A public-surface benchmark of Calendly's core scheduling job, 40 customer workflows, and the five actions worth verifying next.

THE FINDING

Calendly is ready for the core scheduling job. Recovery is the clearest public gap.

Calendly documents end-to-end booking, availability, event-type updates, cancellation, and links. It does not document an agent action for reconnecting a failed calendar connection.

A SIMPLE QUESTION

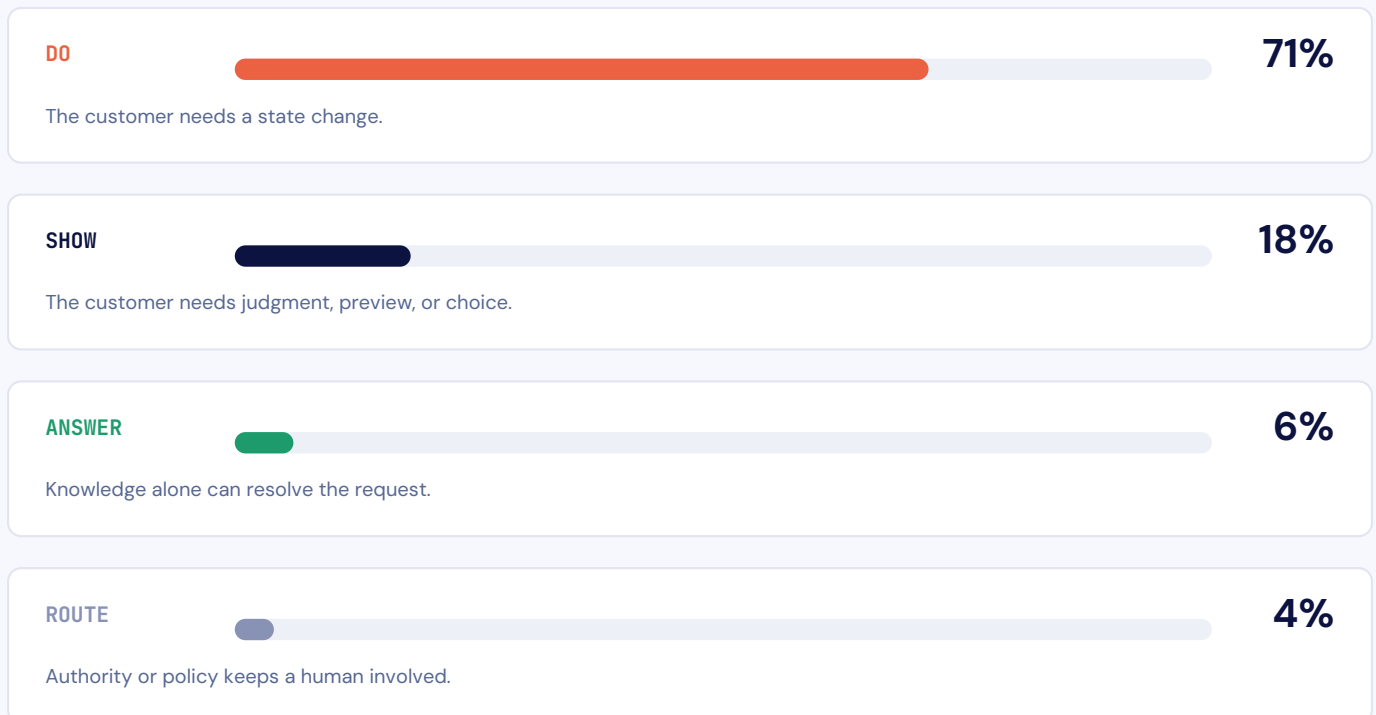
Can an agent do what customers want?

The audit separates work an agent can answer, show, do, or route, then checks whether a trustworthy public action exists for the workflows that require a change.

01 / DEMAND

Forty workflows. One strong core job.

The categories show the binding constraint in each resolution path. The B+ grade weights core scheduling more heavily than peripheral support work. The shares below remain public estimates, not ticket measurements.



Percentages are rounded, so the total may not equal 100%.

THE CORE-JOB VERDICT

Scheduling is strongly agent-addressable.

Calendly documents availability, event types, booking, cancellation, and links. Recovery and advanced configuration are the main public gaps.

WHY CALENDLY IS INTERESTING

Calendly publishes 34 first-party operational MCP actions. The remaining gaps are unusually specific: reconnecting a failed calendar, direct rescheduling, and changing Workflows or routing forms.

02 / PRIORITY ACTIONS

Five missing actions would move the grade.

These are not promises that a workflow is impossible. They are the highest-value places where public evidence stops and in-product verification should begin.

01 Reconnect a disconnected calendar

DO

CONFIRM

PUBLIC TODAY

Calendly guides the user to Calendar settings to reconnect.

BLOCKER

No published agent action reconnects the external calendar account.

VERIFY NEXT

Permission handoff, recovery, and restored sync state.

02 Embed Calendly on a website

SHOW

CONFIRM

PUBLIC TODAY

Public guides provide embed options and generated code.

BLOCKER

Placement, design, and publishing require judgment in another product.

VERIFY NEXT

Preview, approval, publication, and a live check.

03 Reschedule a meeting

DO

CONFIRM

PUBLIC TODAY

Calendly exposes meeting details and an invitee reschedule link.

BLOCKER

No published action directly moves the existing meeting to a chosen time.

VERIFY NEXT

Choice presentation, context carryover, and replacement verification.

02 / PRIORITY ACTIONS

Configuration is the next frontier.

Calendly's public tools are strong for scheduling. The two clearest gaps are managing the automations and routing logic around the meeting.

04 Edit or delete a Workflow

DO

CONFIRM

PUBLIC TODAY

The Help Center explains how users edit, clone, and delete Workflows.

BLOCKER

No published MCP action changes or removes a Workflow.

VERIFY NEXT

Action shape, confirmation boundary, and final automation state.

05 Create or manage a routing form

DO

CONFIRM

PUBLIC TODAY

Setup guides exist, and four public tools can read routing-form data.

BLOCKER

No published action creates or updates the form or its routing rules.

VERIFY NEXT

Create and update actions, validation, CRM handoff, and resulting route.

THE SAFE NEXT STEP

Verify one workflow in a 15-minute walkthrough.

A short capture shows the actions the public web cannot see, without turning the session into a product demo or asking Dubot to operate your account.

✓ You stay signed in.

✓ No credentials are shared.

✓ Nothing is executed.

✓ You review the recording before sharing.

03 / EVIDENCE

What this report can and cannot claim.

The public preview is useful because it is bounded. It identifies demand, documented actions, and precise verification targets without pretending public evidence is production proof.

OBSERVED

Help-center workflows, official developer documentation, and the published MCP tool inventory.

INFERRED

Relative demand from article placement, coverage, and available popularity signals.

NOT YET TESTED

Authenticated execution, confirmation behavior, failure recovery, and resulting product state.

PROVISIONAL**B+**

Strong core scheduling.

Calendly documents the core booking loop. Authenticated execution, confirmations, recovery, and resulting product state remain untested.

WHY THIS IS A BENCHMARK

Calendly is a recognizable product with unusually strong public agent infrastructure. That makes the remaining gaps legible. It is a useful standard of comparison, not a claim about Calendly's internal roadmap or support performance.
