

Pythas Privacy Policy

Last update: Jul 28th, 2023

This Privacy Notice describes how Pythas collects and processes your personal information through the Pythas website and applications that reference this Privacy Policy. Pythas refers to an ecosystem comprising Pythas website www.pythas.io. “Pythas Operators” refers to all parties that run Pythas, including but not limited to legal persons, unincorporated organizations and teams that provide Pythas Services and are responsible for such services, “Pythas” as used in this Policy includes Pythas Operators.

This Privacy Policy applies to all platforms, websites, and departments of Pythas and Pythas Operators. By using Pythas Services, you are consenting to the collection, storage, processing and transfer to your personal information as described in this Privacy Policy.

1. INFORMATION COLLECTION AND USE

Pythas collects information from you in several different ways on the Site. One goal in collecting personal information from you is to provide an efficient, meaningful and customized experience.

Pythas may also use scoring methods to assess and manage risk.
Information about your behavior: Pythas may process information about you on your behavior and your activity for marketing and advertising purposes.	- Improve Pythas Services. Pythas processes personal information to improve our services and for you to have a better user experience.
Information about your preferences and for the purpose of contests or marketing campaigns: Pythas may process information about your behavior through voluntary surveys or if you voluntarily participate in one of Pythas marketing campaigns.	- Recommendations and personalisation. 2. AGE REQUIREMENT

Pythas do not knowingly collect information from Users authorized applicants under the age of 18 and/or their Internet usage, and such persons are not authorized to use Pythas Services. If Pythas obtain actual knowledge that an applicant is under the age of 18, then Pythas will take steps to remove that user's personal information from our databases. By using Pythas Services, you as a user authorized applicant represent that you are at least 18 years old. You also represent, by accessing or using Pythas Services, that you are of legal age to enter into legal agreements, or if you are not, that you have obtained from your company, entity or organization consent to accept the terms in this Privacy Policy.

3. USER RIGHTS, CHOICES AND DISCLOSURES

(a) General

- (i) Pythas provides herein certain specific disclosures on privacy rights set forth below. Pythas is committed to facilitate the exercise of your rights as a user of Pythas Services granted by the laws of your jurisdiction, which may include the right to request the correction, modification, or deletion of your personal information and the right to opt out of the sale of your personal information (as applicable). Pythas will do the best to honor your requests subject to any legal and contractual obligations. Although Pythas may do so at its discretion, Pythas does not delete your information upon request, unless required to do so under applicable law.
- (ii) You may opt out of receiving electronic marketing communications from us by clicking next to the "unsubscribe" link on the communication or contacting Pythas at info@pythas.io. Some non-marketing communications may not be subject to general opt-out, such as fulfilling Pythas obligations when services are requested and disclosures to comply with legal requirements, software updates and other support-related information.

- (ii) Subject to local law, you may have additional rights under the laws of your jurisdiction regarding your personal data, such as the right to complain to your local data protection authority.
- (iv) You may be able to disable Cookies through your browser settings, but if you delete or disable Cookies, you may experience interruptions or limited functionality in certain areas of the Services.

(b) California Disclosures

- Pursuant to the California “Shine the Light” information-sharing disclosure requirements, California residents may request a list of all third parties with respect to which Pythas has disclosed any information about you for direct marketing purposes and the categories of information disclosed. If you are a California resident and want such list, please send Pythas a written request by email to info@pythas.io with “California Shine The Light Rights” in the subject line.
- (ii) Pursuant to the California Do Not Track disclosure requirements we do not respond to Do Not Track browser settings.
- (iii) Pursuant to the California Privacy Act (“CCPA”) disclosure requirements, California residents have the right to request:
 - The categories of personal information Pythas has collected about you;
 - The categories of sources from which the personal information is collected;
 - The business or commercial purpose of collecting or selling personal information;
 - The categories of third parties with whom Pythas share or sell personal information;
 - The categories of personal information about you that Pythas has sold; and
 - The specific pieces of personal information Pythas has collected about you.

Additionally, you have the right to request deletion of your personal information, the right to opt out of the sale of your information (if applicable) and the right not to be discriminated against for exercising any of your CCPA rights.

4. STORAGE OF DATA; DATA SECURITY

Pythas retains the personal information collected for as long as reasonably necessary to fulfill the purposes for which the data was collected and to perform Pythas contractual and legal obligations. Notwithstanding the generality of the foregoing, Pythas stores email addresses and phone numbers until the user requests to be unsubscribed or removes themselves through any self-service tools offered to the user.

Pythas website incorporates physical, electronic, and administrative procedures to safeguard the confidentiality of your personal information, including Secure Sockets Layer (“SSL”) for all transactions through the website. Pythas uses SSL encryption to protect your personal information online, and also takes several measures to protect your personal information in our facilities. Access to your personal information is restricted. Only authorized employees who need access to your personal information to perform a specific job are granted access to your personal information.

Finally, Pythas relies on third party service providers for the physical security of some of our computer hardware. Pythas requires those third-party service providers to comply with commercially reasonable security practices and measures. While Pythas uses industry-standard precautions to safeguard your personal information, Pythas cannot and do not guarantee complete security. 100% complete security does not presently exist anywhere online or offline. As such, you assume the risk of security breaches and all consequences resulting from them. To that end, please safeguard your credentials.

5. JURISDICTION

Pythas website is controlled, operated and hosted in the United States. Please be advised that through your continued use of Pythas Services, which is governed by California law, this Privacy Policy, and Pythas Terms of Use, your personal information will be held in the United States and you expressly consent thereto and consent to be governed by California law for these purposes.
