### **Minister's Report 2023**

Dear friends,

Working our way through Mark's Gospel week by week I was struck by the words of Mark 8:23-25:

"Can you see anything now?" (Jesus asked him.) The man looked around. "Yes," he said, "I see people, but I can't see them very clearly..." Jesus placed His hands on the man's eyes again.... His sight was completely restored, and he could see everything clearly." So much of our lives revolve around vision, especially seeing everything as the Lord intends through the lens of faith, grace, and hope. Therefore, I believe we need to pray four petitions:

Primarily, pray to see Jesus more clearly and more of Him. It is through Him that we see everything else with clarity, proportion, and in the light of eternity. As we meet week by week as a worshipping community of faith, we ask that the Lord inspires us with His truth, goodness, and beauty.

Secondly, pray for enablement to see **people** with Gospel-eyes to find their true and full potential in Christ—not merely in terms of what they can do for us, or what they've done to us. Everyone is made in the Lord's image—with a dignity that may be hidden by their brokenness, wounds and scars from fractured relationships, so we pray for an explosion of grace in their lives as the younger of the two prodigals experienced when he encountered the unconditional love of the father.

Thirdly, pray Jesus helps us see **our pain**, sorrows, and failures as He sees them. Our worst moments don't have to define us, and our current pain has a "sell by" date. Because we belong to you, we will be completely whole one Day. Let us see the Father in and over everything that hurts. Free us, and keep us free.

Fourthly, we don't want just to see—we want to smell, taste, and hear the wonders of **our promised life** in "the new heaven and new earth" (Rev. 21:1-5). We want to live heavenly focused lives as the "Day" draws nearer. May I encourage everyone to make these petitions part of your prayer life and walk with Jesus.

Since my last letter in the 2022 Annual Report, I am delighted to welcome Sandra, Alan, Andrew, Ben and John on to the Kirk Session. Each has proved through their personal faith and service as leaders of vision and integrity with a passion for Christ and His Kingdom. This was recognised by the Commission of Presbytery who collectively endorsed the selection by the congregation as the will of God.

I wish also to pay tribute to Sam Connery who sadly died in February 2024. His personal faith in Christ was birthed in this congregation, nurtured and encouraged in the family home. His spirituality and Christian leadership credentials were recognised by this congregation on his election and subsequent ordination as a ruling elder back in 1982. As an elder he brought many gifts and a huge Godly influence and presence to our Kirk Session meetings. While never the first to speak when he did so it was worth waiting for as his comments were always wise and gracious. He had a heart for people pastorally able to bring the presence of Christ into many homes. Over the years Sam served diligently as our Freewill Offering Secretary and as member of our Finance sub-committee. While our loss is tangible we continue to pray for Norma, Gary and family whose loss is greater. May they know the peace and presence of Christ. Roy Irwin stepped to the side from the duties of the eldership and joins Herbie Jordan and Billy Gordon as elders emeriti.

2023 marked 20 years of ministry in Drumbo. Judith and I were surprised and humbled by the dinner and gift last September – thank you for your love and support from our church family in Drumbo. From someone in the later stages of ministry to Jonny just starting out! Last Summer we welcomed Jonny, Ruth and Isaac. In the months since we have grown to value Jonny's ministry and we look forward to his time with us as an Assistant. Congratulations on his graduation from Union College and the wonderful news of Ruth's pregnancy.

I have been truly privileged to share with you in the rhythms of congregational life in 2022. I've had the joy of seeing people discover new life in Christ and grow in faith. I've shared the pain of sickness and bereavement. I've shared in the joy of births and marriages. Most of all, I have many memories of a church family that genuinely loves and cares. ### **Committee Report**

After the extensive work to the church building in 2022 this year property repairs were much reduced. Unfortunately, we suffered a break in to the storage shed and theft of a lawnmower. Thankfully the ride-on mowers were not taken. This incident required security improvements to be implemented. Our insurance policy was able to helped cover the cost of a replacement mower.

Damage to the boundary wall between the church carpark and the orange hall was repaired and again our insurance policy was invaluable in helping to cover the expense.

Our thanks go out to all the volunteers who maintained the graveyard grass during the year. This work saves what would now be considerable a considerable expense if we had to employ a contractor to perform this work.

### **Treasurer's Report**

#### Summary:

As a congregation we now have costs of more than £130,000 per annum. (£2,500 per Week) excluding any major property maintenance or new projects. This was an increase of circa £5,000 on the previous year. A massive thanks to your generosity as faithful Members we were able to manage these additional costs in 2023 with the increase in your giving that totalled circa £136,000 inclusive of £25,000 Gift Aid (an increase of circa £16,000 on previous year).

#### **Property Maintenance:**

Maintenance costs for 2023 were circa £10,000 with no major projects. These costs were for routine electrical, gas and oil boiler maintenance. These costs are covered by contributions from Harvest offering (80%), graveyard transfers £8500 and together with members that contribute specifically to our property account.

#### **Graveyard Account:**

The Graveyard managed by Harold Marshall generates a substantial income. This year 2023 we had receipts of circa  $\pounds15,000$  with  $\pounds8,500$  transferred to our Property Account and a positive balance of circa  $\pounds11,000$  at year end.

#### Church Hall (Rental) & Events:

The Church Hall and Events rentals receipts managed by David Hunter generated an income in 2023 of circa £2800 with an additional income from the Drumbo Annual Vintage Event managed by Albert Clarke that generated  $\pounds$ 2,400 for church funds.

#### **Missions Account:**

Once again thanks to your generosity we raised £19,870 including Gift Aid and our Harvest 20% contribution to missions having paid out circa £18,000 to several charities and missions including £9,000 to PCI United Appeal in 2023.

#### Gift Aid / List of FWO Contributors:

Gift aid is important to us as a congregation with 80% of all your contributions now achieving Gift Aid. This was invaluable in 2023 and worth circa £25,000. We have all your FWO numbers and contributions listed overleaf. If there is a yes against your number this means that we have collected and will continue to collect gift aid on the total of your contributions to the Church. Providing you are a Tax Payer and pay tax equal to at least a quarter of your contributions these is no further cost to you, yet DPC benefits enormously by getting the 25% contribution from the government.

If there is a No against your number, please reconsider your position and let John Tougher or Alan Dorman know if you would like to sign a gift aid form so we can claim the 25% on your giving. Likewise, should your circumstances have changed and you now cease paying Tax also please advise John Tougher or Alan Dorman anytime and we can amend records as this is also important

#### DRUMBO PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH RULES OF GRAVEYARD AND USE OF CHURCH

- 1. All applications for interment in the said Graveyard shall be made to the Convenor of the Graveyard Committee at least 48 hours before interment can take place.
- 2. All interments must be performed under the supervision of the Convenor of the Graveyard Committee or his representative.
- 3. Scale of fees for use of Church and interments: -

Above Fees must, in all cases, be received by the Graveyard Committee in advance. On presenting a receipt for payment the Convenor shall perform internment.

4. Opening and closing of grave - paid directly to the Undertaker.

The responsibility of having graves opened and closed, in liaison with Gravedigger, belongs to the Undertaker.

- 5. To qualify for a grave as a member of the congregation, that member must have contributed at least £1500 over ten years.
- 6. No-one will be permitted to acquire more than one grave space and under no circumstances can these be transferred to anyone outside the immediate family.
- 7. Cremated remains must not be scattered in the graveyard, the urn or casket will be treated as a normal interment
- 8. Requests for permission to erect or replace a headstone made, in writing, to the Graveyard Committee, enclosing a detailed dimensioned drawing and appropriate fee grave numbers to be included on all headstones.

Headstone - £75

Where a headstone is erected, no other flower holders, name plaques or mementoes will be permitted. Committee reserves the right to remove such objects. Temporary name plaques or flower holders must be set in line with other headstones.

- 9. The erection of surrounds or the planting of trees or shrubs will not be permitted in the graveyard. Committee reserves the right to remove such plantings.
- 10. All existing monuments or railings must be kept in good order and repair to the satisfaction of the Committee and should anyone fail to do so, the Committee may have the same put in order and repaired at the expense of the owner, or they may cause such erections to be removed at the expense of the owner and may refuse any application for interment thereafter, except upon terms Committee may deem just.
- 11 The congregation will not be responsible for any injury, loss or damage, which may happen to railings, monuments, wreaths, shades or other mementoes at or upon graves.
- 12 All wreaths will be removed after 28 days.
- 13 Following a period of settlement the surfaces of all burial plots will be levelled and returned to grass.
- 14 Should any dispute arise as to the right of burial, or the boundaries of a grave or graves, headstones, surrounds, name plaques, flower holders, plants and all other objects the Graveyard Committee of the congregation for the time being, shall make their decision thereon and the decision of the Committee when so declared shall be final and binding upon all parties.
