Imam Shafiee said in his book *Al-Umm*, even if one entered the prayer with an intention then his intention **changed** to leave the prayer, although he did not leave the prayer and his intention went back to his original intention...

...his prayer is no longer valid **the moment his intention had changed** and he has to repeat his prayer.



Ma Sha Allah, I love this week's Fiqh Corner because Ustazah Maghfirah shared something super relatable! This only cements how important having firm conviction / niyyah is when you want to do any form of worship, especially our Solah! PS: Be sure to read through all 7 slides to get the full picture of this super important topic.

There is a moment in our Solah that we should start "capitalising" because it is a blessed time when our prayers are answered, and that is when we are at our final Tahyat, right before we do our Taslim. I remember when we first did our [Solah Class with Ustazah Farhanah](#), where she said, **"If you struggle with making long Sujud, then sitting in your final Tahyat is another precious moment to make your long Du'as."** So when Ustazah Maghfirah reminded us of this point again last Sunday Session, I knew that we have to get back into the good habit of NOT rushing to finish our Solah! Rasulullah ﷺ taught us to pray for these 4 things when we are in this position: the torment of hellfire, the punishment of the grave, the trials of life and death, and the coming of the Dajjal. ([Muslim](#)). And after these 4, I would usually ask for Jannah for my family and my loved ones, including every single one of you Champs, and I would ask for anything and everything that comes through my heart. **I urge all of you to stay in this position for as long as you can, asking Allah SWT for everything that your heart needs, because the relief you feel after? Priceless.**

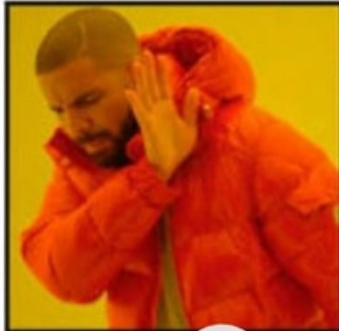
