

BUILDER PITCH – GUIDE

What it is

Build the Bahamian Dream: name one problem, propose one realistic solution, and pitch it in up to three minutes.

Suggested structure

- The problem – specific and local, not a national abstraction
- The solution – realistic and actionable, something that could actually start
- Why it matters – who it helps and how you know
- What you'd need to start – shows you've thought past the idea stage

Format options

- Video pitch (most common – same submission path as Dream Story)
- Slides with narration, recorded as video
- Live pitch, if your school or region hosts an in-person clinic

What judges look for

- Common score (70%): authentic voice, clear vision, Bahamian relevance, personal commitment
- Track score (30%): solution feasibility
