

Paradiso Travel Group Nomad Visa Checklist

Before Applying

- Confirm your eligibility:
 - Remote work arrangement with a non-Spanish company.
 - Income of at least €2,520/month or €30,240/year.
 - Gather proof of employment:
 - Contracts, letters, or invoices showing ongoing remote work.
 - Obtain recent bank statements showing consistent income.
 - Request a police clearance certificate from your home country.
 - Research and purchase private health insurance that meets Spanish requirements.
 - Find proof of accommodation:
 - Rental agreement, hotel booking, or an invitation letter.
 - Translate all non-Spanish documents through a certified translator.
 - Apply for your NIE (Foreigner Identification Number):
 - Complete EX-15 form.
 - Book an appointment at a consulate or in Spain.

Application Submission

- Download and complete the Digital Nomad Visa application form (EX-01).
- Check your local Spanish consulate's website for specific instructions.
- Book an appointment at your consulate to submit the application.
- Prepare all required documents for submission:
 - Passport (valid for at least 6 months).
 - Proof of income and employment.

- Police clearance certificate.
- Translated documents.
- Health insurance proof.
- Accommodation proof.

Pay the visa application fee (€80–€100).

Attend the consulate appointment:

- Submit documents.
 - Answer any interview questions.

After Application

Wait for visa approval (30–60 days).

Track your application status via your consulate or email.

Plan your move to Spain:

- Book flights and temporary accommodation.
- Research transportation and local amenities.

Pack important documents:

- Originals and copies of everything submitted.

After Arrival in Spain

Register your residence at the local town hall (*empadronamiento*).

Open a Spanish bank account.

Explore coworking spaces to find a community and reliable internet.

Familiarize yourself with Spain's tax rules and the Beckham Law.

Enroll in Spain's public healthcare system (optional).

Join digital nomad communities for networking and support.

Immerse yourself in Spanish culture:

- Try local cuisine, attend events, and explore top landmarks.

Set reminders for visa renewal 60 days before expiration.
