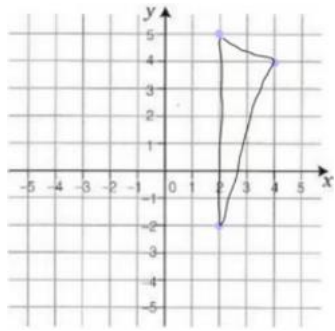

27 B — Missing comma after the reporting clause: "Zahra said, 'then bring...'"'.
28 C — Comma splice between

- independent clauses ("...grip, the mould crew...").
29 C — Needs a comma to close the non-restrictive clause: "...crest, rang...".
30 E — **No error**: list of coordinated clauses punctuated correctly.
31 B — Evening **unspools** (relaxes/unwinds).
32 B — Let the sound **settle**.
33 A — The recording will **suffice**.
34 B — Reputation will **build**.
35 B — Confidence grows into a **routine**, not flashes.

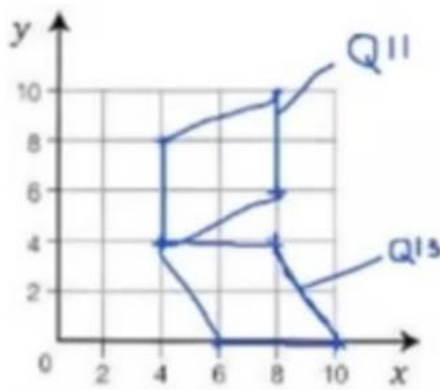
