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DECISION ARCHITECTURE

High-stakes decisions fail – not from missing information, but from structural ambiguity. When responsibility is diffused and the decision itself is unclear, pressure forces action before the real question has been named.

THE OFFERING

Short engagements, scoped to a single decision or inflection point. I clarify what is actually being decided, separate real constraints from perceived ones, locate where responsibility sits, and map what action, delay, or avoidance will cost. This is neither research nor implementation. It is clarification at the point where information has done all it can.

THE OUTPUT

A structural diagnosis of the decision itself. The engagement ends when the decision is made, formally deferred, or structurally reframed.

INTENDED FOR

Decision-makers who are at the Y-point and information is no longer the constraint. Energy, infrastructure, AI governance, legal, and regulatory contexts.
