The RFI represents the additional greenhouse gas emissions from refurbishment activities, expressed as a percentage of the product's original embodied carbon footprint.

Rejoose certifies that the organization named above has implemented the Rejoose company-specific Refurbishment Impact (RFI) method. Included in RFI

The total refurbishment impact is 8.82 kg CO₂e per refurbished unit, broken down as:

- Repair labor: 0.40 kg CO₂e
- Repair parts: 0.34 kg CO₂e
- Storage: 0.08 kg CO₂e
- Transport: 6.24 kg CO₂e
- Packaging: 1.76 kg CO₂e
