


AI prompt to 10X your resume writing

Hiring managers ask two questions when reading your resume: Can you do the job, and how effective will you be? Writing the experience section of your resume using the **M.O.O. structure*** answers both.



Example: Implemented targeted email marketing campaign using Klaviyo **[Method]** to increase candidate pool for a recruitment company **[Objective]**, resulting in a 15% increase in qualified applicants within six months **[Outcome]**.

How to use the prompt

1. Copy and paste entire prompt into your AI tool (ChatGPT and Claude work best) ----->

2. Leave M.O.O. placeholders so you can identify them in returned prompts ----->

3. Replace final two placeholders with your role title and company name (if well known) or industry ----->

AI prompt

You're an experienced resume writer. You always use the following format when writing the experience section of someone's resume;

Method - this explains what someone did and how they did it (e.g what tools were used)

Objective - this is the reason they were doing what they did

Outcome - this is the quantifiable outcome of their actions

Here's an example;

Developed a cold calling script using Aircaller [method], to build a prospect pipeline [objective], resulting in a 10% year on year increase in sales [outcome].

Using the above structure, write 5 dot-points that a **[insert role title]** **[at company / in industry]** could put in the experience section of their resume.
