Day 1 | 15 May – Arrival and stay at Rishikesh

Arrival at **Jolly Grant Airport** in **Dehradun** where our representative will receive you.

Drive to **Rishikesh**, the spiritual and yoga capital of India.

Drive Duration: approx. 2 hours

Upon arrival:

- Check in at your hotel
- Evening visit to **Triveni Ghat**

Experience the **Ganga Aarti**, a beautiful spiritual ceremony with chanting, lamps, and prayers offered to the river.

Dinner on your own to explore Rishikesh's cafés and restaurants.

Overnight stay in **Rishikesh**



Day 2 | 16 May –Drive to Sari Village

Begin a scenic mountain drive towards **Sari Village**, a charming Himalayan village located at the base of the Deoriatal trek.

The journey takes you through winding forest roads, rivers, and beautiful Garhwal landscapes.

Drive Duration: approx. 6–7 hours

Upon arrival in Sari Village:

- Check into your village homestay
- Evening at leisure to soak in the peaceful mountain atmosphere
- Enjoy a freshly prepared **home-cooked Garhwali dinner**

Overnight stay in **Sari Village**



Day 3 | 17 May – Trek to Deoriatal & Picnic Lunch

After an early breakfast, begin the trek to **Deoria Tal**.

This is a **moderate 2.5 km trek** through dense forests and rhododendron trails. The lake is famous for its **mirror reflection of the Chaukhamba peaks** on clear days.

At Deoriatal:

- Spend time relaxing by the serene lake
- Enjoy a **picnic lunch surrounded by Himalayan views**
- Photography and nature walk around the lake

Later trek back down to Sari Village.

Evening free to relax and enjoy village life.

Day 4 | 18 May – Village Walk & Local Experiences

Today is dedicated to **experiencing life in the Himalayas**.

After breakfast:

- Guided **village walk through Sari**
- Visit a **local Garhwali home**
- Interact with village families and learn about their lifestyle
- Try your hands at **traditional farming activities** depending on the season

This experience offers an authentic glimpse into rural Himalayan culture.

Afternoon free for:

- Relaxation
- Short nature walks
- Tea with mountain views

Dinner and overnight in **Sari Village**

Day 5 | 19 May – Tungnath Temple & Chandrashila Trek

Early morning departure for the trek to **Tungnath Temple**, the **highest Shiva temple in the world**.

Drive to the trek starting point at **Chopta**.

From Chopta begin the **4 km trek** to Tungnath through alpine meadows and spectacular Himalayan landscapes.

At Tungnath:

- Visit the sacred temple
- Enjoy breathtaking views of the surrounding peaks

Those who wish can continue the **1.5 km trek further to Chandrashila Peak**, which offers **panoramic views of Nanda Devi, Trishul, and Chaukhamba ranges**.

Return trek back to Chopta and drive to Sari Village.

Dinner and overnight in **Sari Village**

Day 6 | 20 May – Drive from Sari to Rishikesh.

Drive to **Rishikesh**, the spiritual and yoga capital of India.

Drive Duration: approx. 7 hours

Upon arrival:

- Check in at your hotel
- Rest of the evening at leisure
- Dinner on your own

Day 7 | 21 May – Departure

After breakfast transfer to **Jolly Grant Airport** for your onward flight.

Drive Duration: approx. 45 minutes – 1 hour.

Depart with beautiful memories of the Himalayas, village life, and mindful travel experiences.
