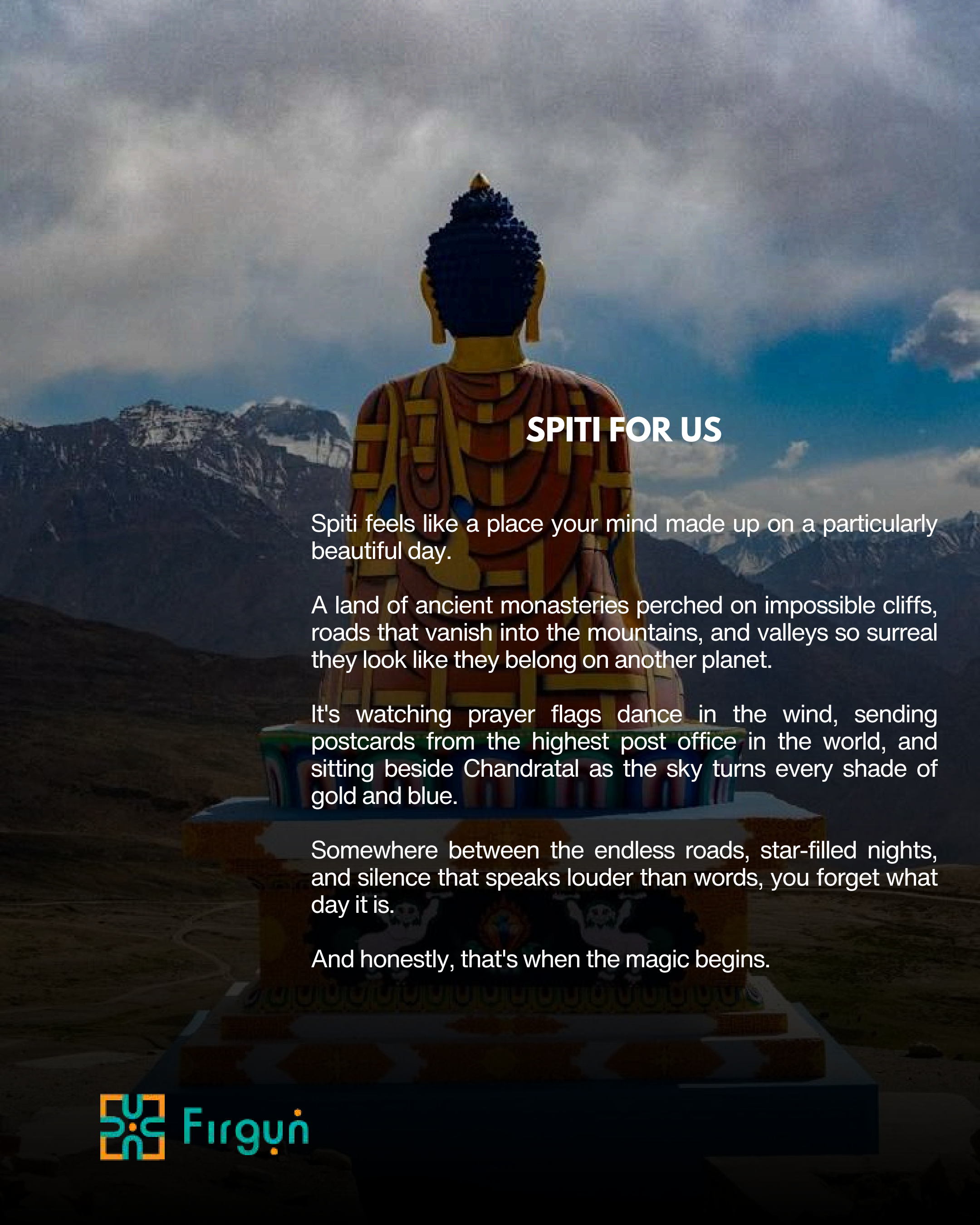

THE PLOT

DAY BY DAY

DAY-1

- Depart from Delhi in the evening by Volvo.
- Overnight journey through the hills towards Shimla.

DAY-2

- Arrive in Shimla and freshen up.
- Scenic drive through Kinnaur towards Sangla Valley.
- Check into your stay and spend the evening amidst the mountains.
- Overnight stay in Sangla.

DAY-3

- Visit Chitkul, the last inhabited village near the Indo-Tibetan border.
- Stop at the famous Hindustan Ka Aakhiri Dhaba.
- Explore the village and drive towards Kalpa.
- Overnight stay in Kalpa.

DAY-4

- Drive deeper into Spiti Valley.
- Visit the stunning Khab Sangam and Nako Lake.
- Cross Sumdo and enter Spiti.
- Overnight stay in Tabo.

- Explore Hikkim, home to one of world's highest post office.
- Visit Komic, highest motorable villages in the world.
- Explore Langza, famous for fossils and giant Buddha statue.
- Overnight stay in Kaza.

DAY-7

- Visit the famous Chicham Bridge.
- Cross the mighty Kunzum Pass.
- Reach Chandratal and spend time at the Moon Lake.
- Overnight stay at Chandratal camps.

DAY-8

- Drive towards Manali through spectacular mountain landscapes.
- Visit Chacha-Chachi Dhaba, Atal Tunnel and Solang Valley.
- Evening departure for Delhi.
- Overnight Volvo journey.

DAY 1

5th September

The Mountains Are Calling

The journey begins from Delhi as we board our overnight Volvo towards Shimla.

Meet your fellow travellers, settle into your seats, and watch the city lights slowly disappear behind you.



The next few days will take us through some of the most spectacular landscapes in the Himalayas.

DAY 2

6th September

Into The Heart Of Kinnaur

Arrive in Shimla early in the morning and freshen up before we begin our road trip towards Sangla.

The drive is nothing short of spectacular. Winding mountain roads, deep valleys, apple orchards, and endless Himalayan views accompany us throughout the day.



By evening, we reach the beautiful Sangla Valley and check into our stay.

Take a moment to breathe in the crisp mountain air and enjoy your first evening in the mountains.

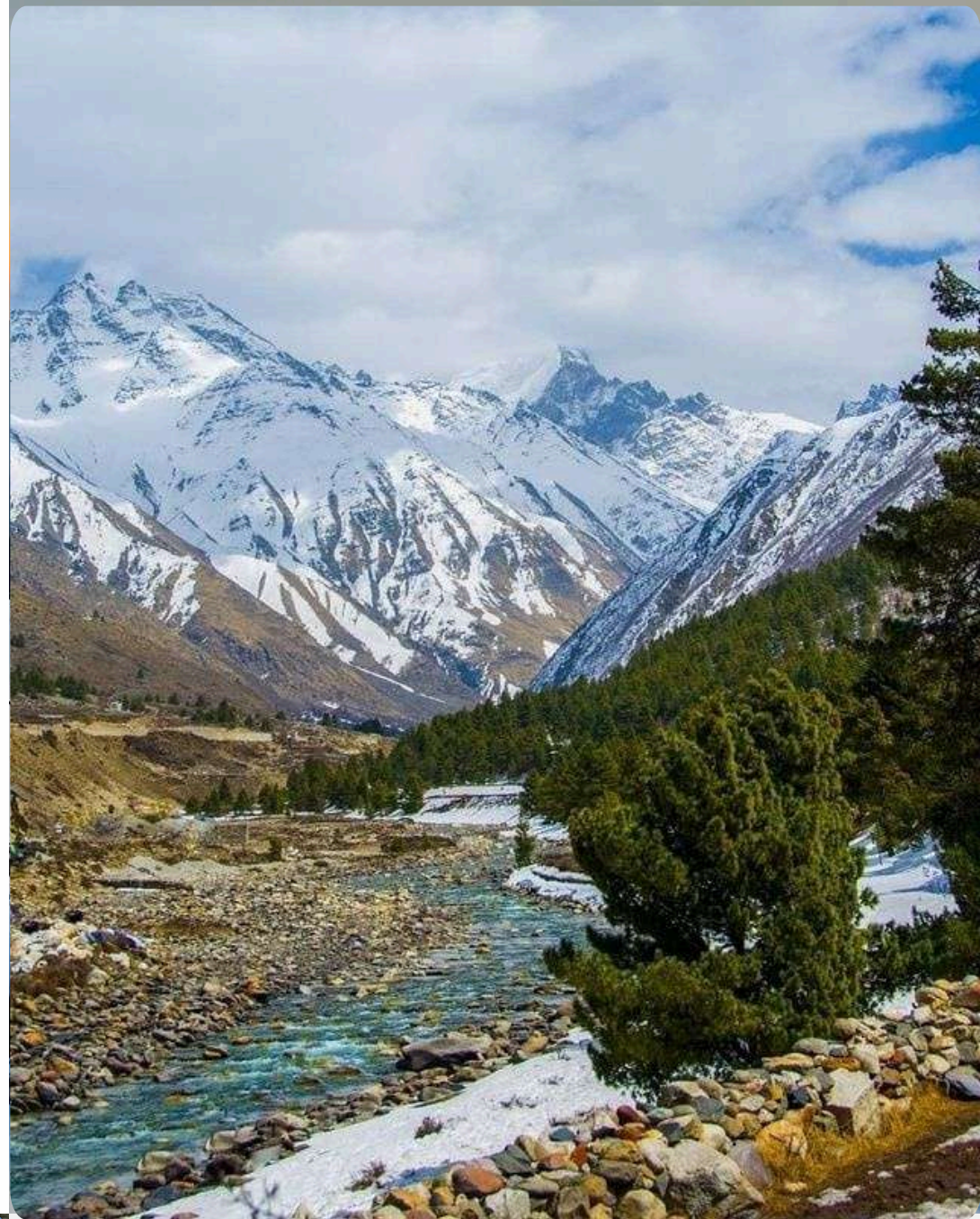
Overnight stay in Sangla.

DAY 3 7th September

The Last Village Of India

After breakfast, we head towards Chitkul, often known as the last inhabited village near the Indo-Tibetan border.

We'll stop at the legendary Hindustan Ka Aakhiri Dhaba, grab a cup of chai, and soak in the incredible views surrounding us.



Spend time wandering through the charming village, crossing wooden bridges, and taking in the beauty of the Baspa River.

Later, we drive to Kalpa, famous for its breathtaking views of the Kinnaur Kailash range.

Overnight stay in Kalpa.

DAY 4

8th September

Entering Spiti

Today marks the beginning of our journey into the cold desert of Spiti.

We drive through dramatic landscapes and make stops at the famous Khab Sangam, where the Sutlej and Spiti rivers meet, and the serene Nako Lake.



As we cross Sumdo, the gateway to Spiti, the scenery transforms completely.

By evening, we arrive in Tabo and settle into our homestay.

Overnight stay in Tabo.

DAY 5

9th September

Ancient Monasteries & Hidden Valleys

The day begins with a visit to the thousand-year-old Tabo Monastery, one of the oldest functioning Buddhist monasteries in the Himalayas.

We'll also explore the nearby meditation caves before continuing towards Kaza.



En route, visit the stunning Dhankar Monastery, perched dramatically above the valley, and stop at the beautiful Pin Valley viewpoint.

Reach Kaza by evening and explore its bustling local market.

Dinner and overnight stay in Kaza.

DAY 6

10th September

The Highest Of Everything

Today is dedicated to exploring the iconic villages around Kaza.

We begin with a visit to the magnificent Key Monastery, perhaps the most photographed monastery in Spiti.

Next, head to Hikkim, home to the world's highest post office, where you can send a postcard to your loved ones.



Continue to Komic, among the highest motorable villages in the world, before ending the day at Langza, known for its fossils, giant Buddha statue, and panoramic mountain views.

Return to Kaza by evening.

Overnight stay in Kaza.

DAY 7

11th September

Chandratal Dreams

After breakfast, we leave Kaza and make our way towards Chandratal.

Our first stop is the iconic Chicham Bridge, the highest suspension bridge in Asia.

We then cross the spectacular Kunzum Pass, surrounded by towering snow-clad peaks and endless mountain vistas.



By afternoon, we arrive at Chandratal, the famous Moon Lake.

Spend the evening by its crystal-clear waters, watching the colors of the lake change with the setting sun.

Overnight stay at Chandratal camps.

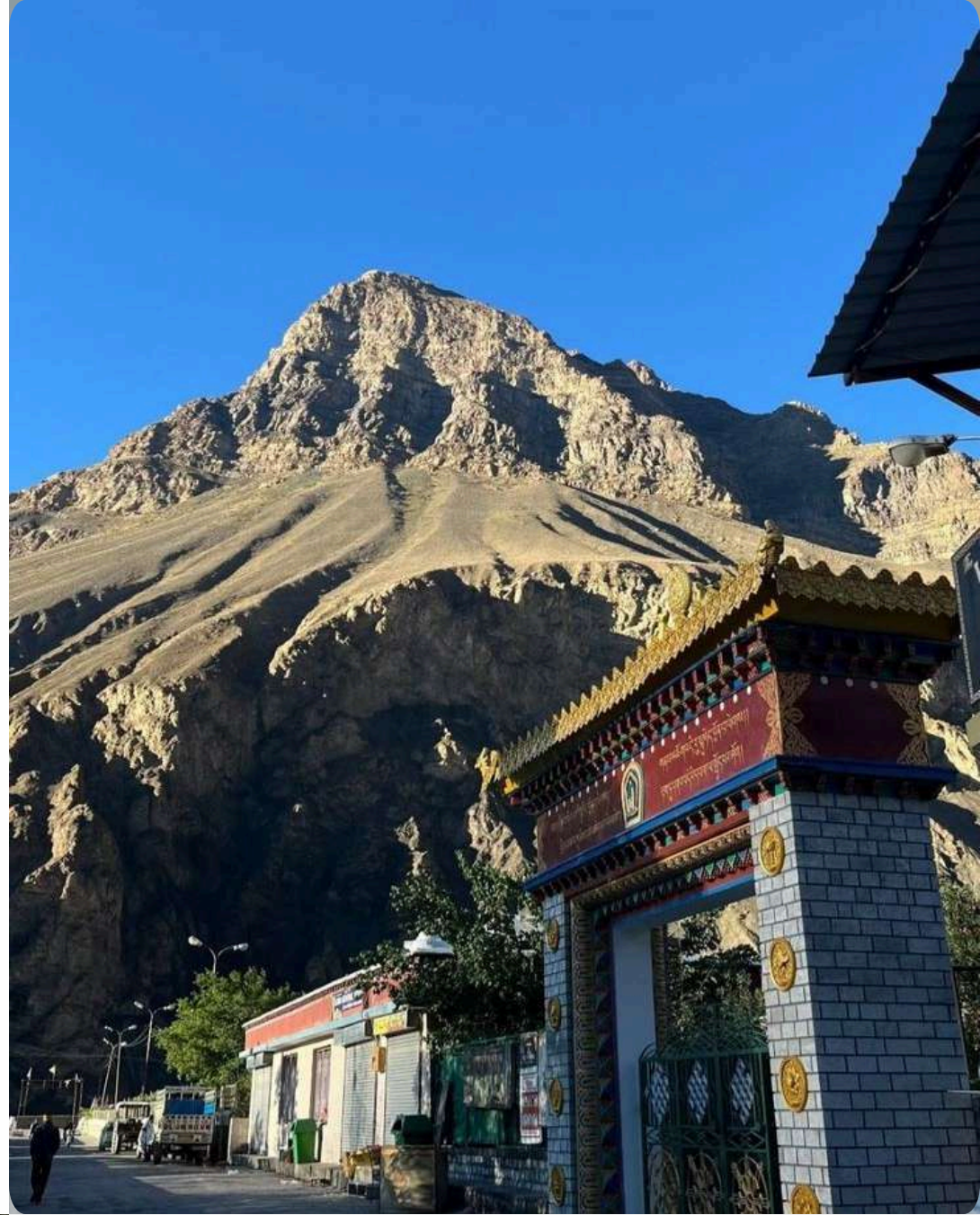
DAY 8 12th September

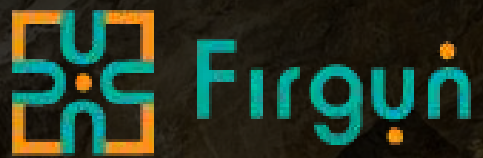
