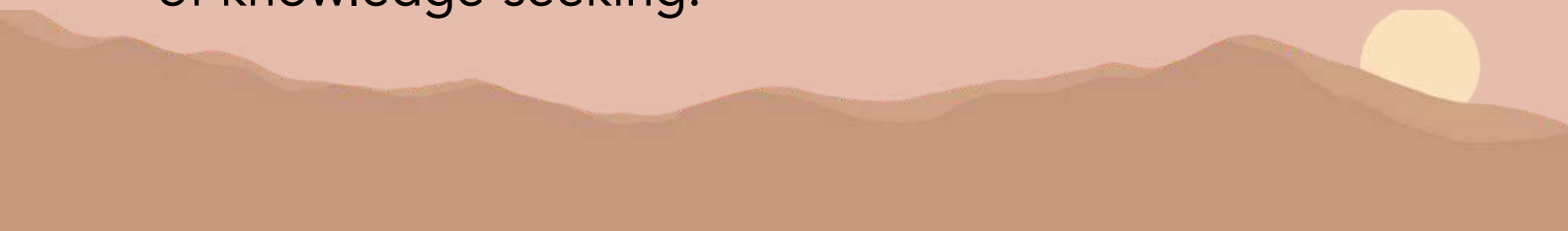
Duas for our children

May our children be those who are loved not just by the inhabitants of the dunya, but also inhabitants of the Heaven.



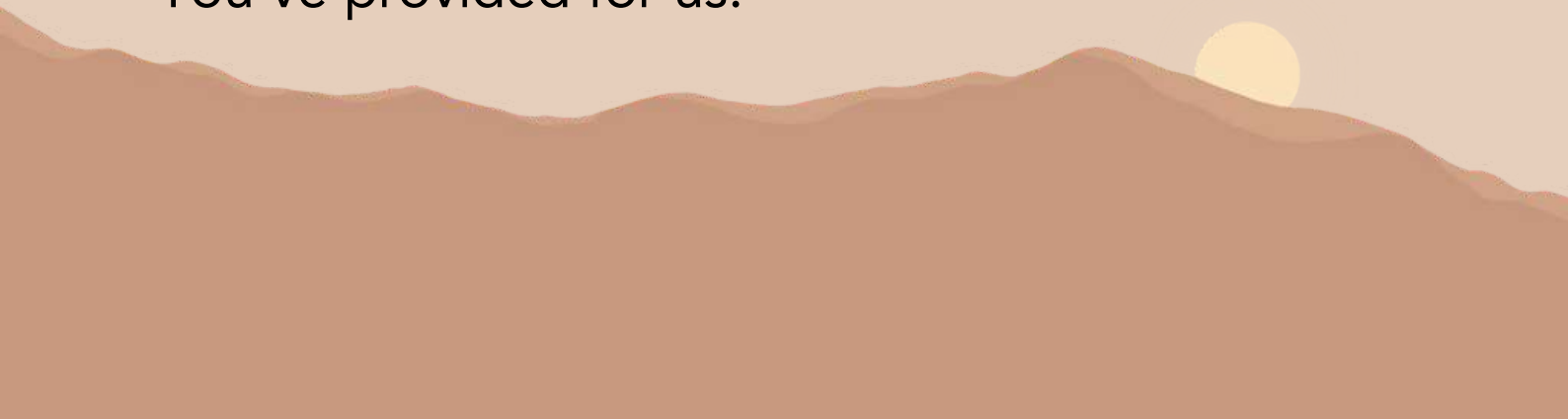
Duas for Rizq and Knowledge

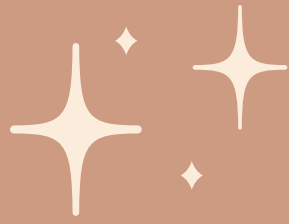
