OPTIONAL ANSWERS

- The author wants to explain that bones can bend a little, but that they will break if they bend too much.
- A doctor takes an X-ray to find out if a bone is broken and to find out how to set a broken bone.
- "Setting a bone" means moving the pieces of the broken bone back to their normal position.
- a) A person with a broken bone has to wear a cast for one to two months.
b) "It can take from one to two months for a broken bone to heal."

Cause	Effect
<i>A doctor sets the broken bone.</i>	The pieces of broken bone are now back in their normal position.
<i>A cast is put around the part of the body where the broken bone is.</i>	<i>The broken pieces of bone do not move while they heal.</i>
<i>The bone makes many new cells to heal the break.</i>	The broken pieces of bone stick together and slowly make the bone as good as new.

1st letter - Step size increases by 1 with each step and the direction alternates with each step
2nd letter - Count forward steps of 5

AZ , TI , BY , RK , CX , PM , DW , NO

This is a double sequence - pair 1 to pair 3 to pair 5 etc
Pair 1, 1st letter - Count forwards in steps of 1 - A B C D
Pair 1, 2nd letter - Count backwards in steps of 1 - Z Y X W
Pair 2, 1st letter - Count backwards in steps of 2 - T R P N
Pair 2, 2nd letter - Count forwards in steps of 2 - I K M O
