

Use the following worksheets before, during, and after reading 'Feelings' to deepen your understanding of the book.




Making Predictions:

Before Reading


Read the first page of 'Feelings.' Then, use what you have just read, the front cover illustration, and the back cover blurb to make some predictions about what you think will happen in the story.





EEE During Reading
