

INFORMATION & APPLICATION RULES AND REQUIREMENTS

The student shall:

1. Be in good academic standing as a 2024 approved candidate for graduation from an accredited Greater Williamsburg Area high school to include James City County, Williamsburg, the Bruton area of upper York County, and Grove.
2. Have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of at least 2.5.
3. Complete all requirements and graduate from your enrolled high school in 2024.
4. Return a completed application with all supporting documents.
5. Be recommended by a member of the arts faculty at your high school.
6. The principal of the winning student's school must certify that the selected student attends full time and is enrolled in a Greater Williamsburg Area accredited high school. Homeschool students should email WAC23187@gmail.com for more information.
7. Provide a letter of acceptance to attend an accredited college or university to continue your education in the arts.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE AND REQUIREMENTS

Students from the following areas are eligible to apply: Williamsburg; James City County area surrounding Williamsburg city; the Bruton area of upper York County; Jamestown, and Grove.

Submit the following:

1. Completed and signed application form.
2. High school or homeschool transcript along with listed courses and grades.
3. At least one, and no more than three, letters of recommendation from someone familiar with your talent. One letter must be from your high school art teacher.
4. Statement of your career aspirations and motivation for studying art. Consider the following when preparing your statement:
 1. What does the study of art mean to me?
 2. Why do I plan to study art in the next phase of my education?
 3. What type of degree or program do I seek to enter and why?
 4. What sort of special qualities or experiences do I have that will make me the best candidate for this scholarship?
5. At least one and up to three pieces of your artwork with your application in jpeg format.
