

RESOLUTION NO. 2025- 2

A RESOLUTION REGARDING THE COUNTY OF SANGAMON'S  
POLICIES WHICH ARE INAPPLICABLE TO THE  
VETERANS ASSISTANCE COMMISSION OF SANGAMON COUNTY

**WHEREAS**, Section 45/9(g) of the Illinois Military Veterans Assistance Act, 330 ILCS 45/1 et seq. ("MVAA"), requires the Veteran's Assistance Commission of Sangamon County ("VAC" or "Commission") to, in writing, adopt all applicable policies established and in place in Sangamon County ("County") and adapt those policies to fit its organizational structure; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 45/9(g) of the MVAA provides that those policies which have been adapted to and adopted by the VAC shall then be the policies of the Veterans Assistance Commission, and they shall be implemented and adhered to by the Superintendent and Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, the Superintendent and the Veterans Assistance Commission have considered the County of Sangamon's policies to determine which are applicable to VAC operations and which are not;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Delegates of the Veterans Assistance Commission of Sangamon County, as follows:

**Section 1.** The foregoing recitals shall be and are hereby incorporated as findings of fact as if said recitals were fully set forth herein.

**Section 2.** The Commission hereby finds that the following policies of the County of Sangamon are inapplicable to the Veterans Assistance Commission's operations and therefore need not be adopted or adapted as a policy of the Commission:


1. That County policy which addresses flag protocols;
2. That County policy addressing budget carryovers;
3. That County policy addressing accounting for and the use of proceeds from the sale of tort immunity bonds;
4. That County policy addressing 30-day position vacancies;
5. That County policy regarding the personal use of County vehicles;
6. That County policy regarding fixed and capital assets;
7. That County policy regarding the disposition of surplus property;
8. That County policy regarding the management of grants;
9. That County policy regarding capitalization and useful life;
10. That County policy regarding petty cash; and,
11. Any other County policy not referenced above nor otherwise specifically adopted and adapted by VAC Resolution 2025-1,
