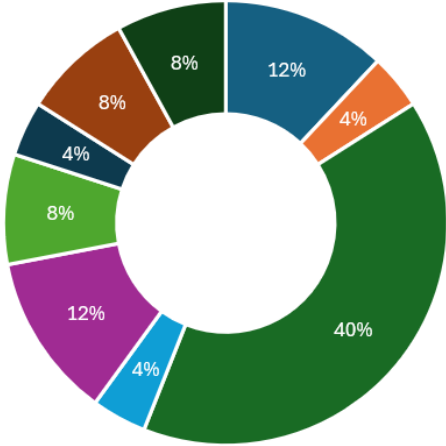

LBS programmes demonstrate teaching excellence and strong student outcomes, as reflected in their graduate employment statistics and performance metrics. Our graduates enter the workforce quickly and across a broad range of industries, a testament to the practical, internationally oriented education LBS provides. The data below — drawn from alumni surveys — highlight key patterns in post-graduation employment, job search duration, and professional field placement.

Field of Employment

LBS graduates pursue careers across a diverse range of professional fields. Sales leads at 24%, followed by Finance & Accounting (20%), Marketing & Communications (12%) and HR Management (12%).

The breadth of fields — spanning Banking, IT, Logistics, Project Management, and beyond — reflects the cross-functional competencies developed throughout LBS programmes.

Time to Employment After Graduation

LBS graduates enter the workforce with notable speed. 46% secure employment before graduation — a strong indicator of the programmes’ career integration and industry networks. A further 33% find positions within 1–2 months of graduating. Only a small minority require more than a year to secure employment, underscoring the labour market relevance of an LBS degree.
