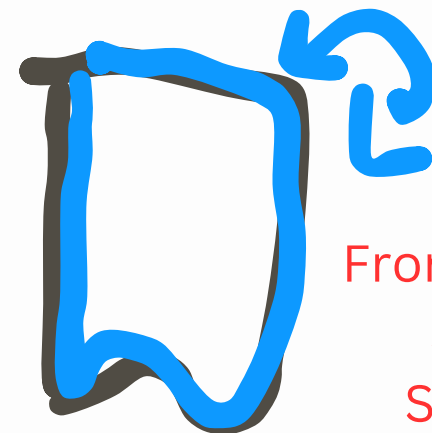

# Process: Lasting

## 'Last' Prep



Example of one way

Soak Insole

Nail the sole to the last

Bind Insole with rubber strips

8 hours

## Upper Prep★

Soak Boot Upper in Water

[lasting plier] pull leather to accommodate curves

\*hoisting (1 - 1 3/4)

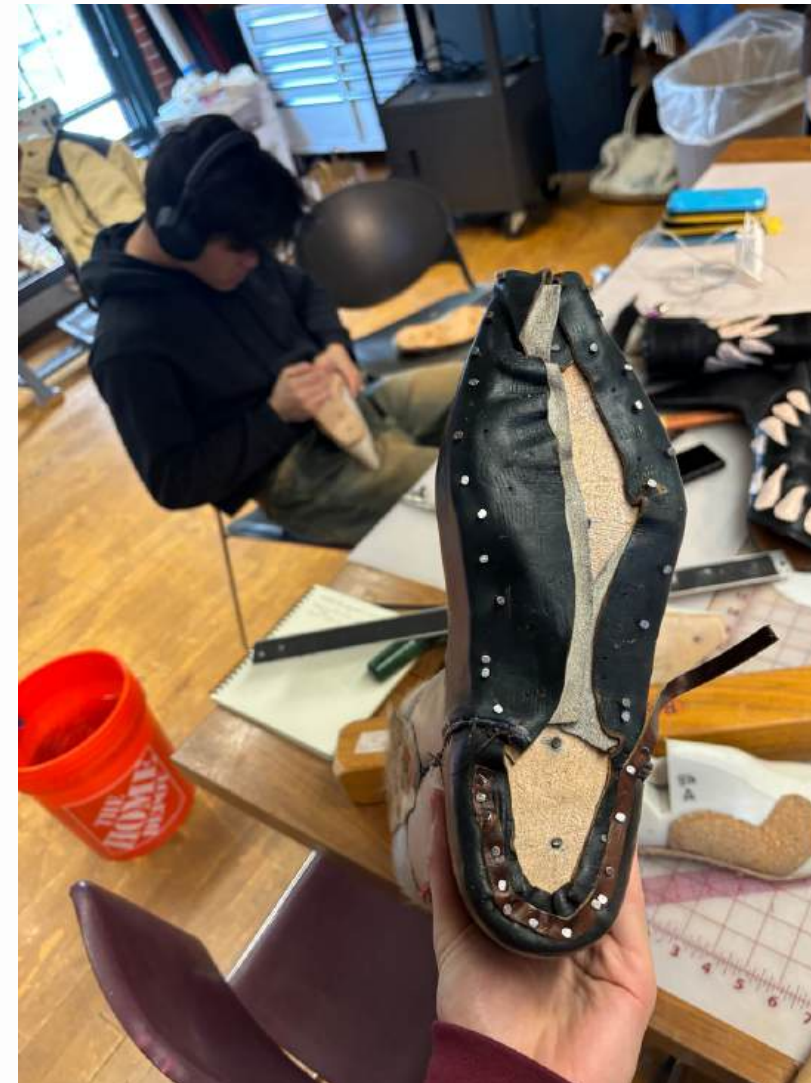
\*secure front with nails

\*secure sides with nails while in leverage

\*release the hoist and nail the back

\*re-nail the front / side / sides

\*use wiping strip to get rid of bubbles



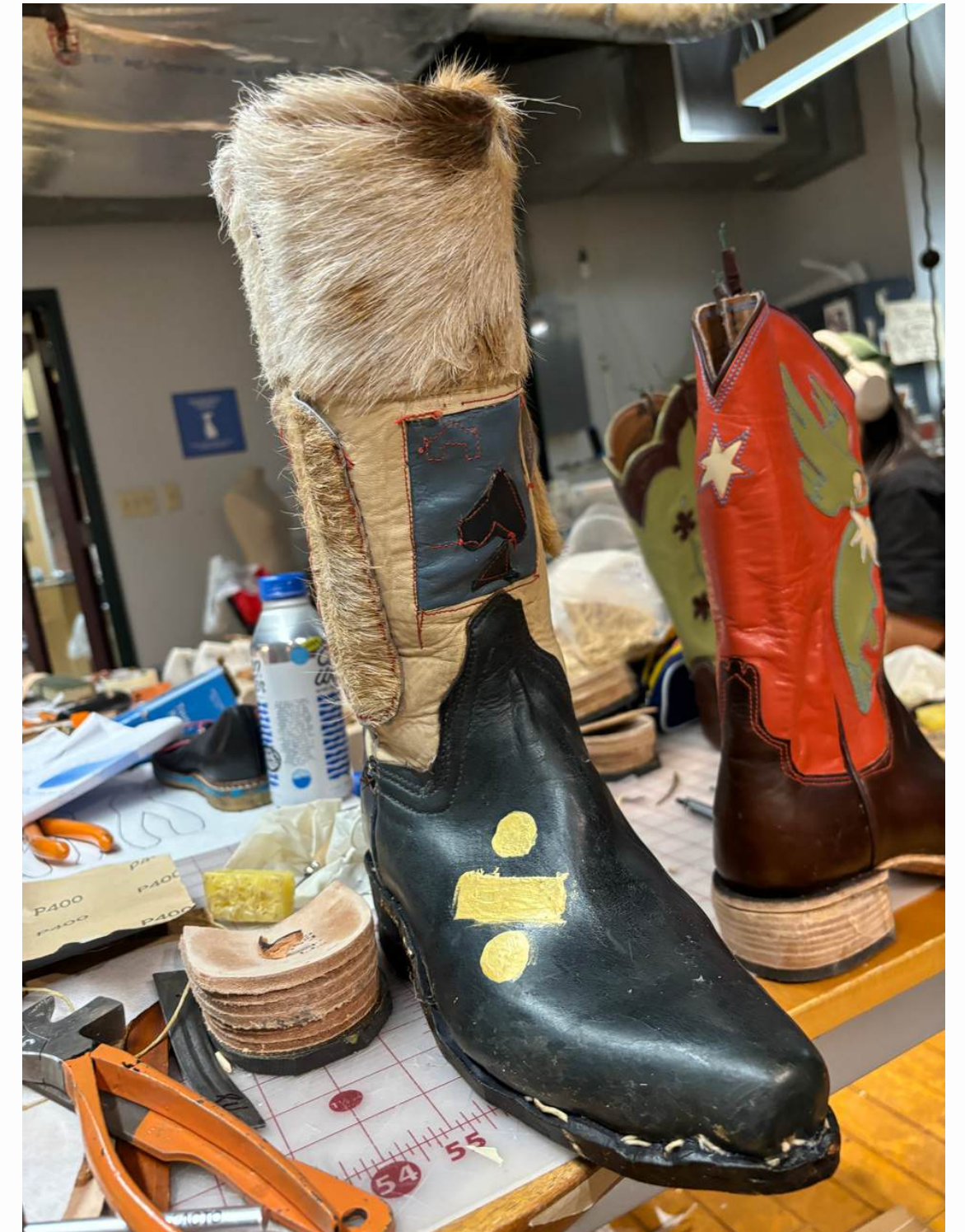

## Bottom Preparation

### Basic Preparation

- Trim about 1 in
- Bend Shank
- Skive Shank
- Cover



Glue all the parts together (+ cork for filling)

### Sole Preparation

- Soak Sole of Boot / Trim
- Dye the area until the feathline - heel (featherline)

2 hours

## Combining

Wooden peg the pieces together to the feather line



8 hours

## Cleaning Up

- Trim the Front Area (did not choose to stitch)
- Trim the back sole leather
- Sand Heel to shape
- Glue the Heel to back
- Nail the Heel to Shoe

## Refining ★

Use Skiving knife to trim around the back edge closer to edge

Trim away the Middle side distances

13 hours

## Oil and Shine ★

1. Leather Lotion (2x)
2. Acrylic Paint
3. Pro Resist
4. Leather Lotion (2x)
5. Shoe Polish
6. Protecting Leather Lotion (2x)

## Insoles for Wearing ★

1. Click thick leather (shiny side bottom) with excess

2. Soak Leather

3. Place it into Boot and let it dry
