This Cookie Policy explains how xpate Ltd and xpate SIA ("we", "us", or "our") use cookies and similar tracking technologies when you visit our website, xpate.com.

We operate in full compliance with the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), the ePrivacy Directive, the UK GDPR, and the UK Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations (PECR). This policy applies to all visitors from the European Economic Area (EEA) and the United Kingdom (UK).

1. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files or pieces of code that are stored on your computer or mobile device when you visit a website. They are widely used to make websites work efficiently, improve your browsing experience, and provide analytical data to website owners.

In addition to traditional HTTP cookies, we may use alternative storage technologies (such as HTML local or session storage) to support site performance and layout optimization.

2. How We Manage Your Consent

When you first visit xpate.com, a cookie consent banner powered by Cookiebot will appear.

- Strictly Necessary Cookies do not require your consent, as they are mandatory for our website to function securely and properly.
- Statistics and Analytics Cookies will only be dropped on your device if you explicitly click "Accept" or opt into them via our banner.

You have the right to change or withdraw your consent at any time by clicking the "Cookie Settings" link located in the footer of our website.

3. Inventory of Cookies Used on xpate.com

Our website utilizes a total of 7 cookies. They are categorized as follows:

Category A: Strictly Necessary (1 Cookie)

Necessary cookies enable core functionalities like page navigation, secure area access, and consent logging. The website cannot function properly without these cookies.
