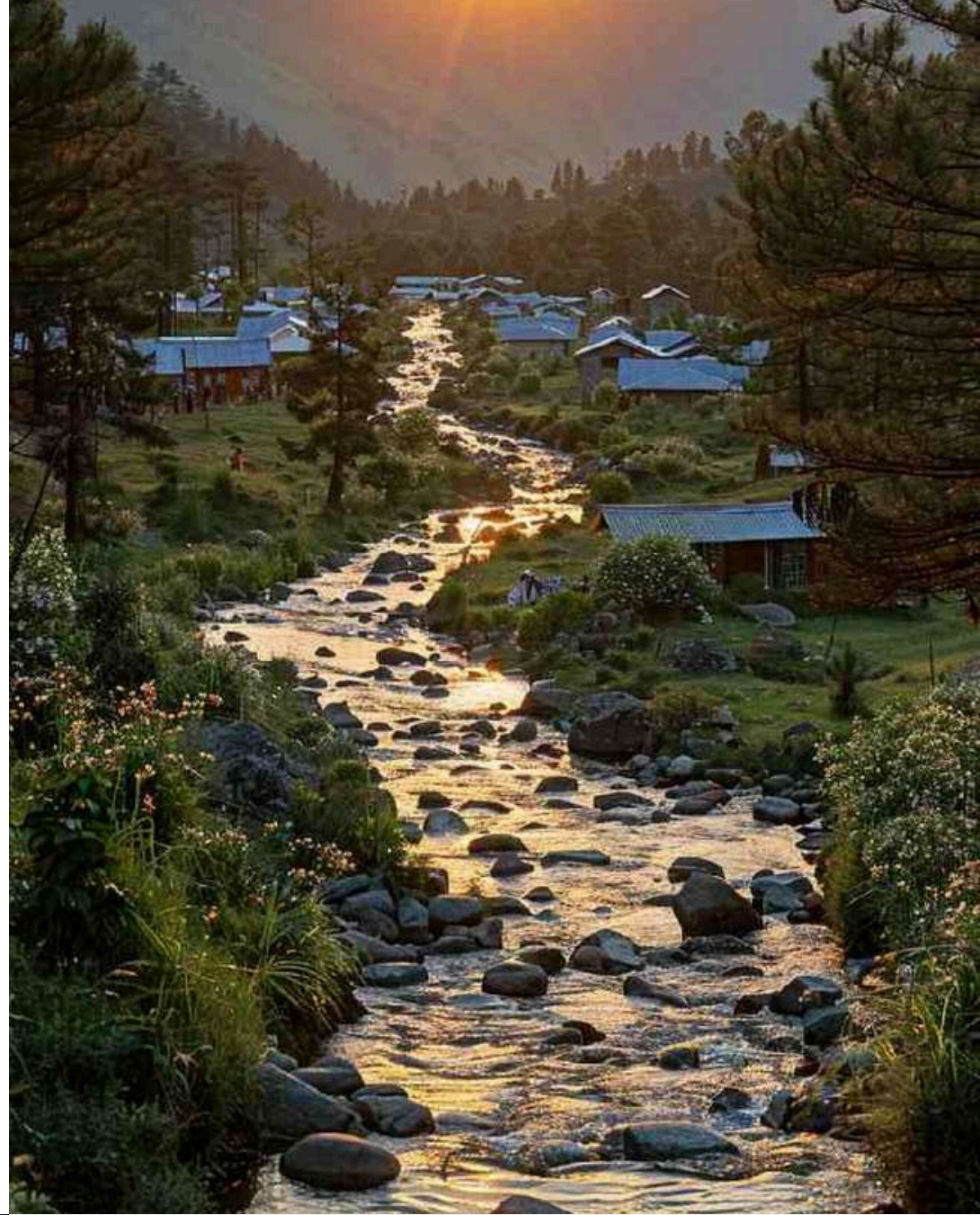
DAY 5

As we begin our scenic drive back to Guwahati, watch the rolling hills slowly give way to bustling towns while replaying the highlights of the past few days.

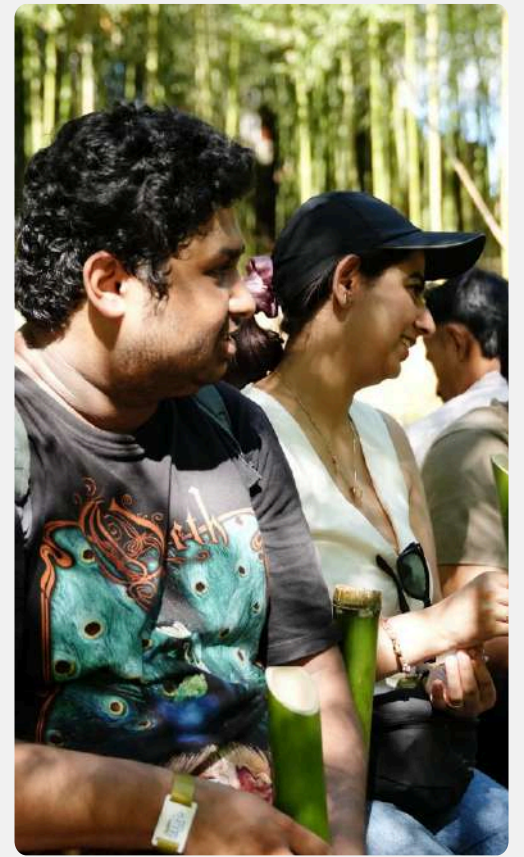


Expect playlists to be exchanged, hundreds of photos to be shared, and conversations about "where are we going next?"
