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Itinerary

Golden Triangle (Brothers, Daedalus, Elphinstone)

9 nights / 10 days

Arrival Airport: Marsa Alam International Airport (RMF)

Departure & Return Port: Ras Galep, Port Ghalib Egypt

October 14 & 15

Itinerary

Saturday 16/10

Day 1 – Arrival Day

You will be assigned a cabin and discover the boat.

Check-in 3:00 PM. Complimentary airport pick-up for guests arriving at Marsa Alam or Hurghada Airport after 2:00 PM.

Sunday 17/10

Day 2 – Departure from Marina

After breakfast, your guide will brief you on the week's programme, safety recommendations, and life on board.

Your diving certifications, logbook, and insurance will be checked before leaving the marina. The boat will then sail to the first dive site, 30 minutes away, followed by a detailed briefing and a second dive in the afternoon.

After dinner, the boat heads towards the Brothers Islands for a six-hour journey.

The route is given as an example and is subject to weather conditions; it may be modified.

Monday 18/10

Day 3 – Brothers Islands

Having arrived the day before, you will complete three daytime dives on the stunning drop-offs of the Brothers Islands.

Due to new regulations protecting the marine ecosystem, safari boats are only permitted to spend one day at the Brothers site.

The boat will then sail overnight to reach Daedalus at dawn.

Tuesday 19/10

Day 4 – Daedalus

Arriving early in the morning, you will complete three daytime dives on the amazing drop-off of Daedalus, home of the hammerhead shark.

A visit to the lighthouse will be organised by the guide, subject to authorisation from the keepers.

Wednesday 20/10

Day 5 – Daedalus

Depending on the weather forecast and guests' requests, you will complete two or three further dives on Daedalus before sailing towards the coast – a journey of about seven hours – to reach Abu Dabbab, where you will spend the night.

A night dive may be organised depending on your time of arrival.

Thursday 21/10

Day 6 – Elphinstone

Depending on the weather forecast, you will complete two or three dives on the stunning drop-offs of Elphinstone.

The boat will then sail back to Abu Dabbab to spend the night in a protected area.

If a night dive was not organised the day before, it will take place this day.

Friday 22/10

Day 7 – Final Dives

Depending on the weather forecast and your flight schedule, you will complete one or two more dives in the morning. After the last dive, you will have the opportunity to rinse your diving gear on the rear diving deck before sailing for two hours to Port Ghalib.

This programme is based on a departure from Port Ghalib and may be modified without prior notice by the captain and/or guide according to weather conditions.

Saturday 23/10

Day 8 – Departure

Departure from the boat will take place after breakfast, or according to your flight and transfer schedule to the airport or hotel.

Check-out 10:00 AM. Complimentary airport transfers are available for departures scheduled before 4:00 PM.

Dune Touch Program

As part of the liveaboard experience, guests are invited to take part in the **DUNE Touch Event**, a signature onboard gathering organized by the DUNE crew.

Held once during each itinerary, this special evening celebrates the diversity of the guests on board through food, conversation, and shared experiences. Participants are encouraged to bring a small culinary specialty or snack from their home country—such as local cheese, biscuits, chocolate, cured meats, or other regional treats—to share with fellow divers.

Drinks are provided by the crew, creating a relaxed and welcoming atmosphere where guests from around the world can connect beyond diving.

- 2 to 3 dives per day
- Daily dive briefings and trip assistance

IMPORTANT DIVING REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum certification: CMAS Level 2 or Advanced Open Water Diver (AOWD)
- Minimum experience: at least 50 logged dives
- Full diving equipment is required (including SMB and dive computer)
- Diving insurance is required
- Check-in: 3:00 PM
- Airport after 2:00 PM. For earlier arrivals, a transfer package can be arranged at an additional cost
- Check-out: 10:00 AM
- Last day of cruise: complimentary airport transfers for departures before 4:00 PM

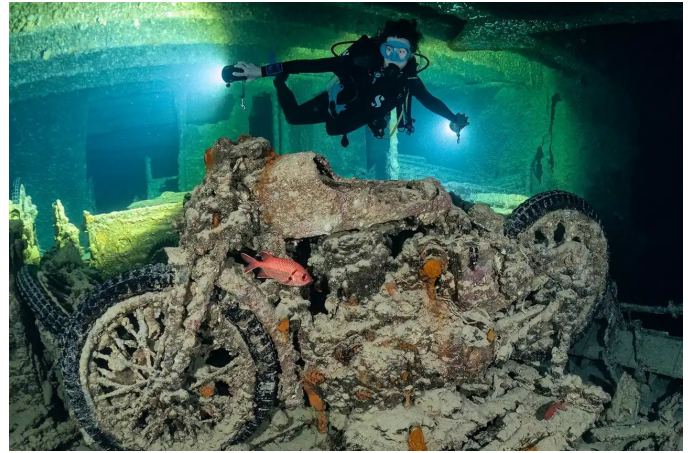
In the event that extreme weather conditions prevent the vessel from departing or force an interruption of the trip, **no refunds or credits will be granted.**
