The Challenge: The Cost of Uncertainty

Uncertainty in Outcomes:

59%

of companies have not defined specific targets for AI impact, and 46% of leaders report that no single enterprise objective has seen a "strong positive impact" yet.

Uncertainty in Use:

65%

of employees admit to using unvetted "Shadow AI." This is a dual crisis: it exposes proprietary data to the public domain and hides internal innovation from leadership, preventing the scaling of successful use cases.

Uncertainty in Control:

46%

of organizations currently lack an official AI usage policy, while 95% of orgs use AI in some form. Without an automated vetting framework, innovation either stops (the "Slow No") or moves into the shadows where it cannot be governed.

Uncertainty in Training:

only 12%

of employees report receiving sufficient AI training. This gap leads to a 19% decrease in delivery throughput and a 150% increase in production bugs when developers use unguided AI tools.

- **Organizations with mature upskilling are 2x more likely to see significant positive outcomes.**

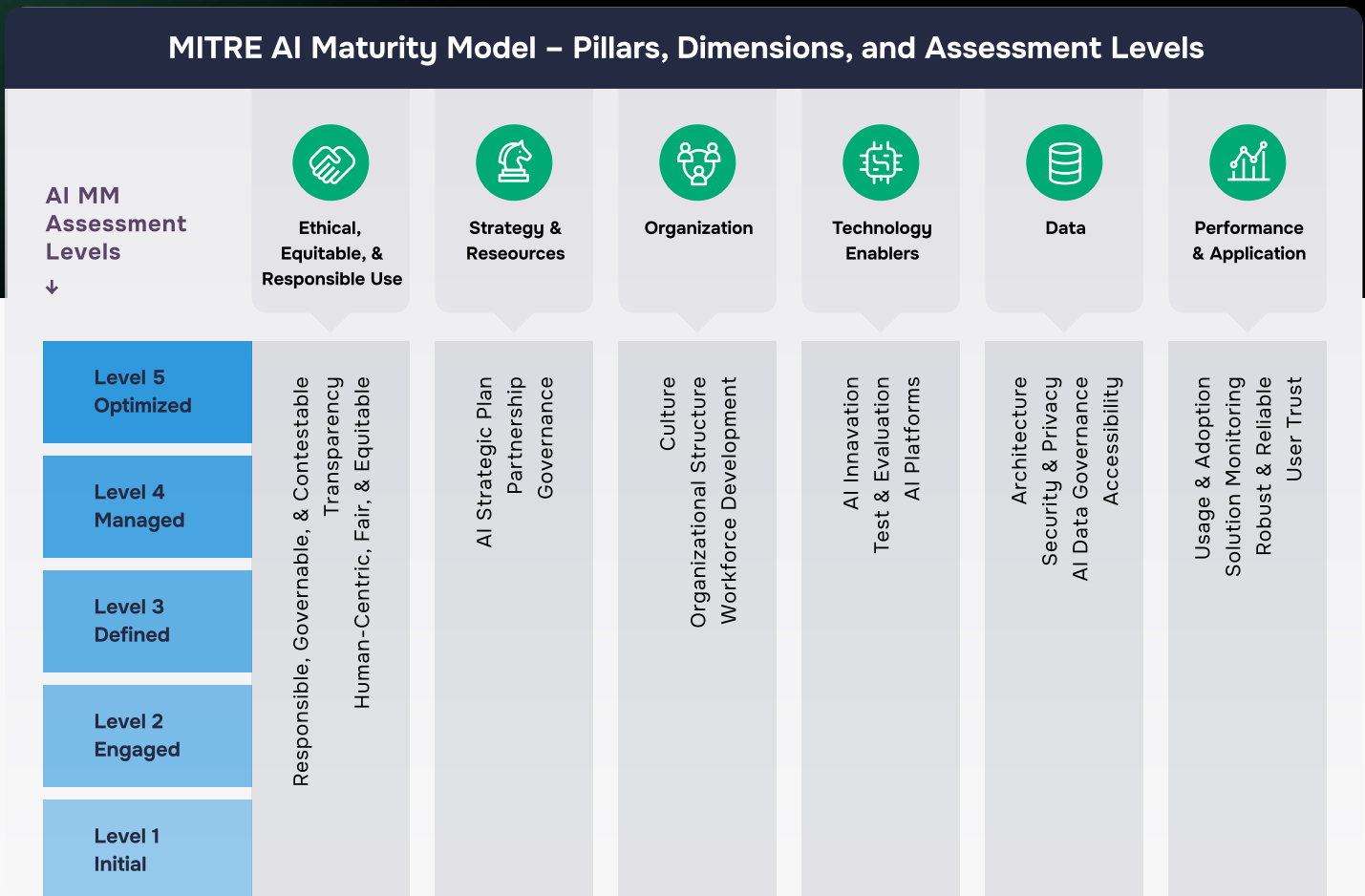
4 The Registry: Your Single Source of Truth
