FOUNDER'S NOTE

My journey began in a small village in Palakkad, where life was simple and hospitality was never something you had to ask for. I left home young, carrying those memories with me.

In 1988, I began what would become the Sabari Group – starting with a simple wish to provide for my family. That wish has grown into something larger: a family of more than 3,500 people who now work alongside me.

With growth came a responsibility to look beyond our own walls. Through the Sabari Charitable Trust, we've tried to give back in the ways that matter most – helping almost 9,000 children stay in school, caring for children who need extra support through Faith India, and standing by elderly members of our community with a pension each month.

Vedic Village is a return to something I have carried with me all these years. Every retreat we build is created by the same value, in conversation with its habitat and the geography – not merely constructed – so that the same warmth I grew up with is felt in every space we make.

For me, that is what a village has always meant: a place where there is room for everyone

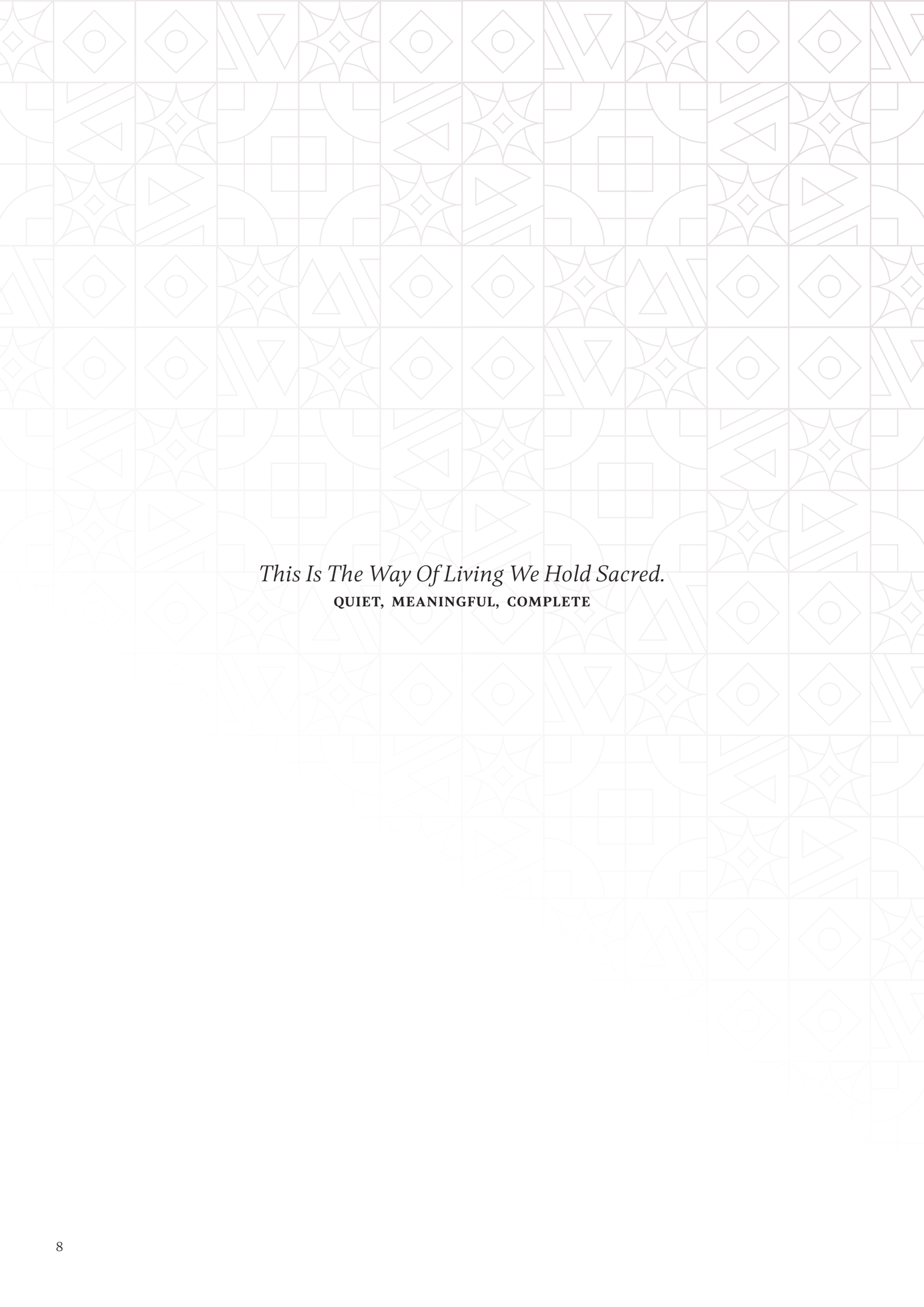

VEDIC VILLAGE // ALLEPPEY

Alleppey is a historical port city where human effort and the sea coexist beautifully.

Once a bustling hub for spice and timber trade, its hand carved canals navigate a landscape nearly two meters below sea level.

Vedic Village Retreat Alleppey, rests on a private island surrounded by the river on one side and paddy fields on the other. The retreat unfolds across an expansive stretch of land, leaving room for water, groves, and the landscape around it.

A private boat from Pallathuruthy lifts you from mainland noise into the tranquil setting of the 32-key retreat, with groves and backwater life just beyond your door. One can experience the region's enduring relationship with its environment, revealing how Alleppey remains resilient and harmonious over time.

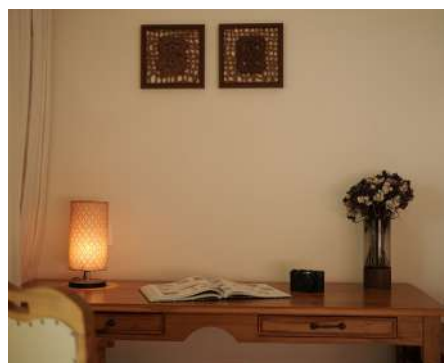

By evening, the sky stretches wide, settling into soft colours over the fields.

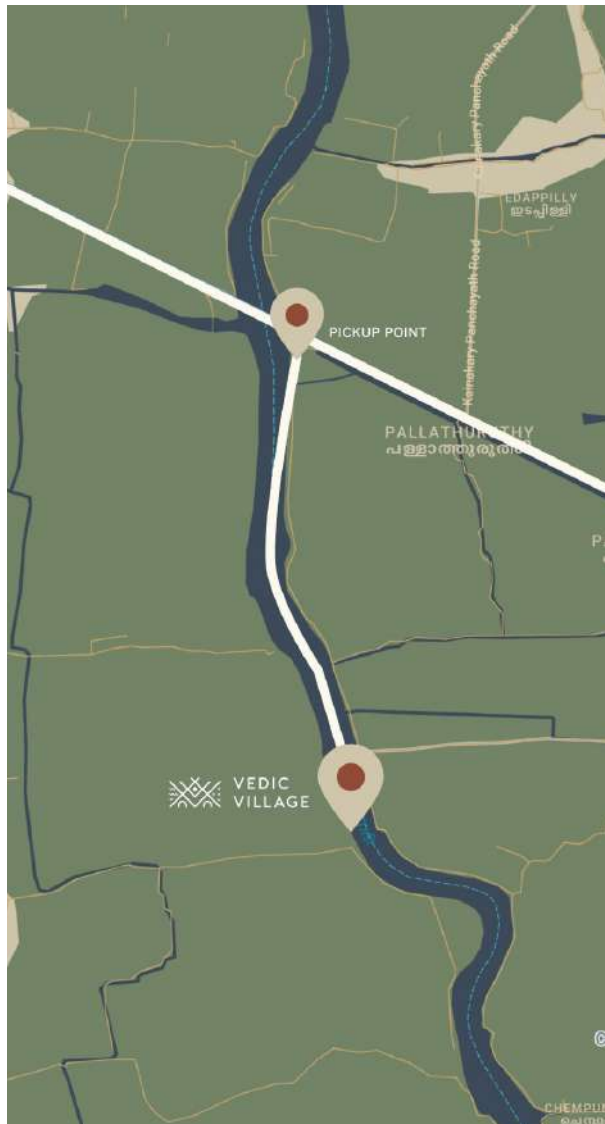
Or you may choose stillness instead

HOW TO REACH

Vedic Village Retreat, Alleppey feels a world apart, while remaining within easy reach.



Cochin International Airport at 95 km,

connects the backwaters seamlessly to the rest of India and the world.



Alappuzha Railway Station lies at 10 km from the retreat.



Cochin by Road is just a 65 km drive

The journey truly begins at the jetty.

Leaving the noise of the road behind, guests arrive by a 15-minute boat ride, gliding gently across the water toward the retreat.

It is in this quiet passage that the pace begins to change.

The mind slows, the landscape opens, and the experience unfolds even before you arrive.

VEDIC VILLAGE // KODUNGALLUR

Kodungallur, with its historic roads and rivers, has a rich legacy of welcoming diverse cultures and ideas, stemming from its past as the ancient port town of Muziris.

Vedic Village Retreat, Kodungallur is set on VP Thuruth, an island in the Thrissur district of Kerala where the arms of the Periyar river meet the delta. Intimate in scale, the retreat sits quietly within its village surroundings.

The 16-key retreat offers an invitation to explore this region of exchange, where the history of Muziris is conserved through the UNESCO-supported Muziris Heritage Project, and visitors contribute their own stories to its ongoing narrative.

HERITAGE ROOMS

Inspired by the local architecture and the weight of history, these rooms span **200 sq. ft.**, built to offer a snug and protective comfort.



PREMIER ROOMS

Defined by their peaceful verandahs, the **180 sq. ft.** Premier Rooms are spaces of quiet contemplation.

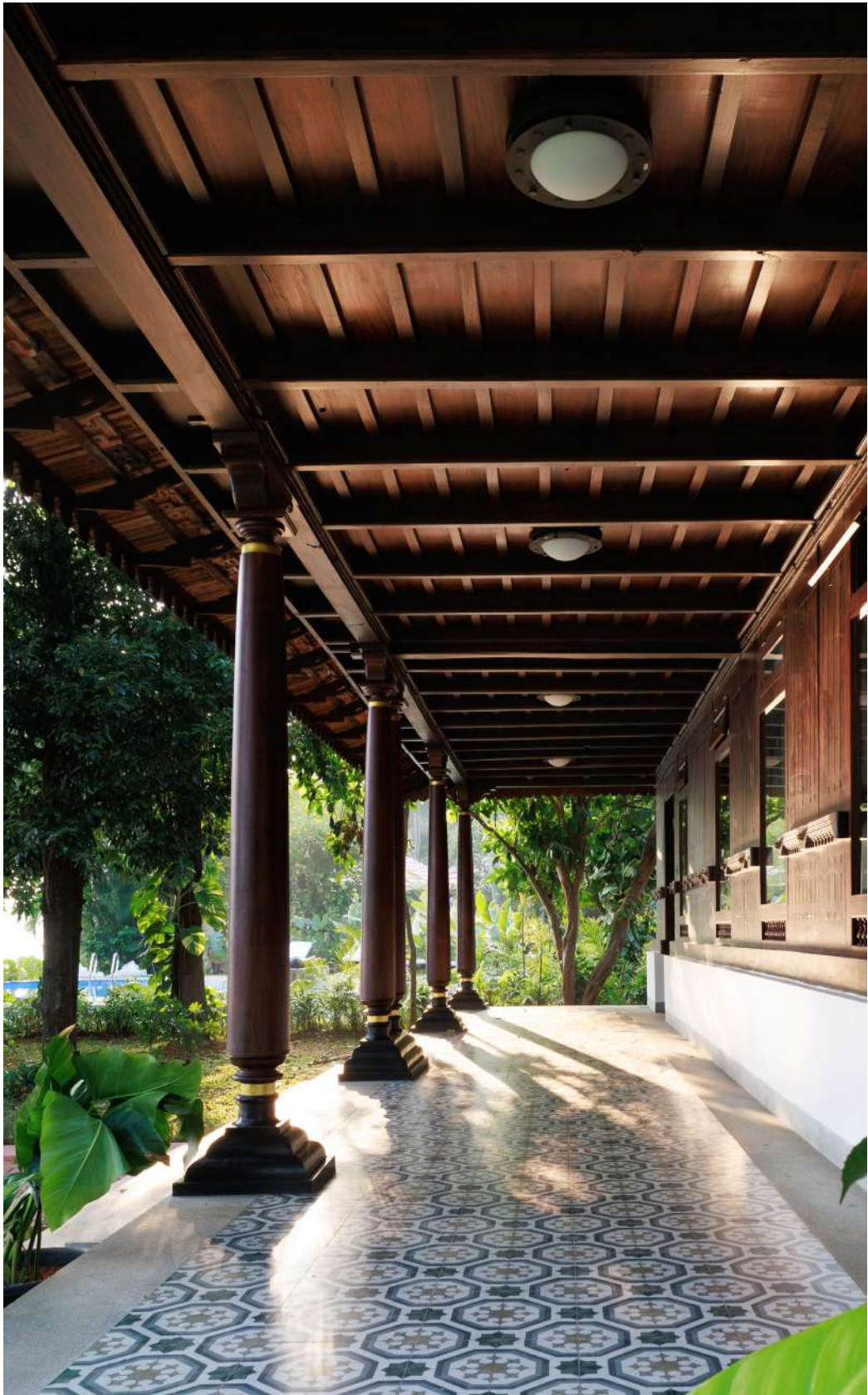
JUNIOR SUITE ROOM

A comfortable room for a small group of three. The space captures the lake in view, inside and out, reflecting a sense of lakeside calm.



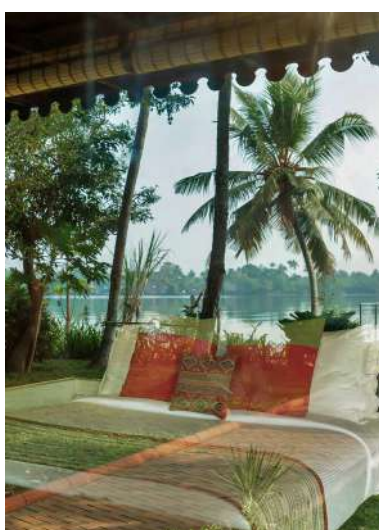

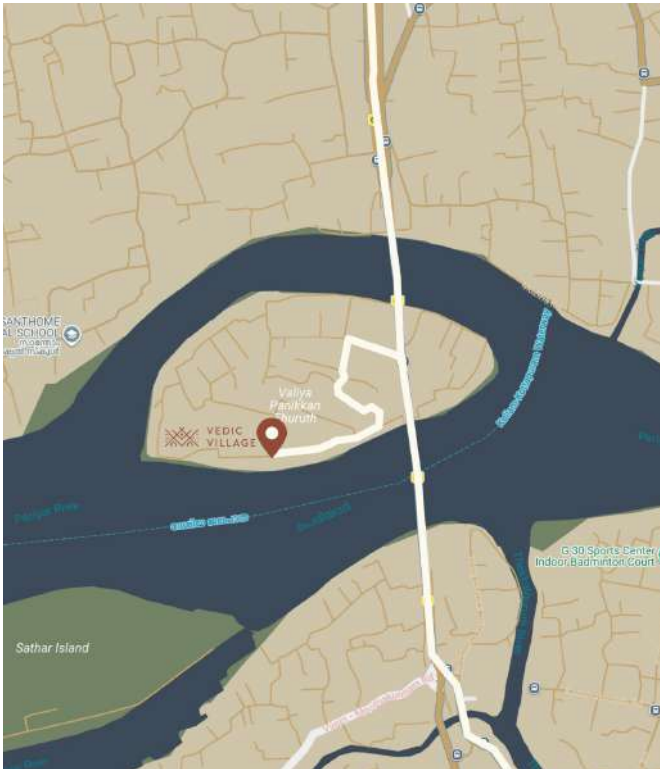

HOW TO REACH

Vedic Village Retreat, Kodungallur is well connected, with a quieter pace once you arrive.



Cochin International Airport at 40 km,

offering smooth connections to the rest of India and the world.



Aluva at 26 km and Ernakulam at 36 km

railway stations lie within comfortable driving distance,



Kodungallur town is just a short drive from the retreat.

THE JOURNEY UNFOLDS GRADUALLY.

Well connected to NH 66, the route soon leads into smaller village roads.

The surroundings begin to change as traffic thins, greenery gathers, and water appears at the edges of the landscape.

By the time you arrive, the village has already begun to reveal itself. The pace feels different here, with water, greenery, and everyday life close at hand.





VEDIC VILLAGE // SRIPERUMBUDUR

The spirit of Sriperumbudur is one of unbroken purpose.

A temple town for nine centuries and a manufacturing hub for generations, it has never asked one identity to make way for the other.

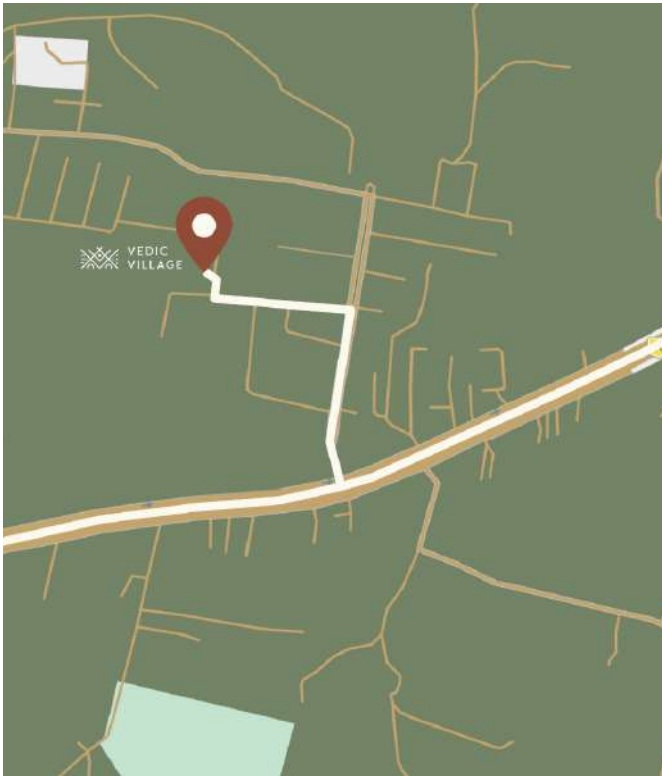
Here, the gopuram and the industrial corridor belong to the same landscape, where the rhythms of worship and work continue side by side.

Vedic Village Retreat Sriperumbudur unfolds across open grounds, a 32-key retreat with space to step away from the movement of the town.



HOW TO REACH

Vedic Village Retreat, Sriperumbudur offers a quieter setting, while staying close to the town and its industrial corridor.



Chennai International Airport at 48 km

connecting the corridor to the rest of India and the world in about 90 minutes.



Arakkonam Railway Station at 48 km

is the nearest station, with Chennai Central (55 km) also within easy reach



Sriperumbudur Industrial SIPCOT is just 16 km — a 15-minute drive that makes the retreat the natural stay for business travelers working the corridor.

Beyond the industrial corridor, the temple town of Kanchipuram lies 25 km away, around 30 minutes by road.

The coast offers another direction for the day.

'Marina Beach' is 60 km away, approximately 90 minutes by road, while 'Mahabalipuram' lies 130 km away, around two hours from the retreat.

Each offers a different way to spend the hours beyond Sriperumbudur.

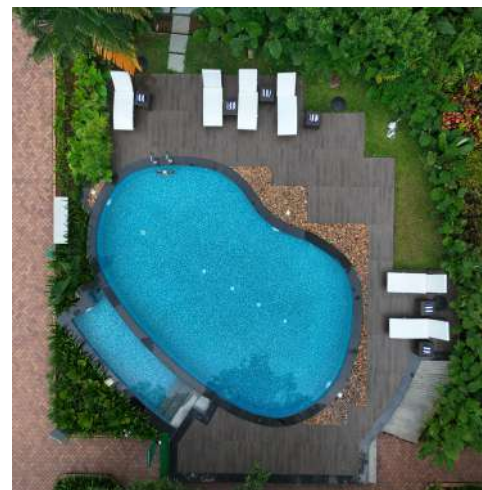




POOL Embodying the fluidity of their surroundings, our minimalist pools act as tranquil thresholds.

DARBAR CONVENTION SPACES

DINING WITH VEDIC VILLAGE

Across Alleppey, Kodungallur, and Sriperumbudur, dining takes its cues from the places around us.

At Sarvam, local ingredients and familiar flavours sit alongside dishes from further afield. Breakfasts unfold at an easy pace, lunches follow the rhythm of the day, and evenings bring people back to the table.

In Alleppey, meals draw from the waters and paddy fields around the retreat.

In Kodungallur, the region's long history of trade and exchange finds its way into the table and the flavours that surround it.

In Sriperumbudur, regional Tamil flavours meet a menu shaped for both familiar tastes and travelers passing through.

Kerala's culinary traditions remain an important part of the experience, from recipes rooted in the region to a traditional Sadhya served as a shared meal.

There is room, too, for food from beyond the region. Mediterranean dishes, Asian influences, fresh coastal seafood, and familiar classics sit alongside local cooking, allowing each guest to eat according to their own appetite and preference.

ONE INTENT, TWO PATHS

Across our Kerala retreats, wellbeing takes two distinct approaches.

In Kodungallur, programmes draw from Ayurveda, Siddha medicine, yoga, and naturopathy, traditions that consider the individual as a whole and seek to understand the sources of imbalance.

In Alleppey, the focus turns towards longevity and preventive health through movement, recovery, and evidence-informed practices that support long-term vitality.

VEDIC VILLAGE // BENGALURU

COMING SOON...

Vedic Village's Bengaluru property is planned near Ramanagara in Karnataka, about 50 km south-west of Bengaluru along the Bengaluru-Mysore Expressway.

Known for its granite hills and rugged landscapes, Ramanagara has served as a film location for 'Sholay' and 'A Passage to India'. Sericulture and silk weaving continue to shape much of the region's local economy.

The surrounding landscape invites exploration, from rock climbing and birdwatching to visits to Ramadevara Betta, a hill with deep local religious significance.

Janapada Loka offers a window into Karnataka's folk traditions, while Channapatna's wooden-toy craft, Kanva Reservoir, and Mekedaatu, where the Arkavathi meets the Kaveri.



VEDIC VILLAGE // KOCHI

COMING SOON...

Vedic Village's Kochi property is planned on Willingdon Island, India's largest man-made island, created in 1936 by dredging the channels of Kochi's backwaters and connected to the mainland by the Venduruthy Bridge.

Ernakulam Junction and Kochi's international airport are both a short drive away, and the setting continues a story Vedic Village already knows – a retreat set apart on water, in the company of the Kochi Naval Base and the historic Port of Kochi.

Just across the bridge lies Old Kochi – Fort Kochi and Mattancherry – where colonial-era streets still carry the rhythm of a centuries-old spice trade.

The Chinese fishing nets along the shore, the antique lanes of Jew Town, the 16th-century Paradesi Synagogue, and the Dutch Palace all sit within easy reach – alongside Kerala's oldest church, still standing since 1503.

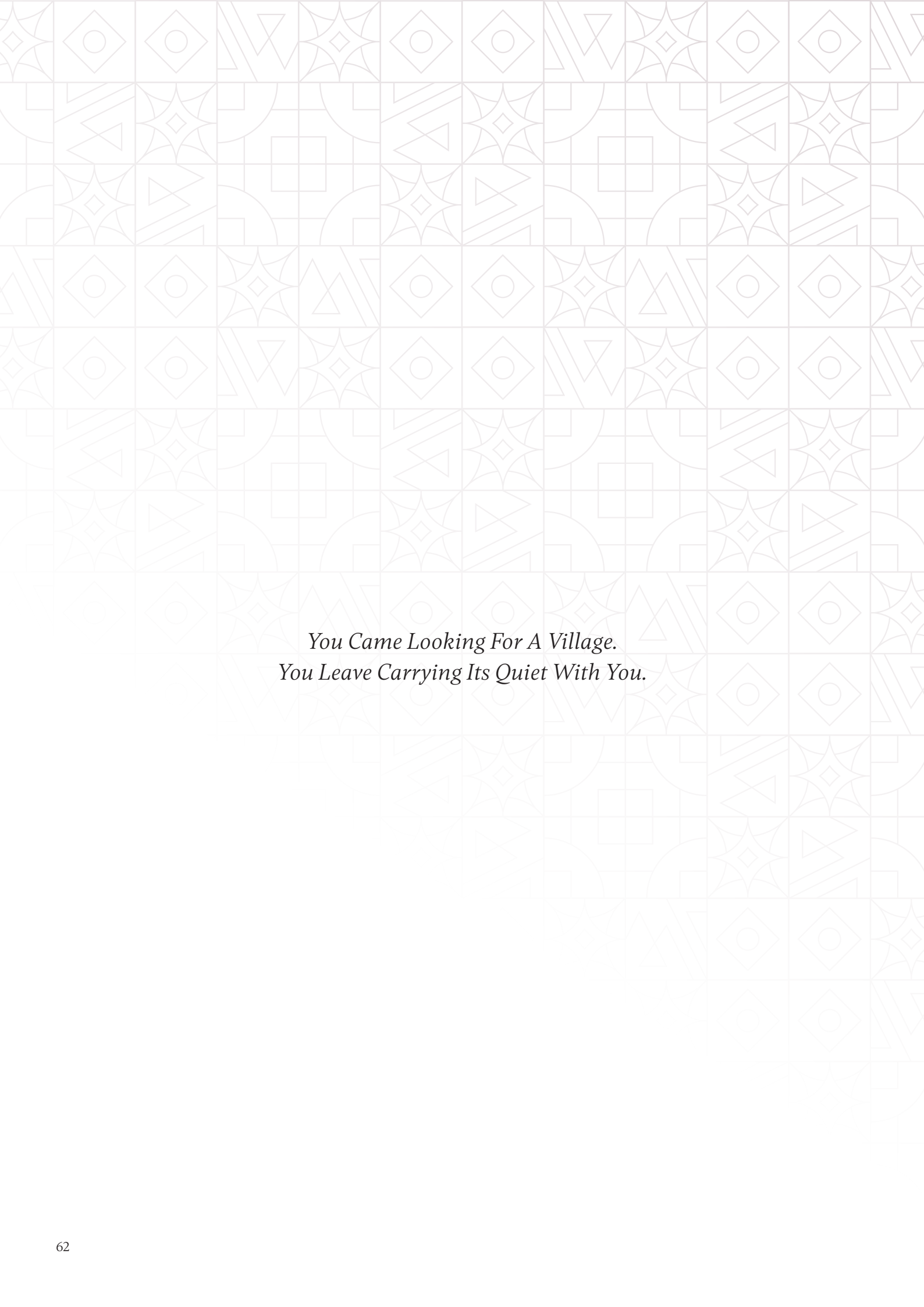

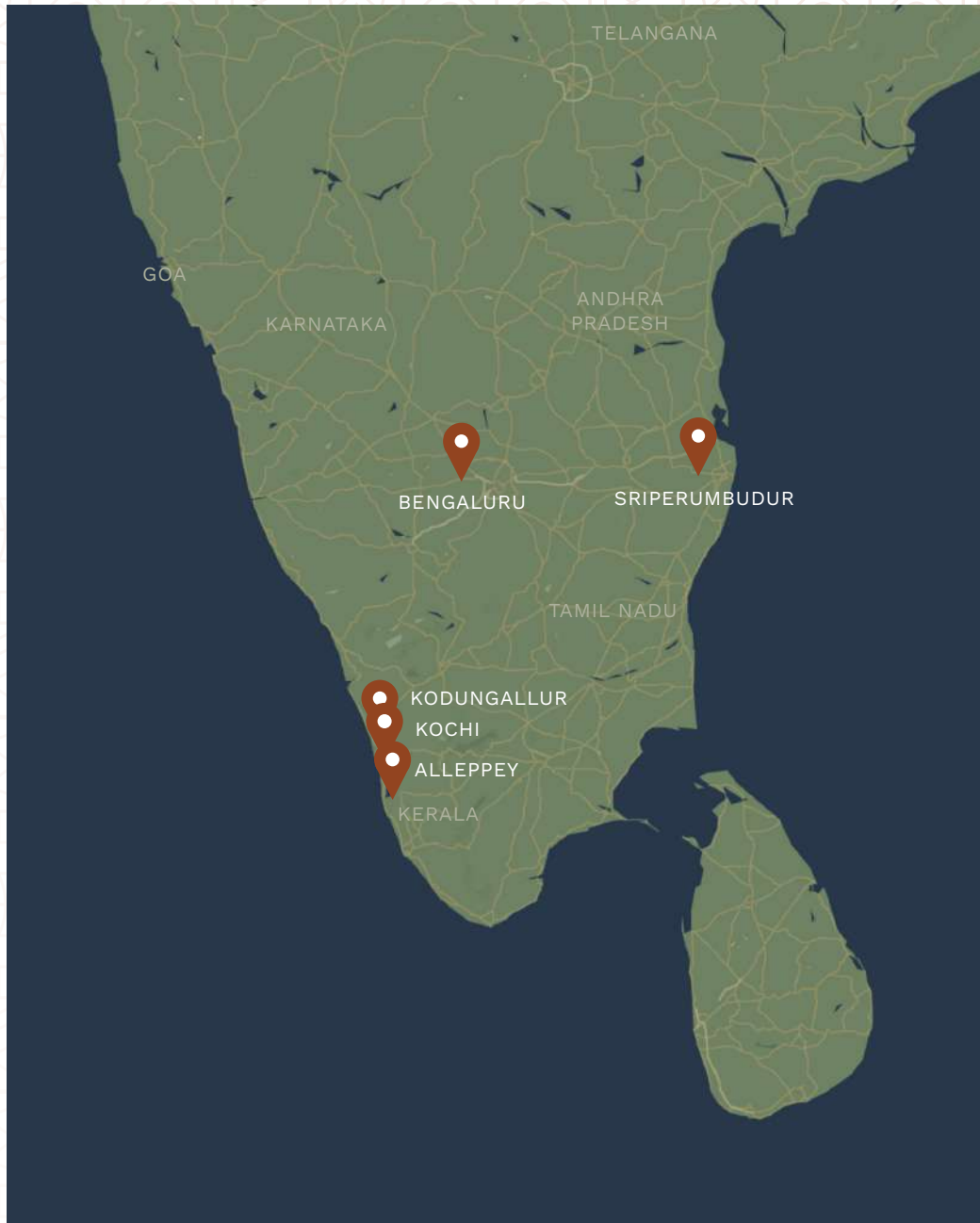
