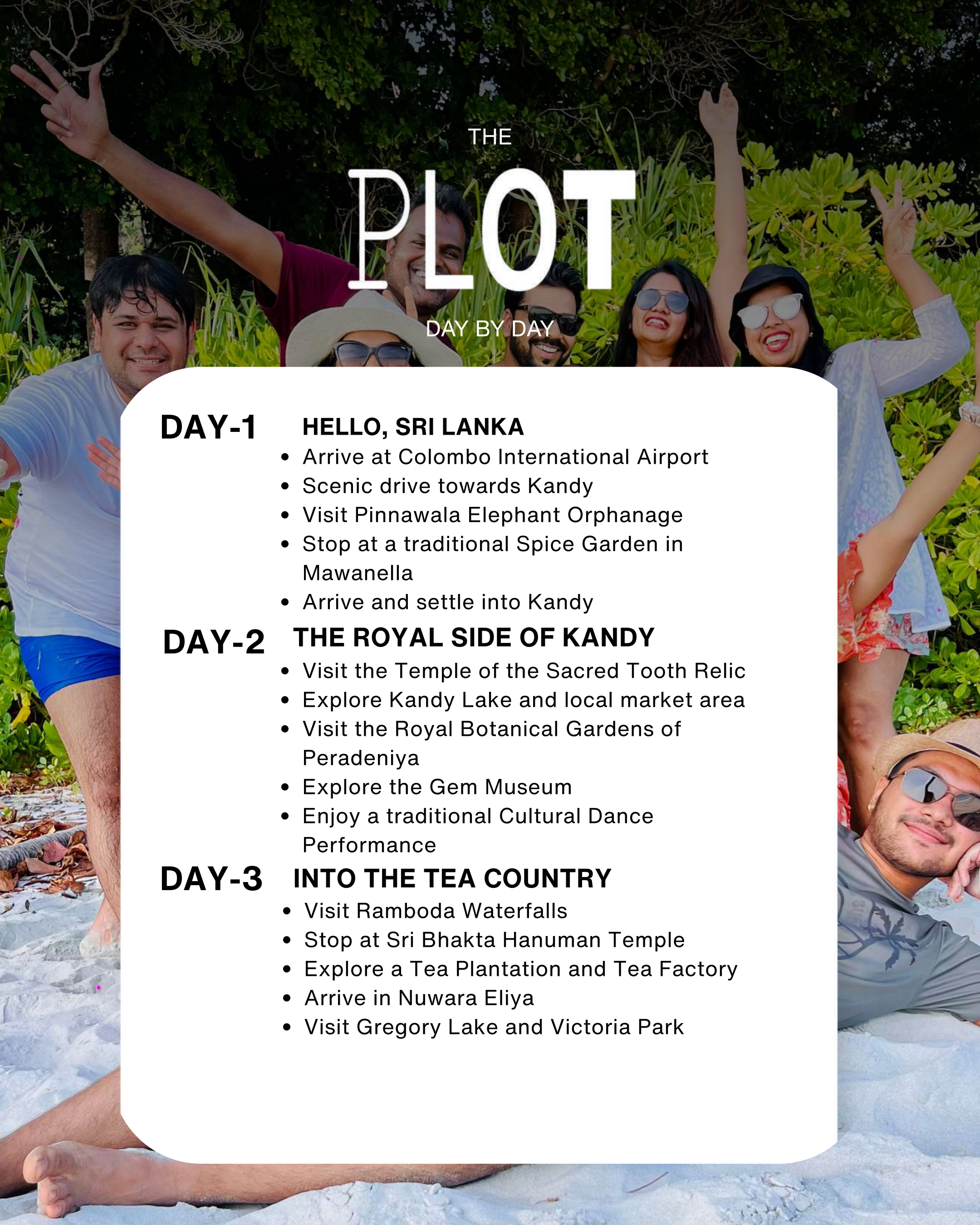
The shared bus rides.

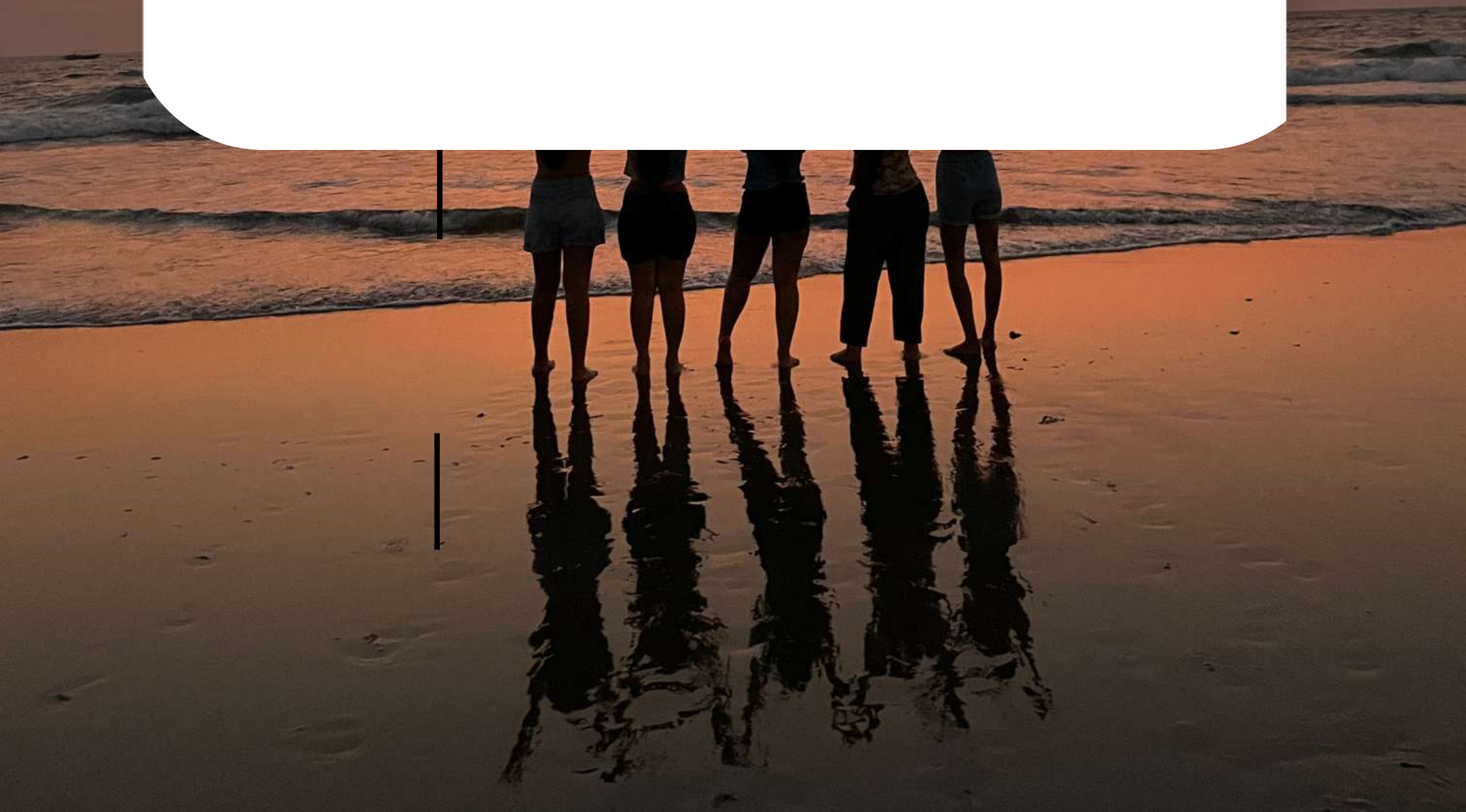

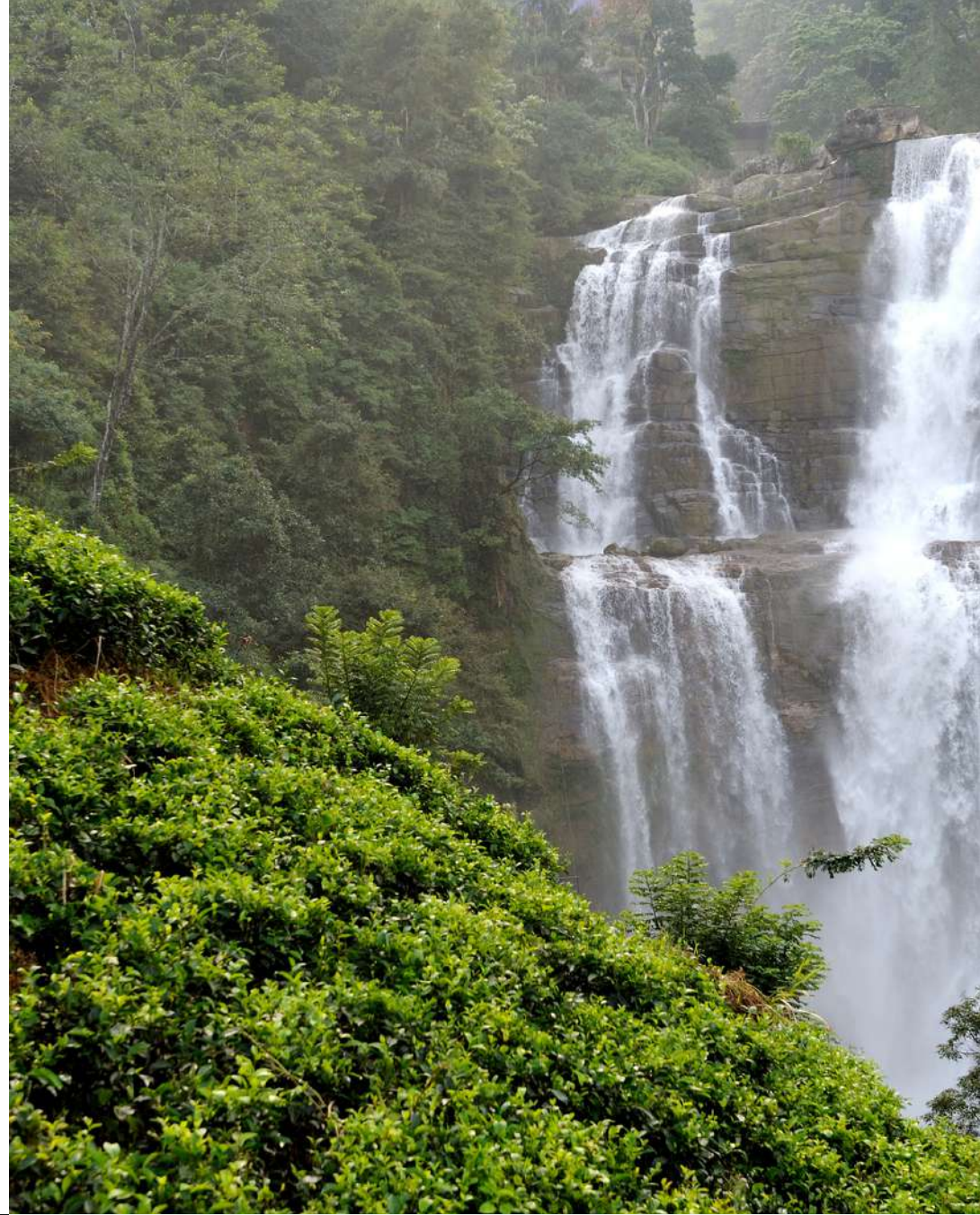
- Breakfast at the hotel

DAY 1

ARRIVAL & JOURNEY TO KANDY

Welcome to the Pearl of the Indian Ocean.
Upon arrival at Colombo International Airport, we'll be welcomed by our local representative and begin our journey towards Kandy.
Our first experience takes us to the famous Pinnawala Elephant Orphanage, home to rescued and orphaned elephants.



Spend some time observing these gentle giants and their daily routines.
We'll then stop at a traditional Spice Garden in Mawanella, where we'll learn more about Sri Lanka's famous spices and herbal traditions.
From here, we continue through the scenic countryside towards Kandy.
Once we arrive, check into the hotel, settle in and relax after the journey.
Our Sri Lankan adventure has officially begun.

DAY 2

EXPLORING THE CULTURAL HEART OF KANDY

After breakfast, we'll spend the day exploring Kandy, the last royal kingdom of Sri Lanka and one of the country's most important cultural centres. We'll begin with the Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic, one of the island's most revered Buddhist sites. Later, we'll explore the surroundings of Kandy, including the Kandy Lake and Market Area,



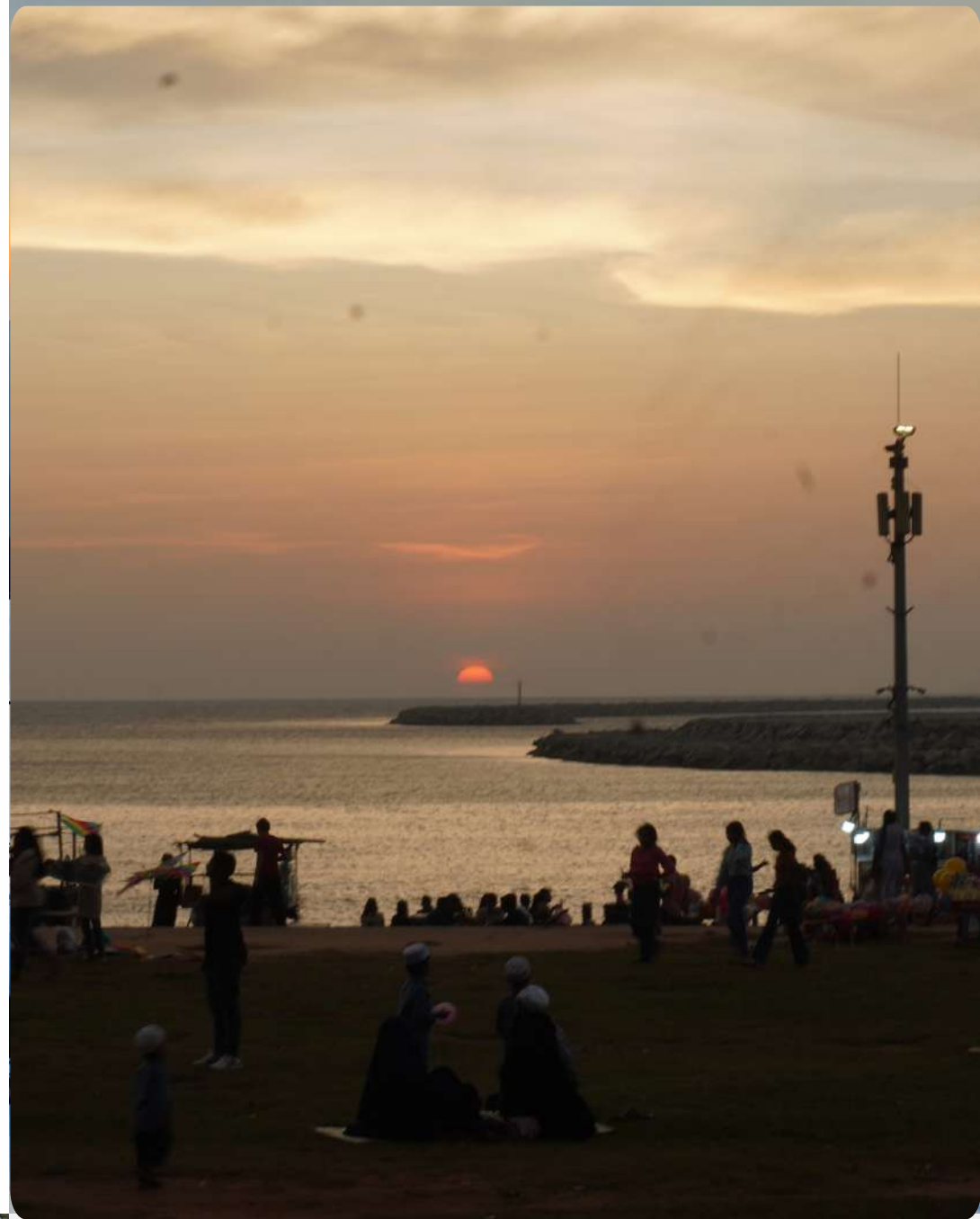
before heading to the beautiful Royal Botanical Gardens of Peradeniya. Walk through landscaped gardens filled with orchids, giant trees and beautiful tropical plants. We'll also visit the Gem Museum, before ending the day with a traditional Cultural Dance Performance showcasing Sri Lankan heritage. A day filled with culture, history and stories from the island's past.

DAY 3

KANDY TO NUWARA ELIYA

After breakfast, we leave Kandy behind and head deeper into Sri Lanka's beautiful hill country. The journey itself is part of the experience.

Our first stop is the scenic Ramboda Waterfalls, surrounded by lush green landscapes. We'll then visit the Sri Bhakta Hanuman Temple, an important site associated with the Ramayana.



As we continue through the hills, the landscapes slowly transform into rolling tea estates.

We'll visit a Tea Plantation and Tea Factory to see how Sri Lanka's world-famous Ceylon Tea makes its journey from leaf to cup. Later, we'll arrive in Nuwara Eliya, often called Little England because of its colonial architecture, cool climate and old-world charm.

We'll explore Gregory Lake and Victoria Park before settling into our hotel.

DAY 4

NUWARA ELIYA TO BENTOTA

After breakfast, we'll visit the famous Sita Amman Temple, believed to be associated with the Ramayana.

From here, we begin our journey away from the cool hill country and towards Sri Lanka's tropical coast.

We'll pass through scenic landscapes and travel via



Kitulgala, known for its lush rainforests and adventure activities.

Those looking for an extra dose of adventure can opt for White Water Rafting on the Kelani River at an additional cost.

Later, we'll continue towards Bentota.

Check into the hotel, freshen up and take some time to enjoy the beach town.

From misty hills to tropical warmth — Sri Lanka changes completely in just one journey.

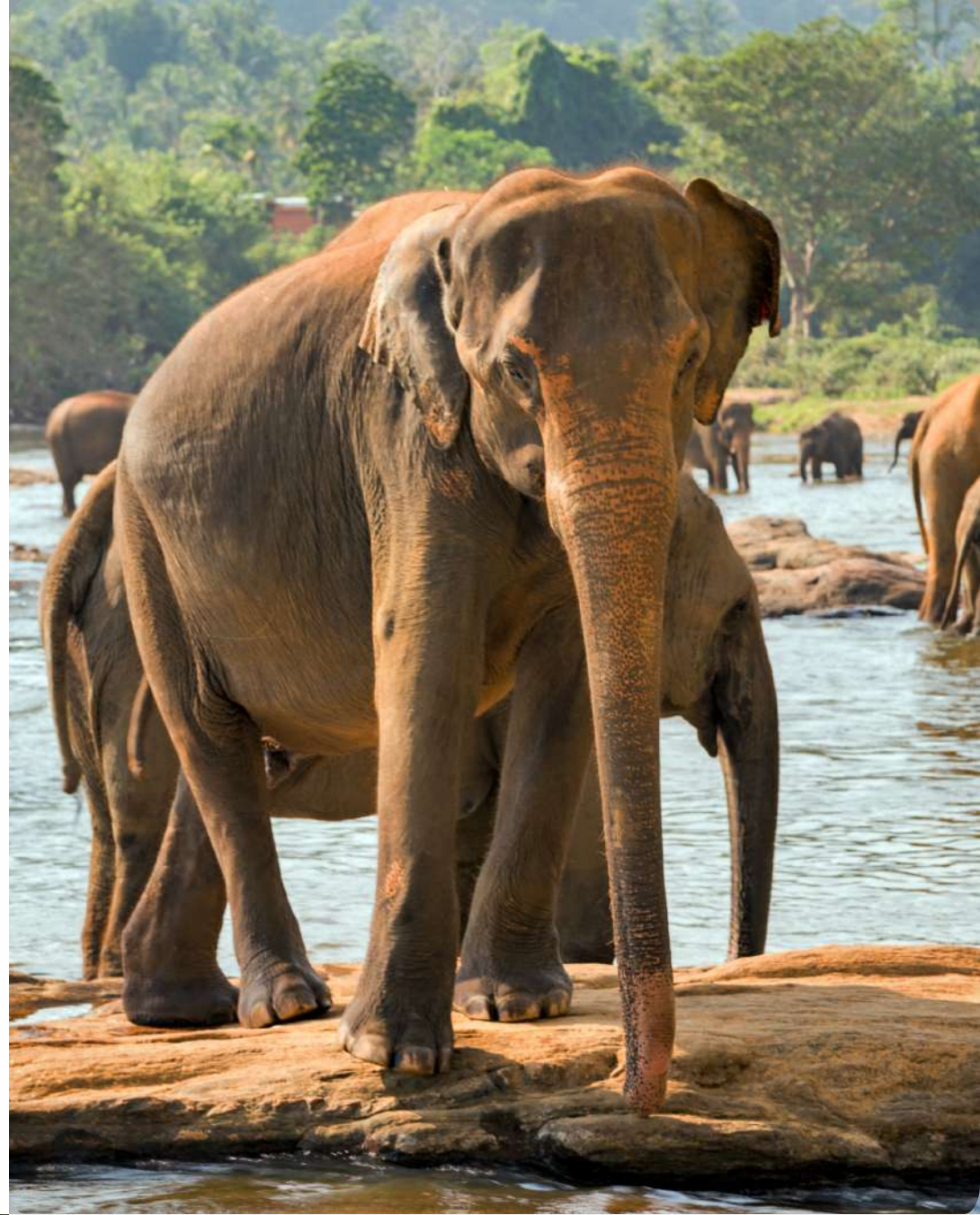
DAY 5

BENTOTA + GALLE EXPLORATION

Today, we'll explore the beautiful southern coast of Sri Lanka.

We'll begin with the historic Galle Dutch Fort, a UNESCO World Heritage Site known for its colonial architecture, charming streets and views of the Indian Ocean.

Walk through its old lanes, take in the history and explore one of Sri Lanka's most iconic coastal towns.



Later, we'll visit a Turtle Hatchery and learn more about these incredible creatures.

We'll also explore the Madu River area, with the option to take a boat safari through mangrove forests rich in birdlife and aquatic species.

For those looking for more adventure, water sports can also be enjoyed at an additional cost.

History, beaches, wildlife and a little bit of adventure — today has it all.



DAY 6

BENTOTA TO COLOMBO

After breakfast, we'll make our way towards Colombo, Sri Lanka's bustling commercial capital.

The city brings together colonial history, modern development and vibrant local life.

We'll explore some of Colombo's important landmarks, including:

- Independence Square
- Gangaramaya Temple
- Old Parliament Building



- Galle Face Green
- Colombo Port City
- Dutch Hospital Precinct
- Lotus Tower – Outside View

We'll also have time to explore the city's shopping scene, including ODEL, Crescat Boulevard and Pettah Market.

Spend your final evening soaking in the energy of Sri Lanka's biggest city.

DAY 7

UNTIL NEXT TIME, SRI LANKA

After breakfast, it's time to pack up one last time and check out.

We'll transfer to Colombo International Airport for our onward journey.
