

there.do launches its free AI-powered voice note mobile app, dedicated to the construction industry

Press release *Paris, April 1st, 2026. — Six months after its commercial launch, there.do officially announces the availability of [there Notes](#), the AI note-taking app dedicated to the construction industry.*

Be there. Hands free on site, head up in meetings.

That's the promise of there notes. Specialized in site reports for project managers and architects, the French startup there.do is launching at BIM World 2026 this free AI-powered mobile voice notes app, open to all construction professionals. Available on iOS and Android, it allows users to capture voice notes, photos, and text on site — even offline — and lets AI automatically produce a structured note.

There notes is designed for construction professionals: architects, project managers, site supervisors, and field experts — people whose work takes place on site or in site meetings, far from a desk. The user starts an audio recording, describes out loud what they observe, takes photos at the same time, then simply stops. The AI transcribes, captions the photos, and produces a structured note in whatever language was spoken.

The goal isn't to document more — it's to free up attention at the moment it matters most: watching the site, listening to the people around you, engaging with the teams, without looking down at a screen to take notes. Capture happens at the right time. Formatting is automatic. At the end of the day, you don't piece things together. You just go home.

"It's an absolutely incredible reference tool. I've stopped taking notes by hand. I look at the site. We need to be more efficient on-site so we can spend a little more time at home."

The app is **free, with no user limits and no subscription**. Notes can be shared across an entire organization, via public link or by email invitation to a third party without an account. It works offline.

Launched a year ago, there note is used by teams at Chabanne, Unanime, Ingerop, and Vinci. At BIM World, there.do is not presenting a beta version, but twelve months of field feedback from these teams.

We want to equip construction professionals with an AI notes app tailored to their trade. With offline functionality and photo capture, there notes enables, for the first time, a usage truly built for the job site.
