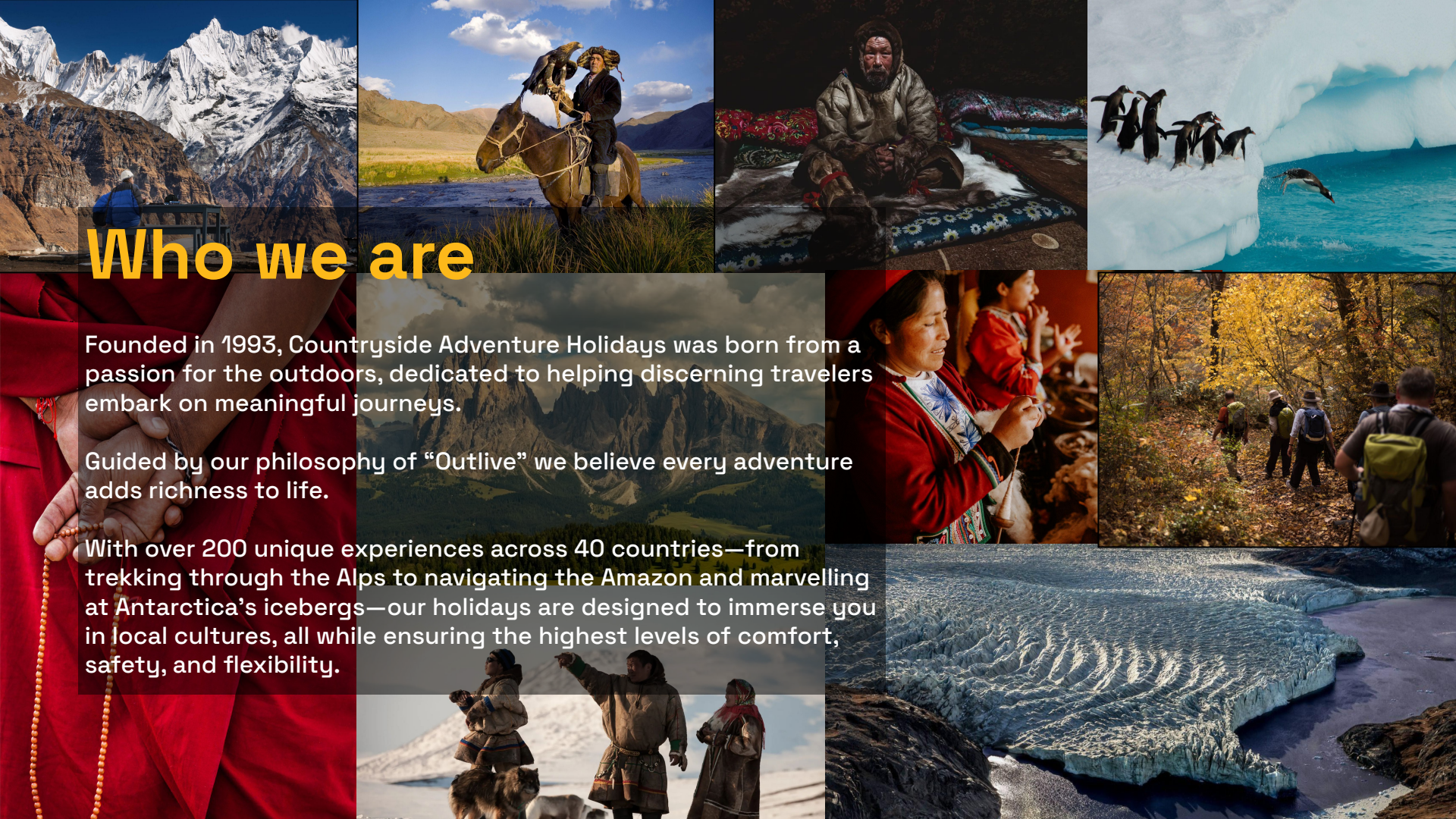

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Brief Itinerary

Day 01 (26-Sep) : Bareilly airport to Champawat (1615m / 5299 ft.; 185 Km; 5 hrs).

Day 02 (27-Sep) : Drive Champawat to Pithoragarh to Dharchula (900m / 2953 ft.; 165 kms; 5 hrs)

Day 03 (28-Sep) : Drive Dharchula to Nabhi (3200m / 10,499 ft.; 68 kms; approx. 4-5 hrs).

Day 04 (29-Sep) : Drive Nabhi to Nabidhang (3987m / 13,081 ft.) – Nabhi (approx 6-7 hrs).

Day 05 (30-Sep) : Drive Nabi to Jolingkong (4400m) – Gunji - Nabhi (approx. 6-7 hrs).

Day 06 (01-Oct) : Drive Nabhi to Dharchula and Dharchula to Chaukori (approx. 7-8 hrs).

Day 07 (02-Oct) : Drive from Chaukori to Bhimtal via Patal Bhuvaneshwar (180 kms; 8 hrs)

Day 08 (03-Oct) : Final Departure from Bhimtal to Bareilly (131 km | ~3.5 - 4 hrs)

The Journey

Day 1 | Into the Kumaon Hills

Bareilly – Champawat (1615 m / 5,299 ft. | 185 km | Approx. 5 hrs)

Leaving the plains behind, the road gradually climbs into the Kumaon hills. Terraced fields, forests and winding mountain roads signal the beginning of a very different pace of life. By late evening, arrive in the historic town of Champawat, once the capital of the Chand dynasty. If time permits, visit the beautifully carved Baleshwar Temple before settling in for the night. **Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel in Champawat.**

THE COUNTRYSIDE MOMENT

As evening settles over the hills, pause for a moment. The crisp mountain air and quiet surroundings gently announce that the Himalayas have begun to work their magic.

Day 2 | Where the Mountains Begin

Champawat – Pithoragarh – Dharchula (900 m / 2,953 ft. | 165 km | Approx. 5 hrs)

Drive through the heart of Kumaon, passing the scenic town of Pithoragarh before descending to Dharchula on the banks of the Kali River. This vibrant border town, shared in spirit with neighbouring Nepal, has welcomed pilgrims and traders for generations and marks the true gateway to the sacred Himalayas. **Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel in Dharchula.**

Day 3 | Following the Ancient Pilgrim Route

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Dharchula – Nabhi ((3,200 m / 10,499 ft. | 68 km | Approx. 4–5 hrs)

Today's drive follows the historic Kailash pilgrimage route through the spectacular Vyas Valley. The Kali River remains your constant companion as waterfalls tumble down steep cliffs and remote villages appear against dramatic mountain backdrops. By evening, arrive in the peaceful village of Nabhi, surrounded by the grandeur of the high Himalayas. **Dinner and overnight stay at homestay in Nabhi.**

Day 4 | The First Darshan of Om Parvat

Nabhi – Nabidhang – Nabhi (3,987 m / 13,081 ft. | Approx. 4–5 hrs)

Drive through pristine Himalayan wilderness to Nabidhang, where one of the journey's most anticipated moments awaits. Rising before you is the sacred Om Parvat, its naturally formed "ॐ" shining against the mountainside—a phenomenon that has inspired pilgrims and travellers alike for generations.

Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel/homestay in Nabhi

THE COUNTRYSIDE MOMENT

There is a noticeable hush as Om Parvat comes into view. Some moments are shared not through conversation, but through silence. Before reaching for your camera, simply stand still and take it all in. Some memories are best captured by the heart.



Day 5 | In the Presence of Adi Kailash

Nabhi – Jolingkong – Nabhi (4,400 m / 14,436 ft. | Approx. 6 hrs drive bothways + short trek)

An early start takes you by local jeep to Jolingkong, with magnificent views of Kunti Parvat, Pandav Parvat, Brahma Parvat and Parvati Mukut along the way. A short uphill walk leads to the sacred Adi Kailash Temple and the tranquil Parvati Kund. Those who wish can continue to Gauri Kund, where the still waters reflect the majestic peak above. **Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel/homestay in Nabhi.**

THE COUNTRYSIDE MOMENT

Standing before Adi Kailash, it is easy to understand why this mountain is revered. The landscape itself inspires quiet reflection.

TAKE A MOMENT...

Sit beside Parvati Kund for a few minutes. Whether in prayer, contemplation or simple appreciation, allow the stillness of the mountains to become part of your journey

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Day 6 | Descending Through the Himalayas

Nabhi – Dharchula – Chaukori (About 7 -8 hrs)

Leaving the high Himalayas behind, descend through scenic valleys towards Chaukori, a peaceful hill station known for its tea gardens and sweeping views of the Panchachuli peaks. The changing landscape offers a gentle transition from rugged mountain terrain to rolling hills. **Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel in Chaukori**

THE COUNTRYSIDE MOMENT

As the evening light touches the distant Panchachuli range, the mountains offer one final unforgettable panorama before you continue your journey home.

Day 7 | Legends Beneath the Earth

Chaukori – Patal Bhuvaneshwar – Bhimtal (180 km | Approx. 8 hrs)

Visit the mystical cave shrine of Patal Bhuvaneshwar, steeped in mythology and revered for centuries. Continue through the picturesque Kumaon hills to the tranquil lakeside town of Bhimtal, where a leisurely evening by the water provides the perfect contrast to the high Himalayan landscapes of the previous days. **Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel in Bhimtal.**

Day 8 | Carrying the Mountains Home

Bhimtal – Bareilly (131 km | Approx. 4 hrs)

After breakfast, drive back to Bareilly for your onward journey. While the roads may lead away from the Himalayas, the memories of sacred peaks, quiet valleys, mountain villages and shared experiences will linger long after the journey ends.

Until We Meet Again...

Some journeys are remembered for the places we visit.

Others are remembered for how they make us feel.

Long after the winding mountain roads, prayer flags and snow-clad peaks fade into the distance, the quiet moments remain—the first glimpse of Om Parvat, the reflection of Adi Kailash in the waters of Gauri Kund, conversations shared over simple meals, and the peace that only the Himalayas can offer.

The journey may end here, but the mountains have a wonderful way of travelling home with you.
