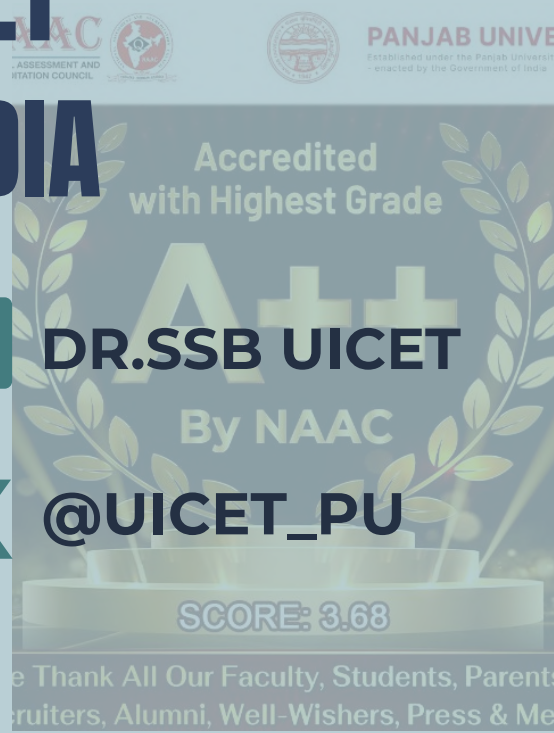
