



Entering China

1. Athlete Entry

1) Athletes from Visa-Waiver Countries

- a) Athletes from nations eligible for the visa waiver can enter China without a visa, provided that their stay does not exceed 30 days. ([Visa-Waiver Country List](#))
- b) However, the passport should be valid for at least six (6) months beyond the period of holders' intended stay in China.

2) Athletes from Non-Visa-Waiver Countries

- a) Athletes are required to present the following documents at the [local Chinese Visa Application Service Centre](#) for the purpose of applying for an M visa. Please click [here](#) for more details.

2. Firearm Entry

Athletes from both visa-exempt and non-visa-exempt countries shall follow the procedures below for the entry of their firearms:

1) Before Submission of Entry Form

Athletes are required to complete the competition registration form accurately, providing all required information. The number of firearms carried must not exceed the quantity declared on the registration form.

2) Prior to Entry into China

Athletes shall complete the necessary exit procedures in their home country in accordance with its national regulations.

3) Upon Arrival at the Airport in China

The Organizing Committee will designate a representative to assist athletes with the firearm entry procedures at the airport where the athlete's inbound flight lands, as provided by the athlete.

4) After Entry into China

Athletes arriving directly in Chengdu, or transiting through another Chinese city before arriving in Chengdu, will be accompanied by a representative of the Organizing Committee to the Sichuan Administration Center of Shooting and Archery Sports to complete the firearm storage procedures.

5) Upon Departure from China

The Organizing Committee will designate a representative to assist athletes with the firearm exit procedures at the airport of the athlete's outbound flight, as provided by the athlete.

Legal Notice

All participants must strictly comply with China's Firearms Control Law. Failure to declare firearms or carrying quantities exceeding the declared amount upon entry may result in legal liability and disqualification by the Organizing Committee.
