What Happened?

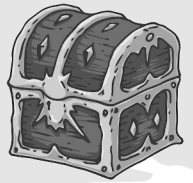
Blessing the Honeybee became curious and followed Fret the Fly to the garbage dump instead of searching for beautiful flowers.

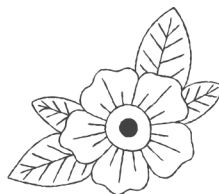
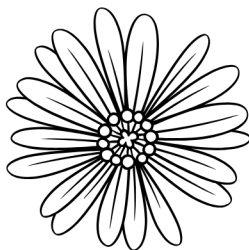
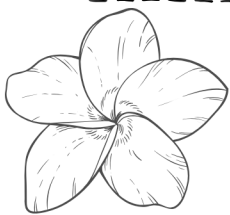
Can you carry pollen?

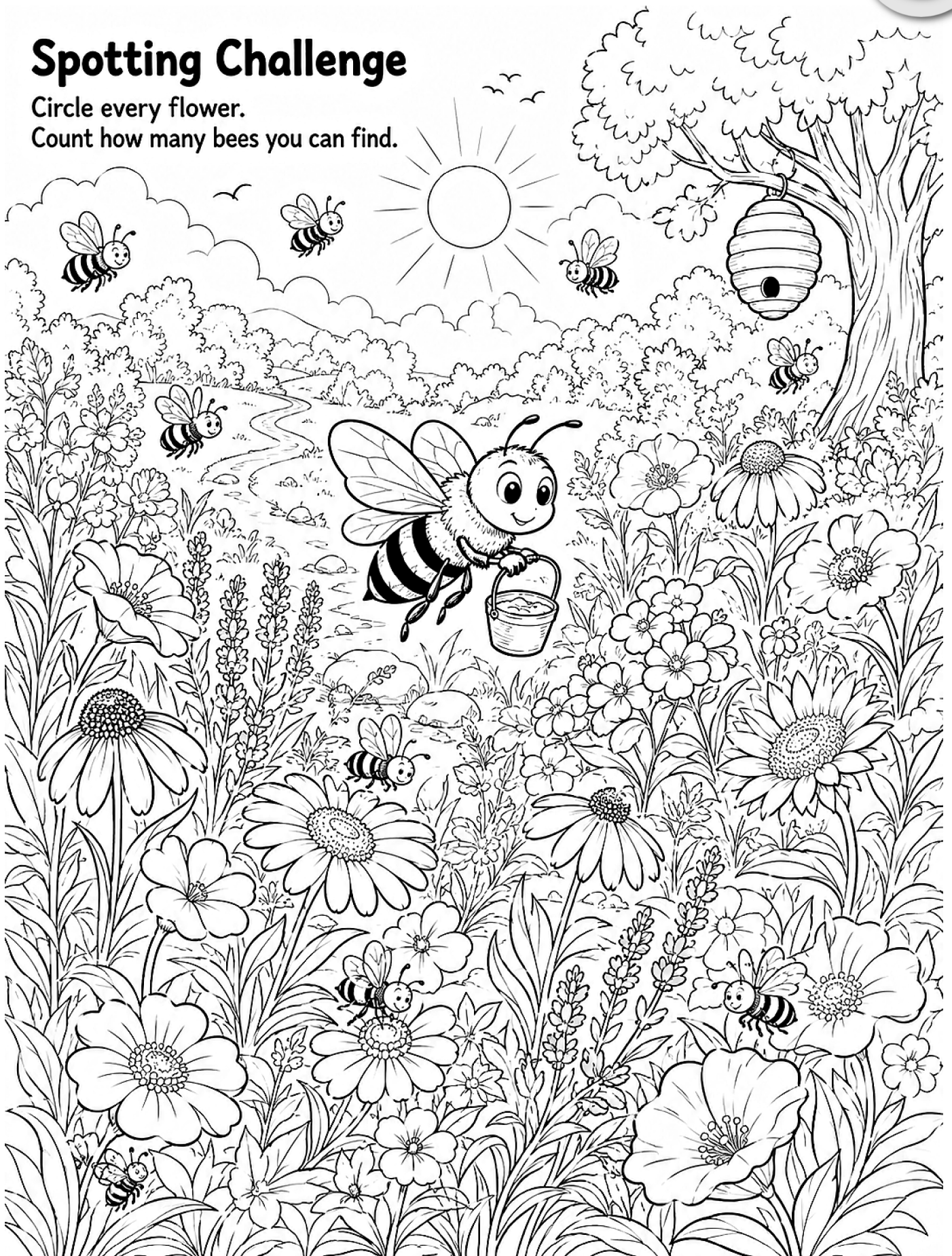
