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AutoVRse Privacy Policy

TDW TECHNOLOGIES INC, operating and conducting business under the name “**AutoVRse**”, and its affiliates (hereinafter referred to variously as “AutoVRse”, “us”, “our” or “we” based on the context) are dedicated to protecting the privacy rights of our users (“users”, “you” or “your”).

This Privacy Policy (the “Policy”) describes the ways we collect, store, use, and manage the information, including personal information, that you may provide or we collect in connection with your use of our VR (Virtual Reality) application, “VRseBuilder”, and/or all related software, accompanying manual(s), related packaging and other written, files, electronic or on-line materials or documentation, onboarding services, training material, “how-to” / “do-it-yourself” content, virtual / in-person training content, documentation, material, video-recordings / transcripts of calls, meetings, training sessions, consultation calls, any and all copies of the same, including any updates thereto (collectively, hereinafter referred to, unless repugnant to the context as “VRseBuilder”).

Please note that the scope of this Policy is limited to information collected or received by AutoVRse through your use of “VRseBuilder”. AutoVRse is not responsible for the actions of third-party people or companies, the content of their sites, the use of information you provide to them, or any products or services they may offer. Any link to those sites does not constitute our sponsorship, approval of, or affiliation with, those people or companies. By using VRseBuilder, you are expressing your agreement to this Policy and the processing of your data, including your personal information, in the manner provided in this Policy. Data Collection and Usage

AutoVRse may collect information as described below. Our primary goals in collecting and using any information is to improve VRseBuilder, your user experience and apps we may make in the future, contact you, conduct research and create reports for our internal use.



Collection and Use of App Analytics Data

If you connect to the Internet when using VRseBuilder, we may receive information from hardware manufacturers or platform hosts (such as Valve, Oculus, Sony, HTC et al.) and may automatically collect certain information from your computer or VR unit. This information may include, but is not limited to, user / display names, app session data and scores, app progress, app performance, locations connected from, IP address, and your usage of various app features. All information collected by us is intended to be anonymous information that does not disclose your identity or constitute personal information, however, if you include personal information (such as your real name) in your user / display-name used with our platform hosts (such as Oculus, Steam et al.) or payment-partners / facilitators, then such personal information may automatically be transmitted and used as described herein. The information that is collected and/or provided to us by hardware manufacturers or platform hosts is useful to us for troubleshooting, improving VRseBuilder and your user experience, app statistics, performance et al. helps us understand usage trends. This information may be associated with your IP address or user ID for the purpose of providing you services or support in connection with VRseBuilder.

Various services on Oculus Platform may be used by us to track user-performance in VRseBuilder, and enhance the overall user experience, including but not limited to displaying high-scores on a leaderboard (which would also display the user's Oculus username / display name), cloud-storage (which may store the user's App progress, achievements, play-time, other in-App activities / actions on a remote server) et al. The cloud-storage services will primarily help enhance user-experience when the user logs in to their Oculus account across different hardware / devices, by saving their App progress and ensuring continuity in-App experience.

Various services of the GameAnalytics SDK are used for tracking specific user parameters, properties and in-App performance, including but not limited to Scoring Data (Level Score, Highest Combo, Lives Left, Pickup Count et al.) and also User ID / Identifier (to track if the user is a new / first-time user), country of origin, session length, number of attempts and / or score at particular levels etc. All these data-points are collected anonymously by GameAnalytics, and AutoVRse does not seek to personally identify any user specifically using these data points.



Customer Service

We may collect your email address when you contact our customer service group and we may use that email address to contact you about your gaming experience with AutoVRse and notify you about company news and promotions. If you no longer wish to receive certain email notifications you may opt-out at any time by following the unsubscribe link located at the bottom of each communication or by emailing us at privacy.vrsebuilder@autovrse.in

App Updates

We may occasionally send you App updates, patches and related push notifications that may be of importance to you. If you do not wish to receive these types of updates, patches and notifications you should discontinue use of VRseBuilder or disconnect your computer or device from the Internet.

How We Use Information

We may use information collected through VRseBuilder or provided to us by hardware manufacturers and platform hosts for the purposes described in this Policy or disclosed to you in connection with VRseBuilder. For example, we may use your information to:

- operate and improve VRseBuilder and future apps we may make;
- understand you and your preferences to enhance your experience and enjoyment using VRseBuilder;
- respond to your comments and questions and provide customer service;
- provide and deliver products and services you request;
- send you related information, including confirmations, technical notices, updates, security alerts, and support and administrative messages; and
- link or combine it with other information we get from third parties and other users of VRseBuilder, to help understand your preferences and provide you with better services.

Disclosure of Your information

AutoVRse does not share your personal information (to the extent it is in possession of any) except as approved by you or as described below:

- We may engage other companies and individuals to perform services on our behalf. Example of these services include analyzing data and providing customer support. These



agents and service providers may have access to your personal information in connection with the performance of services for AutoVRse;

- We may release your information as permitted by law, such as to comply with a subpoena, or when we believe that release is appropriate to comply with the law; investigate fraud, respond to a government request, enforce or apply our rights; or protect the rights, property, or safety of us or our users, or others. This includes exchanging information with other companies and organizations for fraud protection;
- We may share your information in connection with any merger, sale of our assets, or a financing or acquisition of all or a portion of our business to another company. You will be notified via a notice on our site of any change in ownership of AutoVRse or our business; and
- We may share aggregate or anonymous information about you with hardware manufacturers, platform hosts, publishers, business partners, and other third parties, to the extent permitted by applicable law.

Changes to the Policy

We may update this privacy policy to reflect changes to our information practices. If we make any material changes we will notify you by email (sent to the e-mail address specified in your account) or by means of a notice on this Site prior to the change becoming effective. We encourage you to periodically review this page for the latest information on our privacy practices.

Security

AutoVRse takes reasonable measures to protect your information from unauthorized access or against loss, misuse or alteration by third parties. Although we make good faith efforts to store the information collected on in relation to VRseBuilder in a secure operating environment that is not available to the public, we cannot guarantee the absolute security of that information during its transmission or its storage on our systems. Further, while we attempt to ensure the integrity and security of our network and systems, we cannot guarantee that our security measures will prevent third-party “hackers” from illegally obtaining access to this information. We do not warrant or represent that your information will be protected against, loss, misuse, or alteration by third parties. No method of transmission over the Internet, or method of electronic storage, is 100% secure, however. Therefore, we cannot guarantee its absolute security.



Access and Accuracy

AutoVRse will use commercially reasonable efforts to provide access to your personally identifiable information (to the extent we are in possession of any) if you request such access in writing submitted to privacy.vrsebuilder@autovrse.in. Unless otherwise required under applicable law, AutoVRse reserves the right to deny access to your personally identifiable information: 1. when such denial of access is required by law; 2. when granting you access is reasonably likely to negatively impact other people's privacy; 3. when such access is cost prohibitive; or 4. when such requests are frivolous or made in bad faith. If you believe that the personally identifiable information maintained by AutoVRse about you is inaccurate or incomplete, you may notify AutoVRse in writing describing in details any inaccuracies or omissions, submitted to privacy.vrsebuilder@autovrse.in. Following receipt of such a properly submitted written notice, AutoVRse will, within a reasonable time period, use commercially reasonable efforts to, in its sole discretion, either: (a) amend or correct your personally identifiable information to reflect corrected or additional information provided by you, or (b) in connection with your personally identifiable information, make note of any claimed inaccuracies or omissions reflected in the notice submitted by you.

Data Retention

The data and information that we collect will be stored and maintained by AutoVRse until you instruct us otherwise, or, in our sole discretion, for the longer of: (a) for so long as is necessary or appropriate to carry out the purpose(s) for which such information was collected and (b) for so long as we are required to maintain such information by law or other applicable rules or regulations and your consent to such purposes remains valid after termination of our relationship with you.

Our Policy Regarding Children

AutoVRse recognizes the privacy interests of children and we encourage parents and guardians to take an active role in their children's use of VRseBuilder. VRseBuilder is not intended for children under the age of 13. AutoVRse does not target its services or VRseBuilder to children under the age of 13. AutoVRse does not knowingly collect personally identifiable information from children under the age of 13. If a parent or guardian becomes aware that his or her child has provided us with information without their consent, he or she should contact us at privacy.vrsebuilder@autovrse.in. We will delete such information from our files within a reasonable time.
