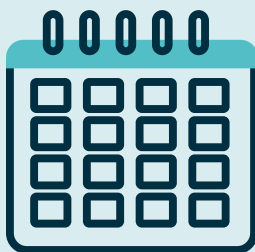
- Length: 800–1,000 words (Essays outside this range will be disqualified)

- **Anonymous review:** Each essay gets a unique code.
- **Fair process:** Reviewed by 3 volunteer English teachers.
- **Standard rubric:** Same criteria for everyone (see P2P website).
- **Final score:** Average of all three reviews.

The final decision will be made by Dr. Chun-Shin Taylor and Dr. David Sohn considered the averaged score and the reviewers' comments.
