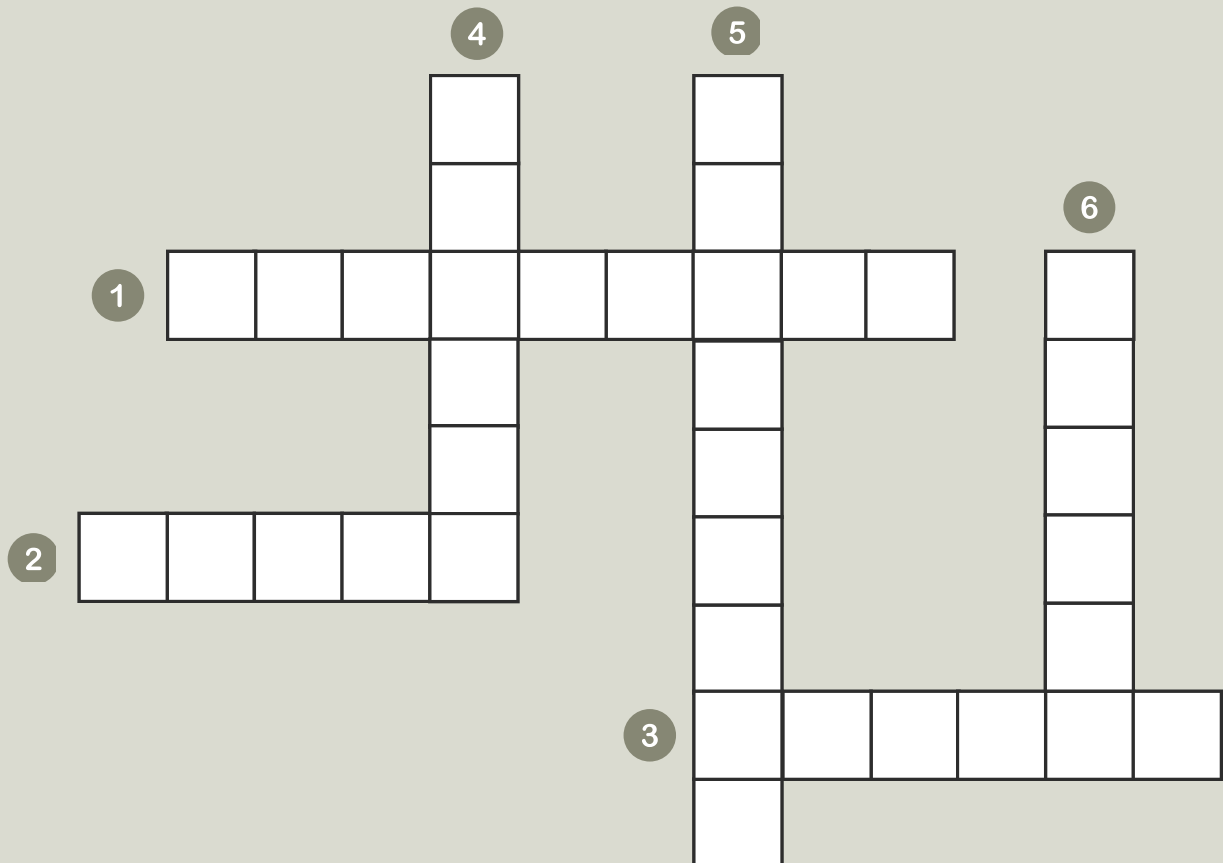

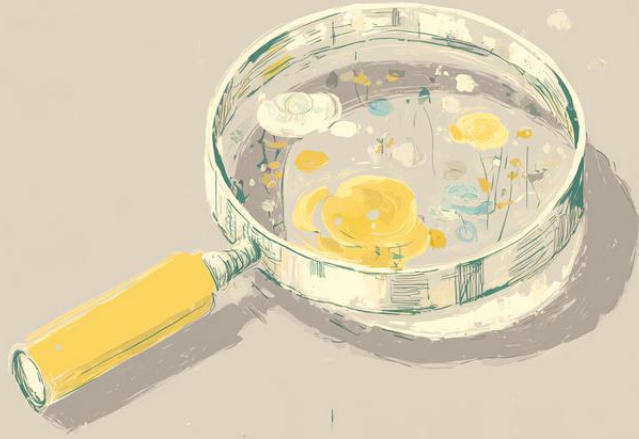

1

The other 4 Surahs that open with the word "Alhamdulillah" other than Surah Al-Fatiha are Surah Al-An'am (6), Surah Al-Kahf (18), Surah Saba (34), and Surah Fatir (35).

2

The only Ayah that talks about Ramadan in the Quran is in Surah Al-Baqarah (2:185).

3

The Ayah that comes after the one about Ramadan is in Surah Al-Baqarah (2:186), where Allah mentions that He is truly near.

4

The last word Allah SWT uses in the Ayah about fasting (2:183), is 'Tattaqun', meaning those who are righteous or mindful of Allah.

#5

There are **12 attributes and/or Names of Allah** in Ayatul Kursi (2:255)

1. He is the **only true God worthy of worship** (Allah! There is no god 'worthy of worship' except Him), absolute Oneness (Tawhid / Wahdaniyyah), and uniqueness in divinity.

2. **Al-Hayy**; The Ever-Living (eternal life, never dies).

3. **Al-Qayyum**; The All-Sustaining / Self-Subsisting (sustains all existence, independent and watchful over creation).

4. **Neither drowsiness nor sleep overtakes Him**; free from weakness, fatigue, or any human-like needs; perfect vigilance and eternal wakefulness.

5. **To Him belongs whatever is in the heavens and whatever is on the earth**; absolute ownership and sovereignty (Mulk / dominion) over all creation.

6. **No one can intercede with Him except by His permission**; exclusive authority over intercession; nothing happens without His approval.

#5

7. He 'fully' knows what is ahead of them and what is behind them (knows the future and the past); perfect, comprehensive knowledge ('Ilm) encompassing everything.

8. No one can grasp any of His knowledge except what He wills 'to reveal'; His knowledge is limitless; He grants understanding only as He chooses (shows His supreme will and control over revelation/knowledge).

9. His Kursi (Seat/Throne of authority) encompasses the heavens and the earth; vast, all-encompassing dominion and greatness; His control covers the entire universe.

10. The preservation of both (heavens and earth) does not tire Him; infinite power and strength; never fatigued or weary in upholding creation.

11. He is the Most High (Al-'Aliyy); supreme exaltation and transcendence above all.

12. He is the Greatest (Al-'Azim); infinite magnificence and majesty.

#10 Maryam AS and Yusuf AS were both seeking refuge from Allah. Maryam AS specifically sought refuge from Ar Rahman.

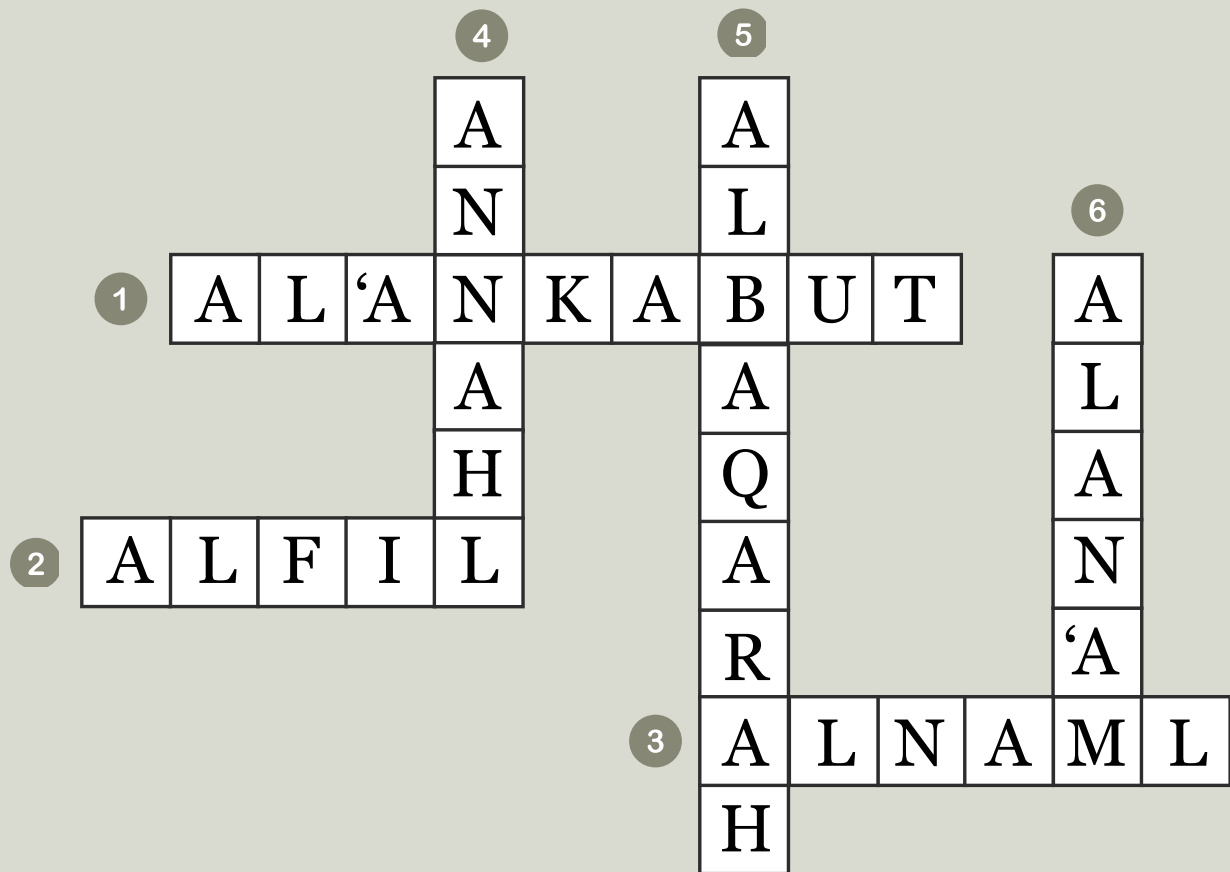
#11 Luqman's list of advice for his son is in Surah Luqman from Ayah 12 to 19 (31:12-19):

- "Be grateful to Allah, for whoever is grateful, it is only for their own good. And whoever is ungrateful, then surely Allah is Self-Sufficient, Praiseworthy." (31:12)
- Never associate 'anything' with Allah 'in worship', for associating 'others with Him' is truly the worst of all wrongs." (31:13)
- to 'honour' their parents. Their mothers bore them through hardship upon hardship, and their weaning takes two years. So be grateful to Me and your parents. To Me is the final return. (31:14)

#11 < Continuation >

- 'Even' if a deed were the weight of a mustard seed - be it 'hidden' in a rock or in the heavens or the earth - Allah will bring it forth. Surely Allah is Most Subtle, All-Aware. (31:16)
- "O my dear son! Establish prayer, encourage what is good and forbid what is evil, and endure patiently whatever befalls you. Surely this is a resolve to aspire to. (31:17)
- "And do not turn your nose up to people, nor walk pridefully upon the earth. Surely Allah does not like whoever is arrogant, boastful. (31:18)
- Be moderate in your pace. And lower your voice, for the ugliest of all voices is certainly the braying of donkeys." (31:19)
