Care and Maintenance Guide

Enviro Surfaces® Sintered Porcelain is a durable and low maintenance material making it the ideal surface for benchtops and splashbacks, both inside and out. Here are some tips and precautions to help you effectively clean and maintain your Enviro Sintered Porcelain material:

Regular cleaning

For day-to-day cleaning, use a soft, damp cloth or soft sponge with mild detergent or neutral soap and warm water. This will be sufficient to remove most dirt, grime, and spills from the surface.

Dry the surface

After cleaning, dry the surface with a soft microfibre cloth to prevent water spots and maintain its finish.

Avoid harsh chemicals

Avoid using abrasive or acidic cleaners, as they can damage the surface. Stay away from products containing bleach, ammonia and hydrofluoric acid and derivatives, as they may cause discoloration.

It is not advisable to use waxes, oily soaps, impregnating agents or other treatments on the surface. Application of these solutions are not necessary.

Wipe spills promptly

While Enviro Sintered Porcelain is highly stain-resistant, it is best to wipe up spills as soon as possible to prevent potential stains or residue build-up.

Use non-scratch pads

When dealing with stubborn stains or dried-on residues, use non-scratch cleaning pads or soft brushes. Avoid abrasive scrubbers or scouring pads.

Avoid impact or dropping objects

Enviro Sintered Porcelain is durable, but it is not entirely chip-proof. To prevent chipping or damage, avoid direct impact or dropping objects on the surface and exposed areas (corners, edges, bevels, undermount sink, etc.)

Use cutting boards

Although Enviro Sintered Porcelain is highly scratch resistant, when working in the kitchen, use cutting boards to protect the surface from direct contact with sharp knives, ceramic knives, and other sharp utensils.

Use trivets

While Enviro Sintered Porcelain is generally heat-resistant and more resilient to temperature changes compared to other materials, it is not entirely immune to thermal shock. When cooking, use trivets under hot saucepans, fry pans and trays to protect the surface from extreme temperature changes by direct contact with utensil temperatures.

Use trivets under electrical appliances

It is recommended that trivets are used under electrical appliances that generate heat over an extended length of time (air fryers, sandwich press, slow cookers, rice cookers, electric fry pans, etc.)

Avoid high-pressure washers

For outdoor applications, avoid using high-pressure washers as the intense force can potentially damage the surface.

Avoid heavy weight

Do not stand, kneel or sit on the surface.

For Silk Polish Finish

The Enviro Sintered Porcelain' Silk Polish' Finish may be more susceptible to fine etching and scratching. This finish is not recommended for high traffic areas. This finish requires higher care to avoid scratches from occurring. (Enviro12® Emerald Verde, Orobico Viola).
