Primarily, that means websites. Occasionally, it means broader product and interface work.

What You'll Actually Do

- Design end-to-end website experiences UX flows, wireframes, and polished UI, primarily in Figma
- Build scalable, modular design systems: reusable components, clear tokens, and layouts that hold up as projects grow
- Design for modular WordPress builds (or similar CMS-driven systems), thinking in blocks and templates, not one-off pages
- Collaborate directly with the team (and sometimes clients) to translate briefs into structured, thoughtful design
- Set your own milestones and hit them
- Own projects and support senior designers.

What We're Looking For

- 2–3 years of experience designing websites, design systems, or scalable digital products.
- Strong command of Figma (components, auto-layout, variables, prototyping) and working fluency in Illustrator and the broader Adobe suite
- A good understanding of Claude Code, Gemini, or any other AI tools.
- A portfolio that shows shipped websites and systems thinking: how your designs were structured, componentized, and built
- Sharp fundamentals: typography, layout, hierarchy, and interaction details
- Clear written communication (as a remote team, we run on clarity)
- AI-forward mindset: A good understanding of AI tools like Claude Code, Gemini, or similar, and a genuine openness to learning and folding them into your workflow. You don't need to be an expert, but you shouldn't be resistant either

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How We Work (Read This Part Carefully)

We're a high-ownership team. Here's what that means in practice:

- We don't chase. Nobody will follow up on your tasks. You commit to milestones, you communicate proactively, and you deliver.
- You set your own milestones. We agree on outcomes and timelines together, then the how is yours.
- Generalists thrive here. You'll touch things adjacent to your core role. If that excites you rather than scares you, you'll fit right in.
- Lean means visible. Your work won't disappear into a large team. What you design is what ships.
