NVR quick checks

- C** - In A, B, D and E, the line is at the next corner clockwise from the dot; C reverses this relationship.
- E** - A-D have one more outer side than inner side; E has two more.
- B** - A, C, D and E belong to one rotation family; B is a reflection.
- D** - A, B, C and E have one fewer dot than sides. D has three sides but only one dot.
- A** - In B-E, the clockwise cell order is circle, line, empty cell, triangle. A reverses this order. Compare positions, not rotation of the entire drawing.
- C** - A, B, D and E have the clockwise order dot, square, triangle, empty quadrant; C reverses it.
- E** - In A-D, the inner polygon has two fewer sides than the outer; E has one fewer.
- B** - A, C, D and E belong to one rotation family; B is a reflection.
- D** - A, B, C and E have six pips in total; D has five.
- A** - B-E point clockwise away from the black corner; A points anticlockwise.
