



2026 "Phoenix Cup" International Invitational Shotgun

Event Regulations

I. Dates and Venue

The 2026 "Phoenix Cup" International Invitational Shotgun will be held at the Sichuan Administration Center of Shooting and Archery Sports from November 18 to November 27, 2026.

II. Events (Total of 6 Gold Medals)

1. Trap Men
2. Trap Women
3. Trap Mixed Team
4. Skeet Men
5. Skeet Women
6. Skeet Mixed Team

III. Participants

Participation is open to clubs or individuals possessing a shotgun shooting license and having the legal qualification to compete at the local level.

IV. Athlete Qualifications

1. Athletes shall be eligible to participate in the competition only if they meet at least one of the following qualifications, and such qualification remains valid throughout the duration of the competition:
 - 1) Athletes must be properly registered by the International Shooting Sport Federation. Only those whose registration is valid at the time of the competition may compete;
 - 2) Possess a valid membership or be duly registered with their National (or Regional) Shooting Federation;
 - 3) Athletes who have participated in at least one event listed on the ISSF competition calendar within the past two years and be able to provide the official results.
2. Athletes who are or have been subject to any period of suspension imposed by the ISSF shall be ineligible to enter the competition.
3. Participants are required to obtain the necessary personal health and accident insurance. The Organizing Committee accepts no liability for any costs incurred as a result of participants' personal accidents.
4. In addition to complying with the international regulations of the International Shooting Sport Federation (ISSF), all participants must also comply with the laws, regulations, and relevant sector-specific management rules of the host country.

V. Event Registrations

1. Entries shall be accepted from countries, federations, or individual athletes. A maximum of 25 entries shall be accepted per event for the four disciplines: Men's Trap, Women's Trap, Men's Skeet, and Women's Skeet. Registration shall close upon reaching the said limit for each event.

Mixed teams (comprising one male and one female athlete) may be formed freely without restriction as to nationality. The final team composition shall be confirmed by 12H00 PM local time on the day prior to qualification.

3. All events will feature a final. No ties shall remain in the final rankings; in the event of a tie, the latest ISSF rules shall apply.

VI. Rankings and Awards

1. Individual Event: For 8-10 participants, top 3 will be awarded; for 11-12 participants, top 6 will be awarded; for 13 or more participants, top 8 will be awarded. The top 3 will receive medals, prize money, and certificates, and 4th to 8th place will receive certificates.
2. Mixed Team Event: For 3-5 registered teams, only the champion will be awarded; for 6-8 registered teams, top 3 will be awarded; for 9-11 registered teams, top 6 will be awarded; for 12 or more registered teams, top 8 will be awarded. The top 3 will receive medals, prize money, and certificates, and 4th to 8th place will receive certificates.
3. Prize **Money (pre-tax)**: Prizes shall be awarded to the top three athletes in each event as follows: 1st place – 30,000 RMB, 2nd place – 15,000 RMB, 3rd place – 10,000 RMB.

VII. Entry Registration and Accreditation/Check-in

1. Athletes are required to submit their entry forms to the Organizing Committee for registration. Upon completion of the eligibility review by the Organizing Committee, a confirmation email shall be sent to the athlete to confirm successful registration. Once the registration deadline is reached, no belated entries shall be accepted.
2. Participants shall be required to execute the **Athlete Integrity Commitment Letter**, thereby certifying that they have no serious criminal record, no prior anti-doping rule violations, and no record of serious disciplinary infractions. Participants further undertake to abide by the competition rules and associated administrative regulations, honor the spirit of sport, observe the principle of neutrality, and contribute to the maintenance of a fair, just, civilized, and orderly competitive environment.
3. The executed Integrity Commitment Letter shall be submitted to the designated registration email address concurrently with the registration documents. The Organizing Committee shall be entitled to conduct necessary verification of the submitted information for event management purposes. If any false declaration, document omission, or inconsistency with the actual circumstances is identified, the Organizing Committee shall have the authority to disqualify the participant with immediate effect.
4. No additional athletes may be registered after the deadline. Upon successful verification of registration, athletes shall submit their flight information. Athletes will be invited to join the WhatsApp group created by the Organizing Committee, where they shall provide timely updates on their flight information, thereby enabling the Organizing Committee to make necessary arrangements for their entry into China.
5. Participants shall be responsible for their own entry fees, accommodation, meals, travel expenses and ancillary costs. The entry fee for individual events is €200 per athlete per event. The entry fee for the mixed team event is €200 per team. The entry fee shall be collected on-site upon arrival and registration. Payment may be made by cash or credit card.

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VIII. Competition Equipment

1. Athletes shall have their own firearms. Ammunition and clay targets shall be provided by the event organizer free of charge in accordance with the prescribed procedures.
2. The transportation of firearms and ammunition shall be carried out in strict accordance with the Firearms Control Law of the People's Republic of China and the relevant provisions stipulated by the public security and transportation departments.

IX. Insurance

All athletes, coaches, and team leaders must obtain their own personal accident insurance from their local insurance company, covering the round trip to the competition venue and the entire competition period. A copy of the insurance document must be presented upon registration. Any person without such insurance shall not be permitted to participate in the competition.

X. Any matters not specified in these regulations shall be further notified by the event organization separately.

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
