76% of CEO alumni feel a stronger connection to their hometowns.

STRONG COMMUNITIES

91% have built stronger networks through the CEO Program

STRONG COMMUNITIES

83% found the CEO Program more impactful than other K-12 entrepreneurship experiences.

MINDSET AND SUPPORT

95% believe an entrepreneurial mindset and community support are accessible to all students.

NETWORK EXPANSION

75% reported that the CEO Program helped them expand their personal and professional networks.


