



FAQs

Why wouldn't I just hire a full-time designer?

Good question. For starters, the annual cost of a full-time senior-level designer is around £100,000 plus benefits. (And trying to find one available is a hassle in itself.) Aside from that, you may not always have enough work to keep them busy all the time, so you're stuck paying for time you aren't able to utilise. With my monthly plan, you can pause and resume your subscription as often as you need to ensure you're only paying your designer when you have work available for them.

Is there a limit to how many requests I can have?

Nope! In the monthly plan, unlimited revisions mean we'll work together until you are 100% satisfied with your design. If you subscribe, you'll also have access to more design support.

How fast will I receive my designs?

On average, most requests are completed in 4-5 working days. However, more complex requests can take longer.

What if I don't like the design?

No worries! I'll continue to revise the design until you're 100% satisfied.

T&Cs

1. Project Scope

The scope of work will be clearly outlined and agreed upon before the project begins. Any additional work outside the agreed scope may be subject to additional fees, which will be discussed and approved before proceeding.

2. Payments

A deposit is required upfront to secure your project slot, with the remaining balance due upon completion and delivery of the final designs. Payment is expected within 14 days of the invoice date unless otherwise agreed upon. Late payments may incur additional fees

3. Revisions

The project includes up to two rounds of revisions (unless subscribed) as outlined in the initial quote. Additional revisions beyond this may incur extra charges, which will be communicated in advance.

4. Cancellations & Refunds

Either party may cancel the project at any time. In the event of cancellation, any work completed up to that point will be invoiced, and deposits are non-refundable.

5. Intellectual Property

Upon full payment, you will receive the rights to the final design assets. However, any initial concepts, unused designs, or source files remain the property of the designer unless otherwise agreed upon.

6. Client Responsibilities

Timely feedback and communication are essential to keeping the project on schedule. Delays in providing feedback or necessary materials may affect the timeline and could result in additional costs.

7. Confidentiality

All project details, discussions, and files are treated with strict confidentiality. Your privacy and the security of your information are a priority.

8. Communication

I am available for you to talk during standard business hours via email or scheduled calls. Response times will typically be within 24-48 hours.

9. File Delivery

Final design files will be delivered electronically in the agreed formats. It is the client's responsibility to back up all files; additional requests for file resends may be subject to a fee.

10. Liability

While every effort is made to ensure accuracy and compliance, the designer is not liable for any loss or damage resulting from the use of the design assets. It is the client's responsibility to review and approve all work before final delivery.
