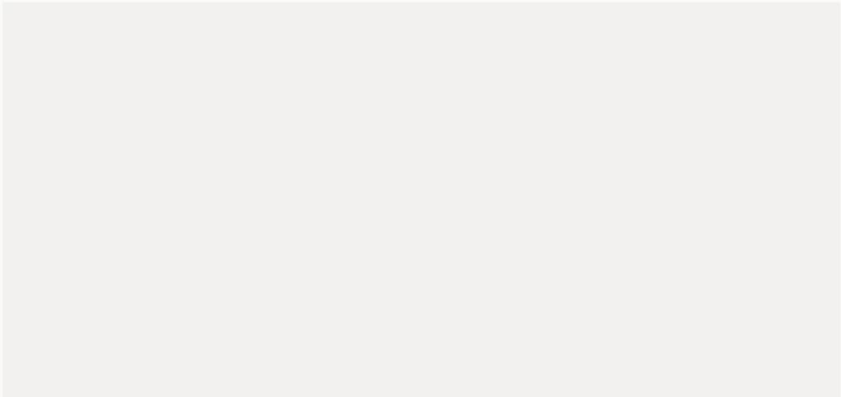
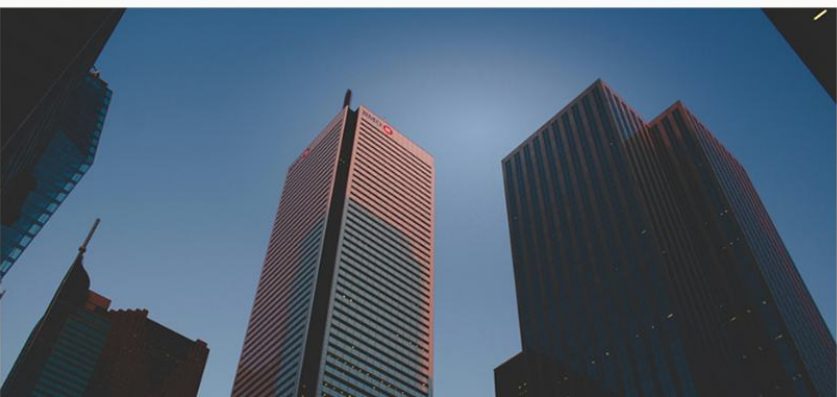
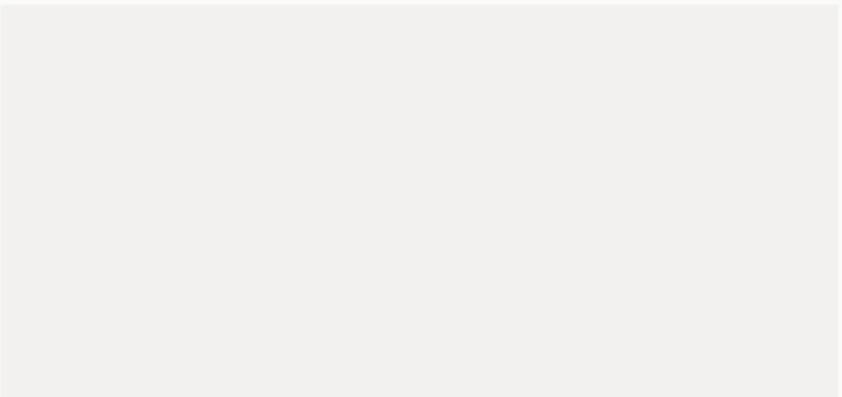
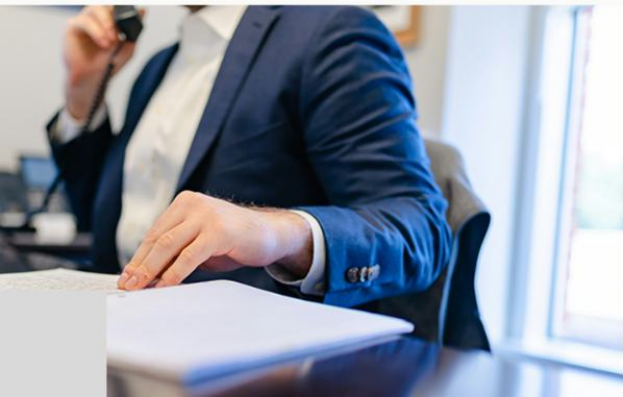
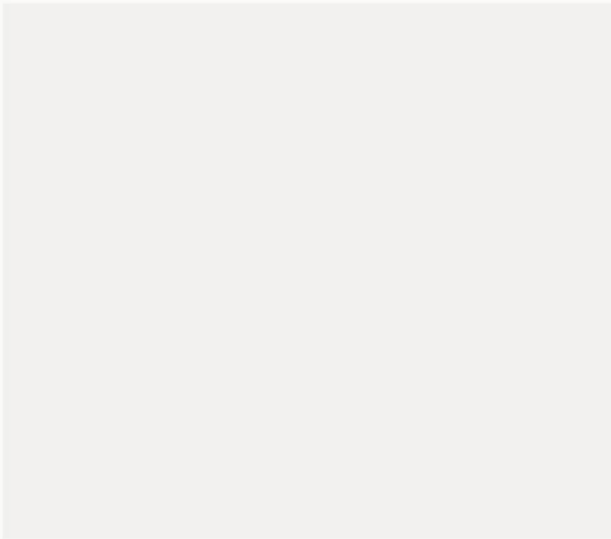
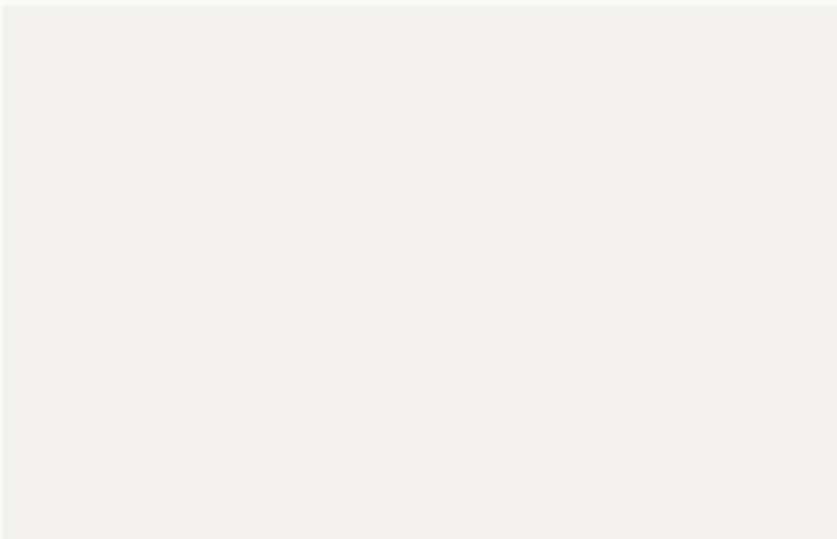
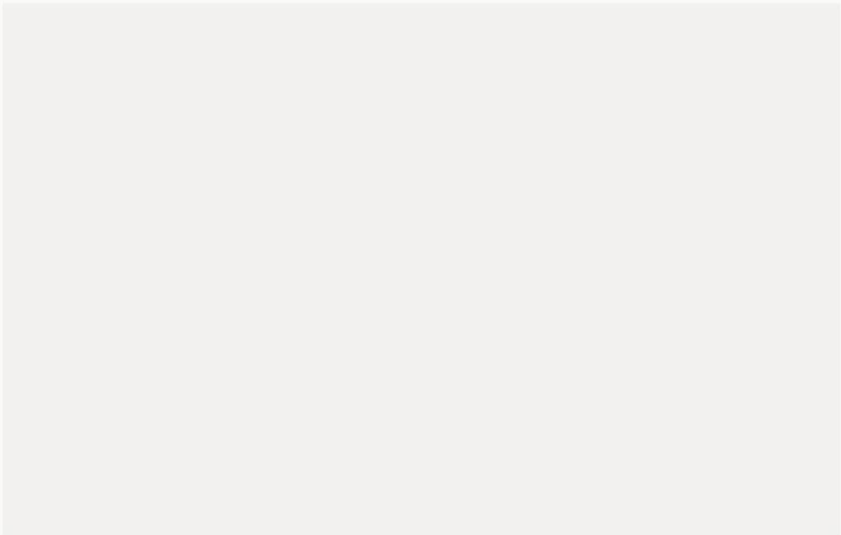
The world moves faster than the board cycle.

Our competitors are making increasingly aggressive claims about AI-driven productivity, new commercial models, and faster delivery. What signals should our board be watching to understand whether AI is materially reshaping competition in IT services, where the greatest threats are emerging, and whether our current strategy is moving quickly enough?

I found relevant context across the Q3 Board Book, FY2027 Strategic Plan, Competitive Landscape Review, and Market & Customer Update. I'm comparing that against recent competitor filings, earnings calls, market data, and external research to identify the shifts most relevant to the board.

Analysis complete. I found four signals that appear most material: accelerating competitor AI investment, emerging AI-linked pricing models, changing enterprise buying criteria, and increased concentration of AI talent and partnerships among leading peers. The first two show the clearest evidence of near-term competitive impact.

Competitor AI investment is moving from experimentation to scale. Recent filings and earnings commentary show leading peers expanding dedicated AI teams, building proprietary platforms, and embedding generative AI across core offerings. This is consistent with the competitive risks identified in the Q3 Board Book, but the pace of external investment has accelerated since that material was prepared.

Commercial models are also beginning to shift. Several peers are introducing usage-based, outcome-oriented, and AI-specific pricing designed to capture more of the value created through automation. If adoption continues, these models could reset customer expectations around productivity, pricing, and
