● Admission Requirements

Applicants must submit the following documents:

- Original bachelor's degree certificate or transcript (in English or Arabic).
- If applicable, an Equivalency Decision from the Egyptian Supreme Council of Universities for private or international university graduates.
- Original computerized birth certificate.
- Copy of the national ID or passport.
- Two recent passport-sized photos.
- Updated resume.
- English Language Proficiency:

Applicants must demonstrate English proficiency through one of the following:

- IELTS: Minimum score 5.
- TOEFL ITP: 500 | TOEFL IBT: 59–60.
- ESLSCA ITEP placement test: Minimum score 2.5.
- Successful performance in a personal interview.

● Important Notes:

- A 10% penalty will be applied to any overdue balance (in both EGP and EUR) if payment is not completed within five working days from the date of registration.
- Failure to meet the payment deadline without an approved postponement request will result in a penalty fee, except in cases of force majeure, provided valid supporting documentation is submitted.
- Dropping an academic year or semester will incur a readmission fee (contact Student Accounting for details).
- Credit balance will automatically be applied towards future semester fees.
- Refunds are only issued in cases of complete withdrawal from the University or upon graduation.
- Students who withdraw from a course and choose to retake it at a later date will be required to pay the current course fees at the time of re-enrollment, regardless of any remaining balance from the previously dropped course.
