THE PROGRAMME

A well-fitting garment is no accident. This programme builds the skill for it, from the first measurement to the final press.



Tailoring & Garment Making is a practice-based full-time programme for made-to-measure work, ready-to-wear and alterations.

Across twenty-five specialist modules in five progressive phases, trainees work from textile material science, measuring and pattern construction, through sewing and fastening techniques, to the making of complete garments and to starting their own business.

The focus is consistently on practice. Training takes place on real fabric, on industrial sewing machines, overlock and pressing station, with around 1,400 hours of technical learning and over 130 assessed exercises.

Each module concludes with an assessed test piece, so that competence shows in real work and not on paper. Regional models and digital pattern technique are firmly embedded.

The programme is offered as a curriculum, as a matching equipment specification, or as a turnkey package for the site.
