4. Answer: b. To investigate bombings carried out by Italian anarchists across the country.

Explanation: The passage states that Attorney General A. Mitchell Palmer “created a new department, the Bureau of Investigation, to investigate the bombings.” None of the other options match that stated purpose. Option D (“to deport members of the Union of Russian Workers...”) describes something the Bureau did later, but it was not the reason it was created. Rerecord

6. Answer: b. Federal judges threw out the cases and argued that citizens' rights had been violated.

The passage explains that judges dismissed the cases arising from the Palmer Raids because they believed the Justice Department had infringed on constitutional rights.

Option D would mean that judges blocked or boycotted the raids while they were happening—for example, refusing to sign search-or-arrest warrants or otherwise “stonewalling” the Justice Department’s plans.

The passage never says that. Instead, it tells us what the judges did after the raids were over. Rerecord

42. The pattern is straightforward: the brackets contain the first three letters of the word that follows them.

- *mango* begins with **man** → (alarm [**man**] mango)
- *ratio* begins with **rat** → (brush [**rat**] ratio)
So the missing word is **rat (A)**.
