

I am the sole graphic design and communications consultant for the Bowen Center at Indiana University, leading all design projects, including frequent large print projects on tight deadlines, all web design, large-scale data visualization projects, social media, policy papers, and marketing materials. I also spearhead the Center's communications strategy, which has led to more than 5,000% growth in online engagement and 2,000% growth in page views in less than one year. In addition to graphic design, I handle all social media, completely rebranded the Center's visual identity, build interactive data dashboards, write regular (1-3 per week) blog posts, conduct communications planning meetings, monitor and update the team on web analytics, and lead the longterm communications strategy for the Center.


LEAD MAP DESIGNER, ISTATION

I was lead map and graphic designer for a comprehensive middle and high school U.S. history platform being deployed in schools nationwide, called the Story of America. I created original designs based on visual needs for the program. Originally hired to do only middle-school level maps, I was quickly promoted to handling all types of visuals for both middle and high school U.S. history coursework within all lessons, including pitching concepts for new graphics, maps, and infographics. I primarily worked in the actual lessons, but also helped with some of the marketing materials for the program, where needed.

MAPMAKER, SELF-EMPLOYED

Initially a side project, I left my office job of seven years to be able to sell my map-based art I designed full-time starting in 2022 in markets around the Washington, DC, area. My maps were featured in major publications in the DC area, including the Washingtonian and WUSA-9, among others. I am well known in the DC area as "the map guy" thanks to my map design work.
